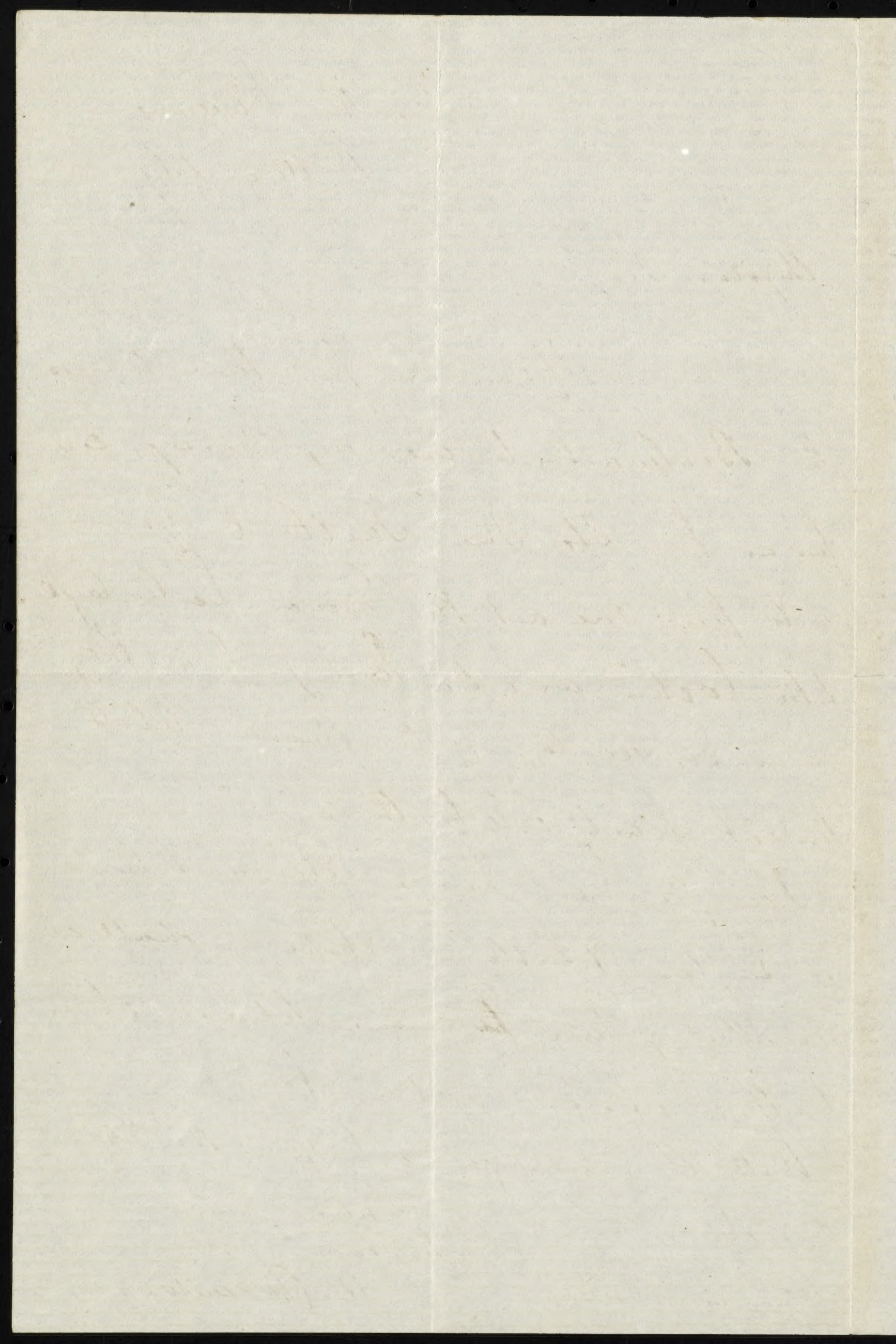
My dear Sir,
