

Led by David Winthrop, president; Charisse Frazier, vice-president; Cheryl Richards, secretary; Rob Brandt, treasurer (second semester); Andrea Helecker, treasurer (first semester); and Mr. Ellrie Von Schopp and Mrs. Doreen Forlow, advisors; the Class of 1982 had a busy final year. Starting with a third place finish in the float competition at Homecoming to graduation under overcast skies, the seniors kept busy.


































The Art Department, in addition to curriculum review, had students paint a mural in the gym and decorate windows of Brentwood merchants at Christmas time.
