Staff members learned that "cycle" became a new by-word as each department would be looked at as to needs and improvement needed.
This year the Art and Language Arts Departments were on cycle and spent numerous hours scrutinizing their classes and programs to see who, what, when, where, why and how the needs of the students would bo bost met.
Two new department chairpersons were named. Replacing Mr. Gerald Crawford in math was Miss Carolyn McNabb while Mr. Bill Batze took over in social studies for retiring Mr. Pete Soringer.
