and have promised a copy of my

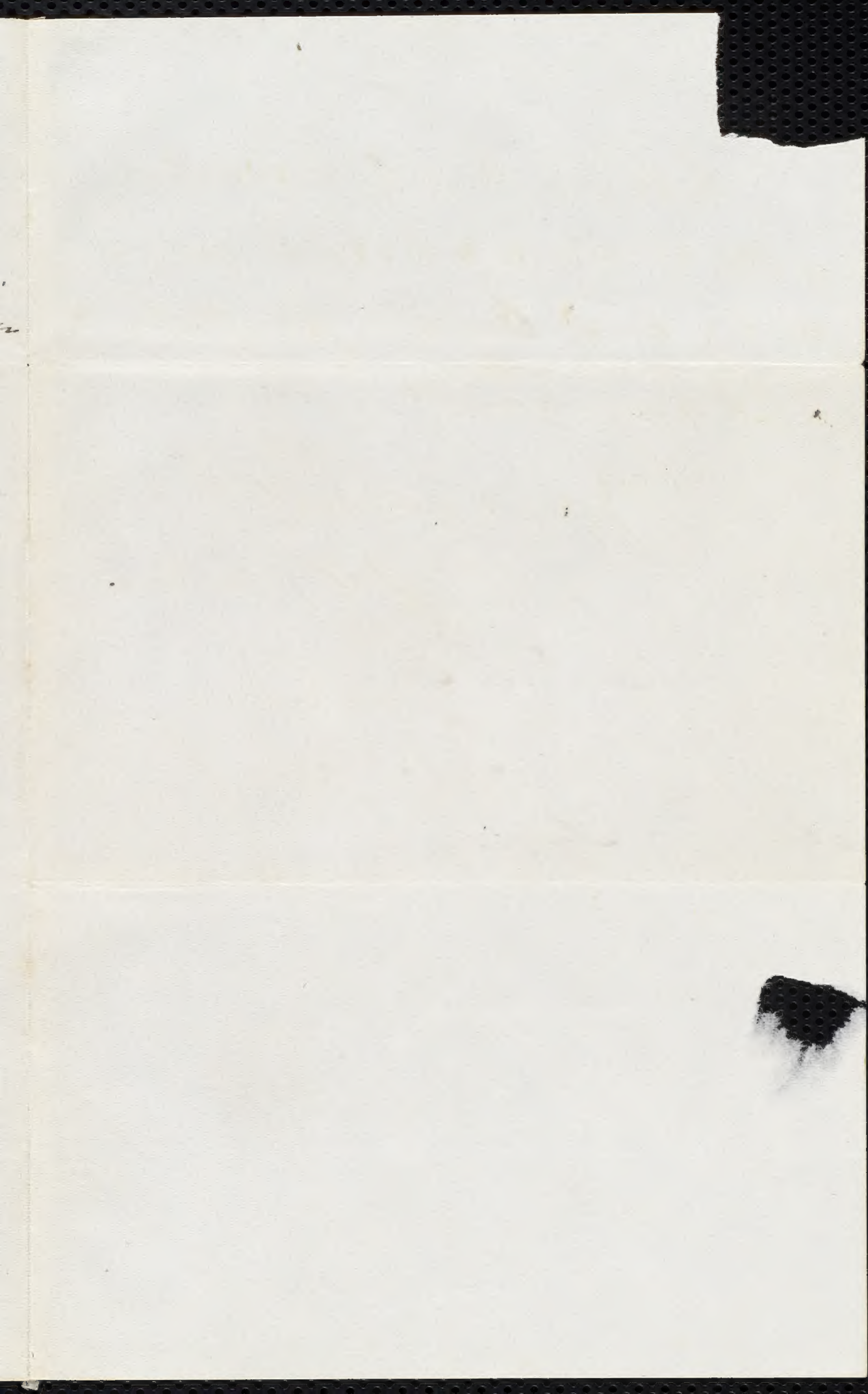
