The Rev Thomas H Jones a fugitive slave  
has just called upon me requesting a  
favor which I extend with pleasure -

He wishes me to forward to you a copy  
of the Morning Journal & Courier of Aug. 30 published  
at New Haven Ct. Calling your especial  
attention to an article signed by Gen H. Wa-  
shington, wishing you to insert it in the Lib-  
erator at your earliest convenience -

The course Mr Washington has taken was  
calculated to injure Mr Jones to a great extent  
as his slanderous article was published by  
numerous papers - all willing of course to hunt  
the poor fugitive - I hope therefore this re-  
antation may have a conspicuous insertion -  
at least if you believe Mr Jones to be all right -  
Since locating with us he has behaved like  
a Man and exercises an indefatigable industry  
in throwing out the lie which is to poison  
the whole Nation & I hope at no distant day cause  
an uprising which will end in annihilating the accursed
