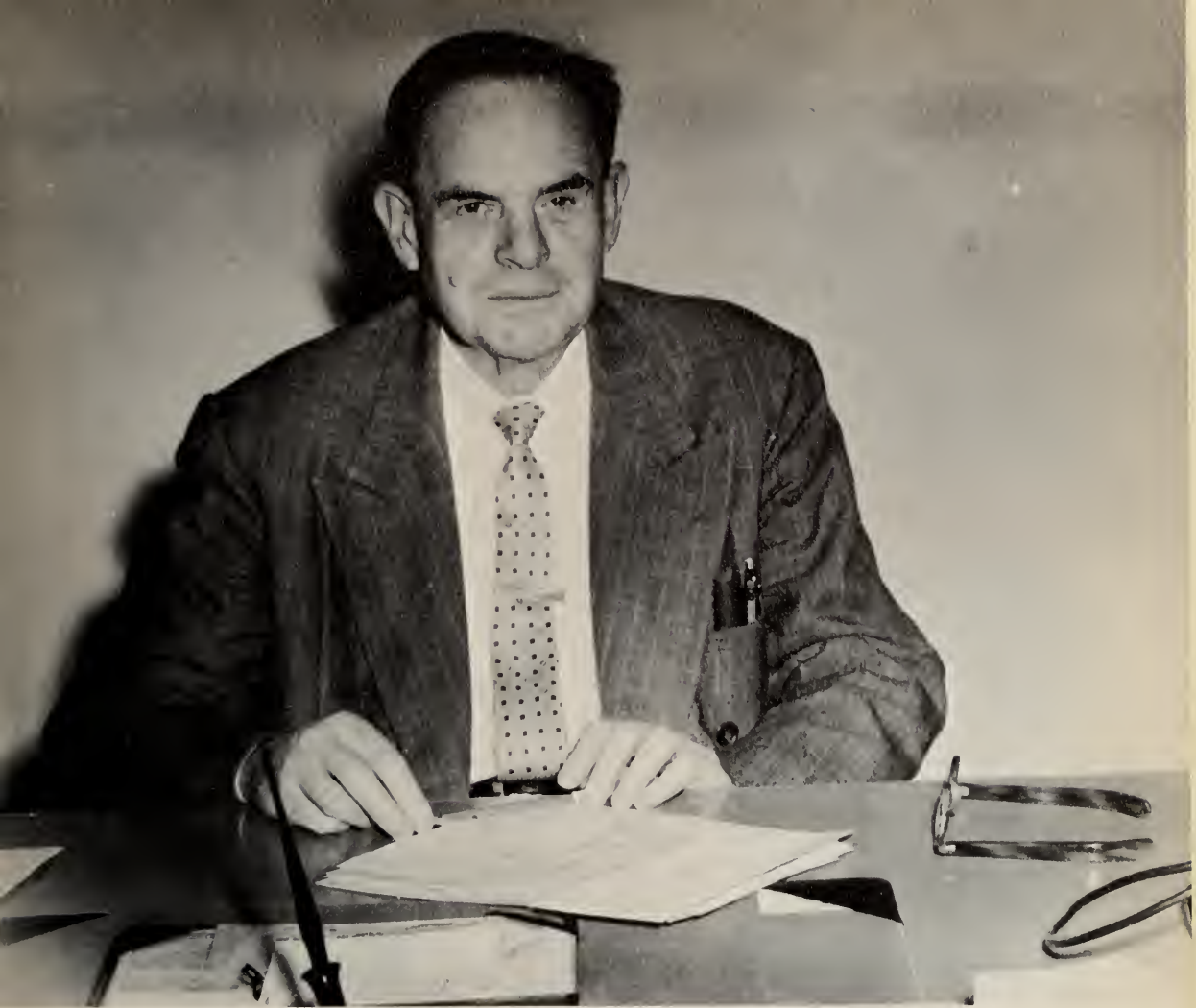




## *Principal's Message*

Then the outfield we have C. Smith, J. Riley, J. Rinset, F. Brumen, D. Fryer, D. Grant, and J. Vaught.

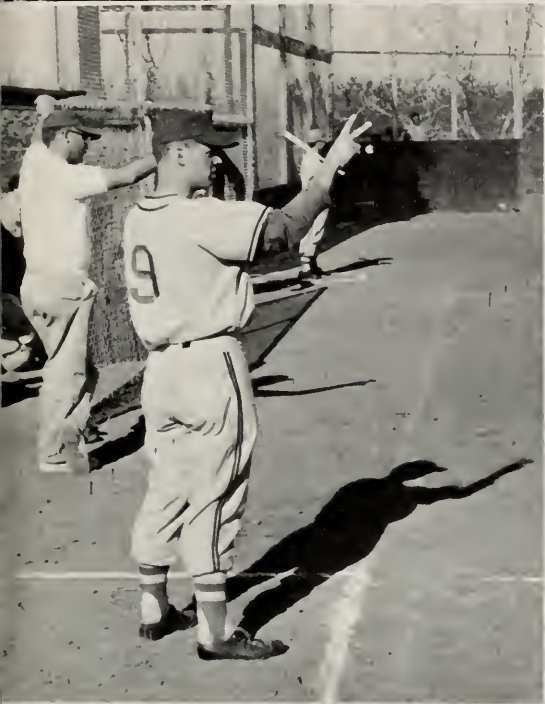
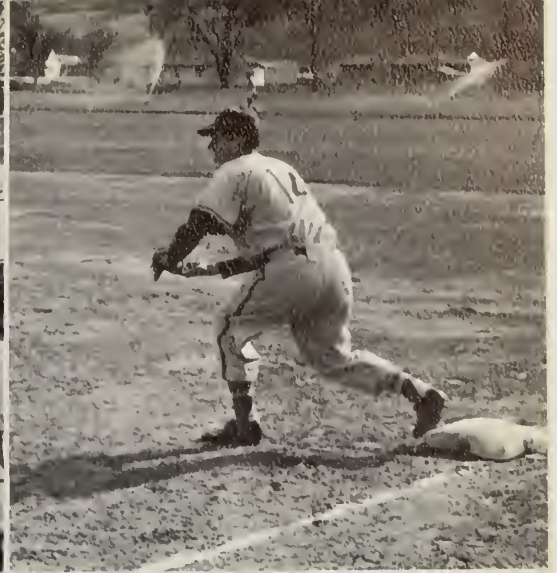

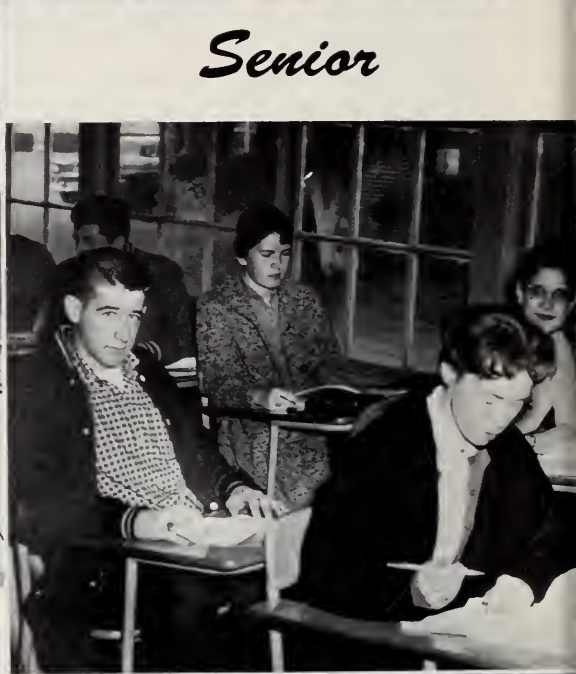
