Schim Schimmel

Schim Schimmel was born August 10, 1954 in Tuscon, Arizona. He studied art with his father, William B. Schimmel, a nationally recognized watercolorist and art instructor. Schim soon started teaching art classes himself in oil, watercolor and acrylic to thousands of students throughout the midwest and in Arizona. He taught for eleven years during the late seventies and eighties.

Today, Schim describes his acrylic paintings as Environmental Visionary Surrealism. His work's message is that we must share this planet with all its varied life. "The central theme of my artwork is the concept of planetary interdependency. I believe in an inherent unity and oneness pervading all manifested creation"

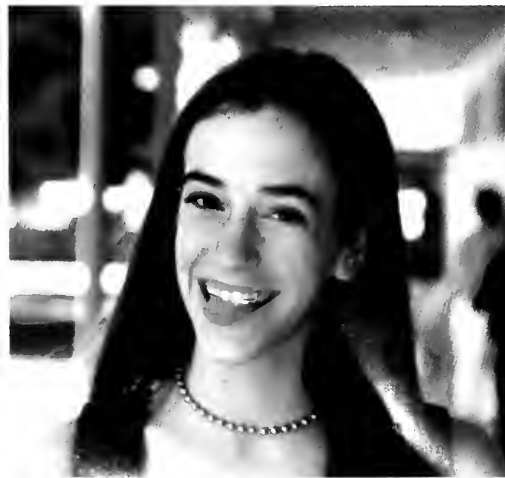

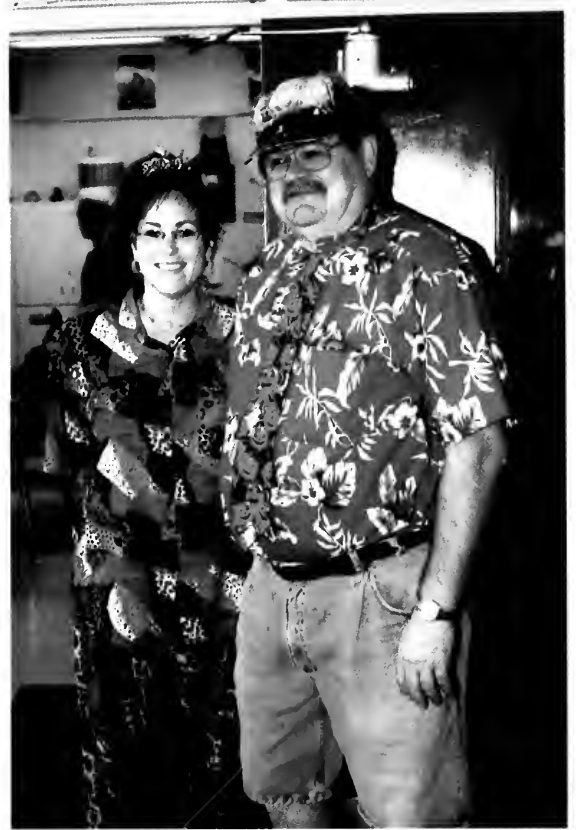

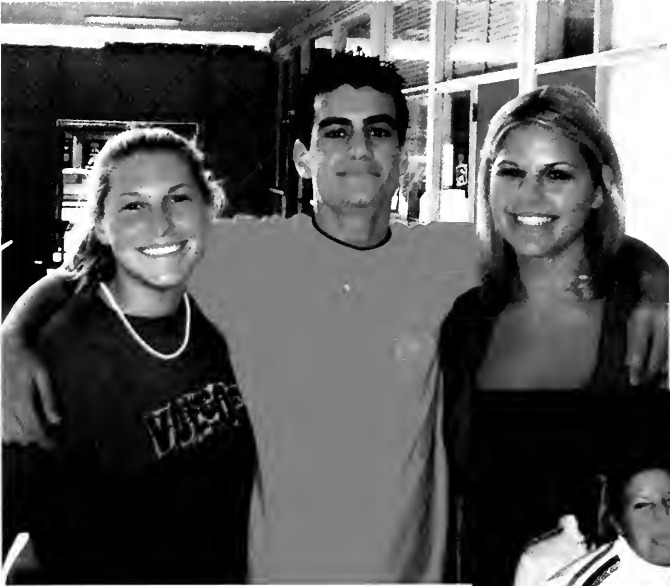

Art class taught us to cherish the beauty expressed even by drawing with chalk on the cement. Teachers were there to guide us and always lended a helping hand.

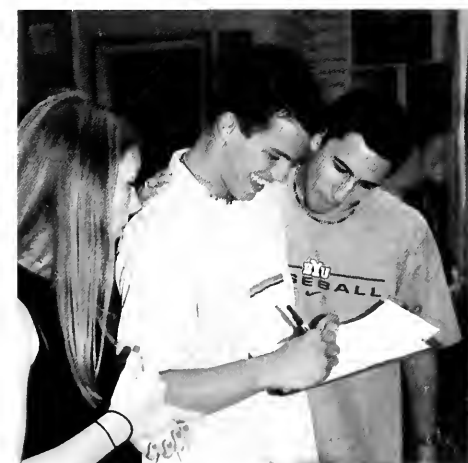
Friends "spot" us when we need help in our classes. And who could forget the smiles and the memories?

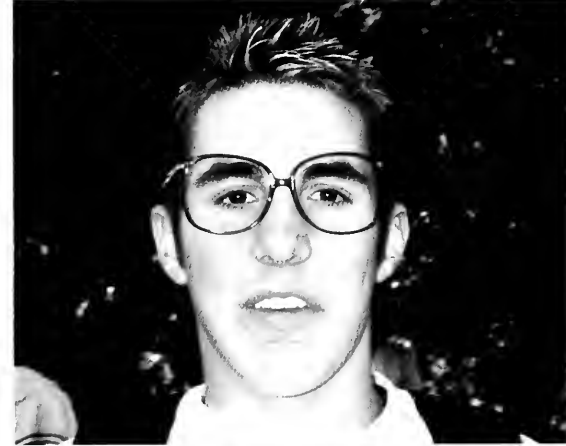

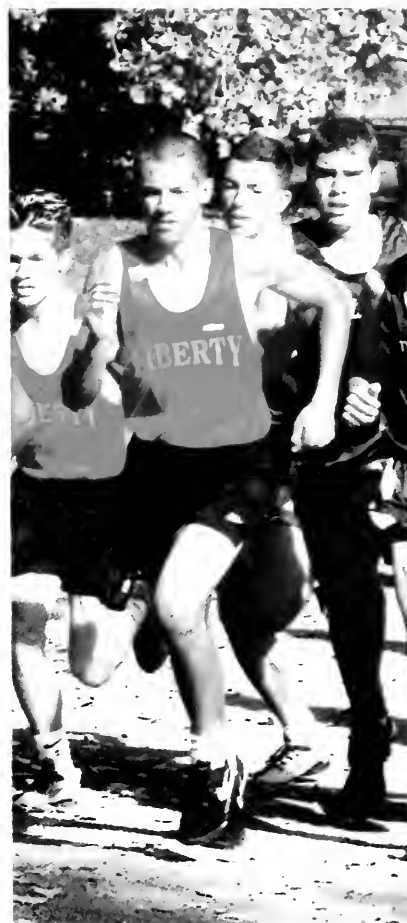

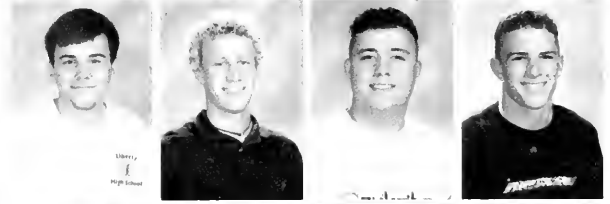
As juniors, we have learned about hard work through our classes, and about life through our friends. We even added the student parking lot to our list of places to hang out, as many of us started driving to school.

'Hanging by a Moment'

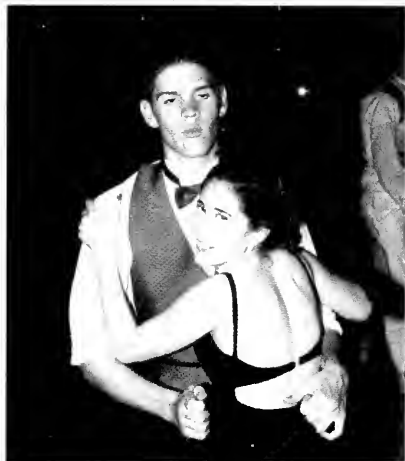

Varsity Captures Homecoming Victory

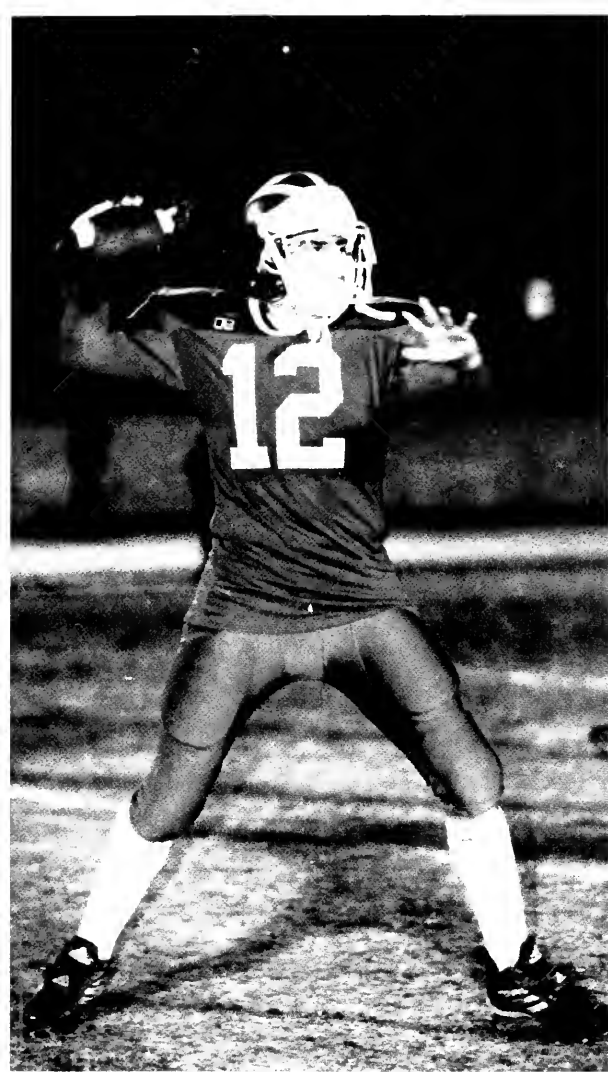

Coach Linda Ghilarducci was extremely proud of her team; she will sorely miss Webber and Cally Enos from the squad as both are seniors.

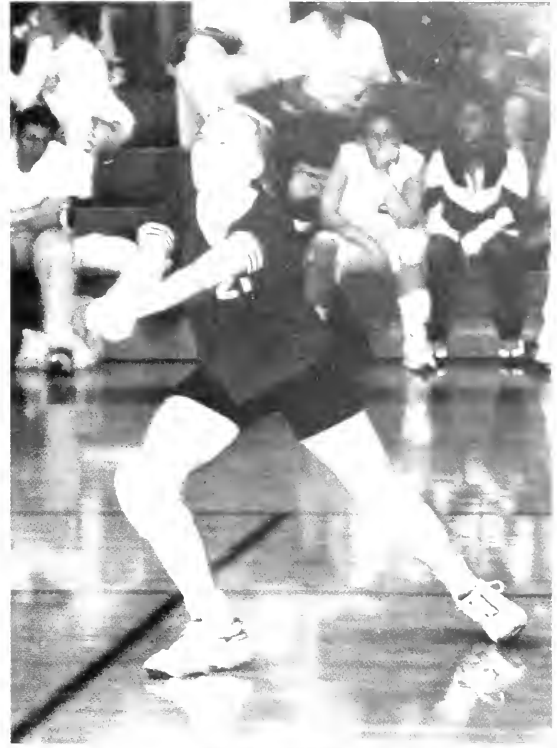

The girls were competitive players and worked well together both at home in Stonebarger Gym as well as on the road.



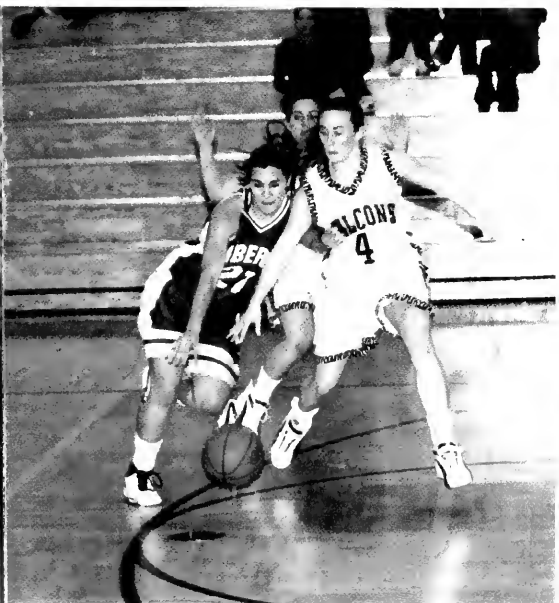

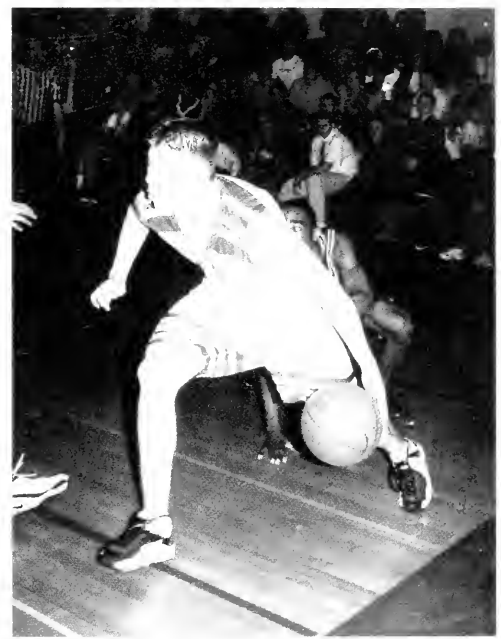
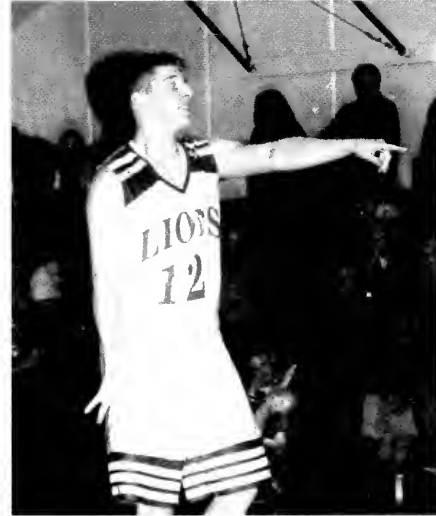


Young Varsity Squad Faces Tough Competition

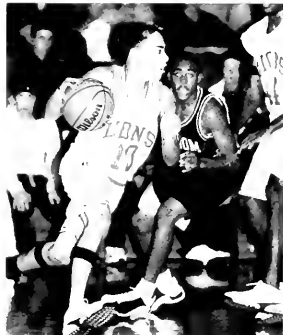

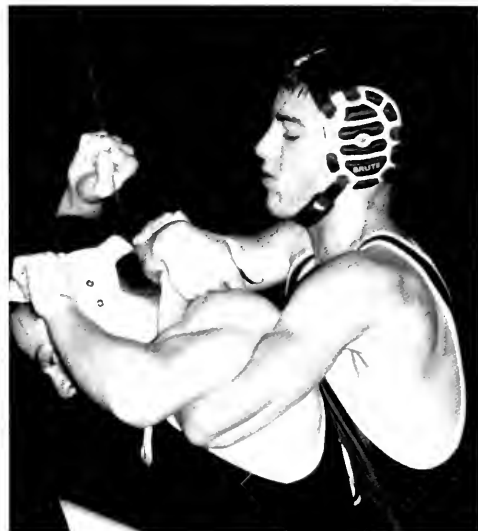


Varsity Wrestlers Continue to Dominate BVAL

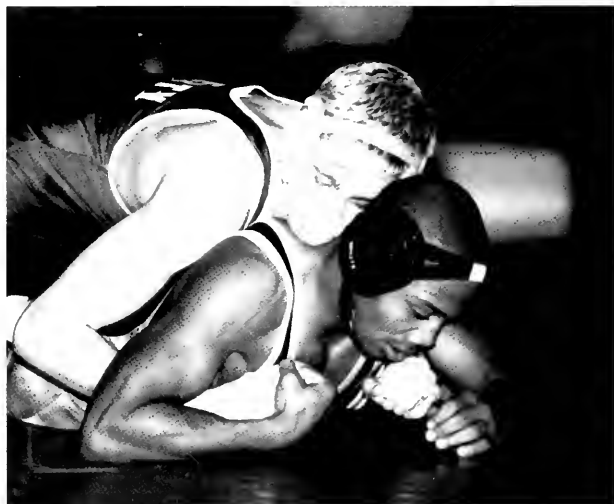

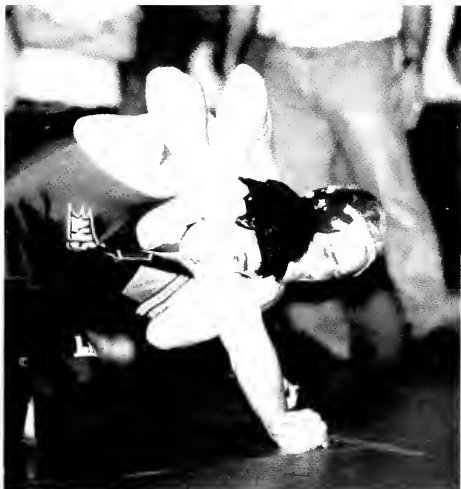

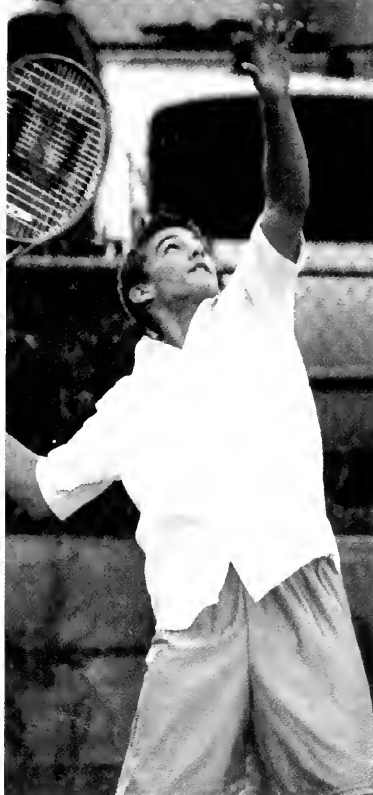

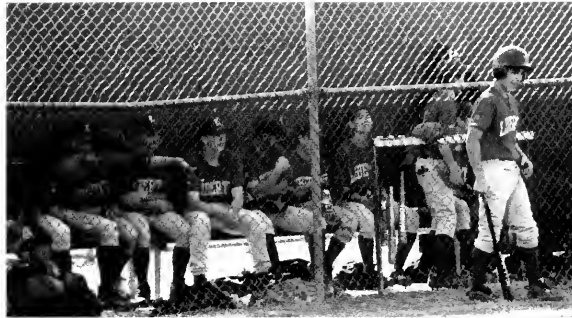

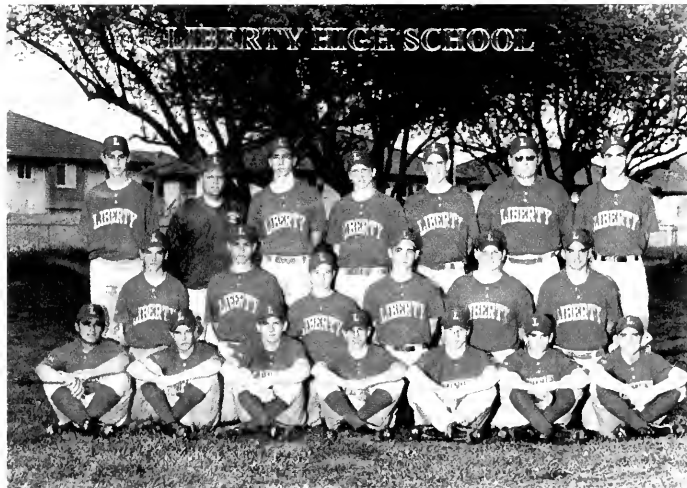

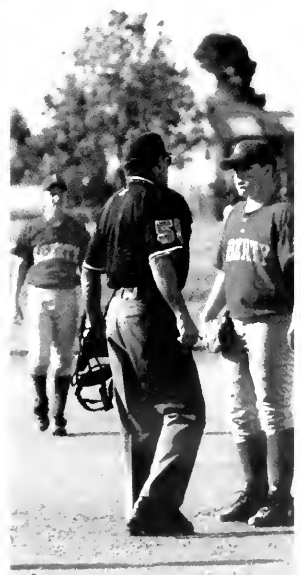

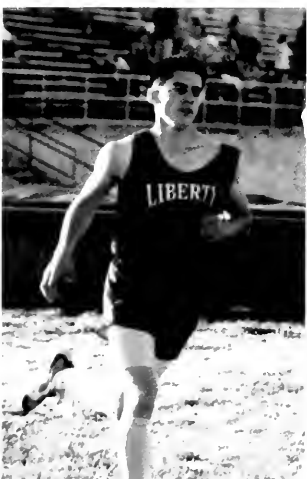
Track Team Sends 14 Runners to NCS

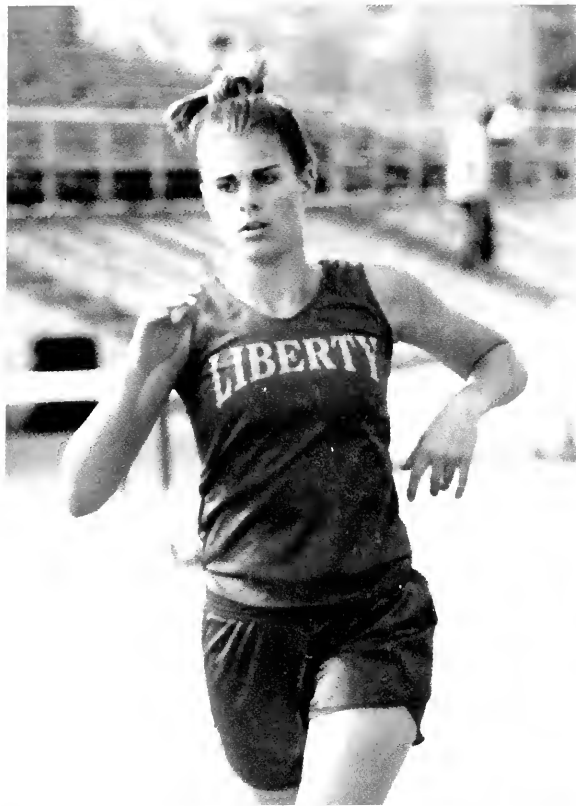

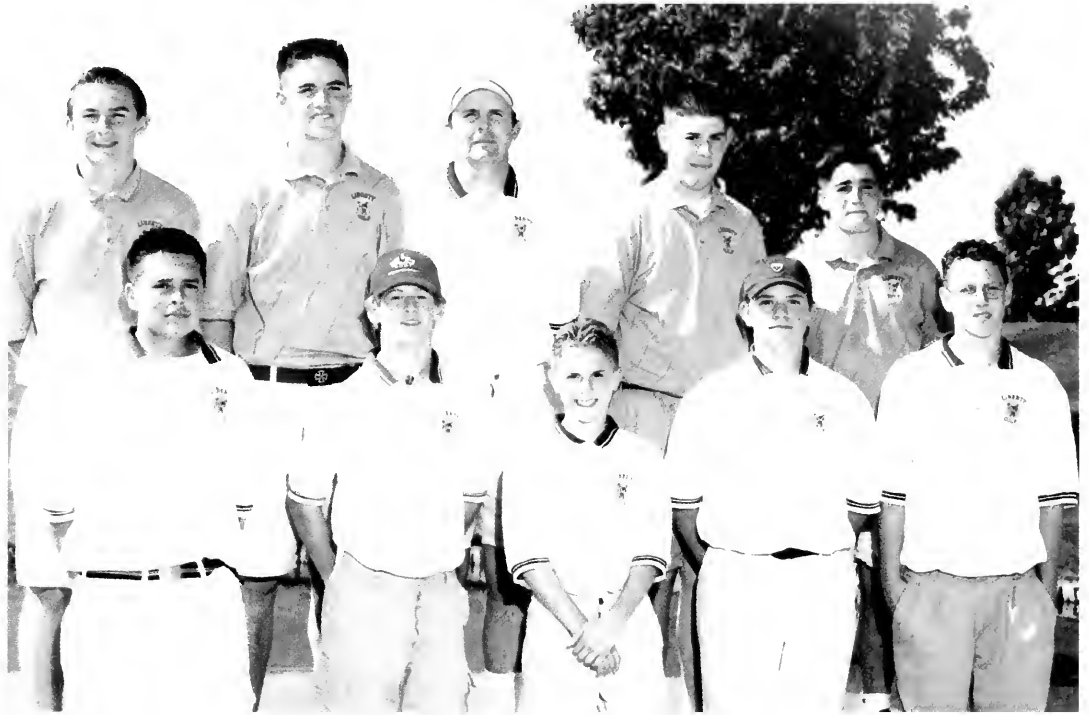

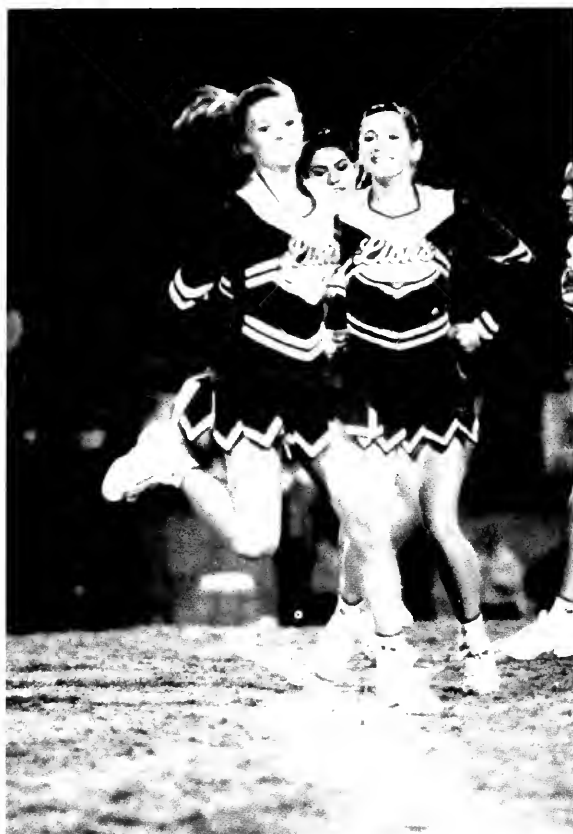

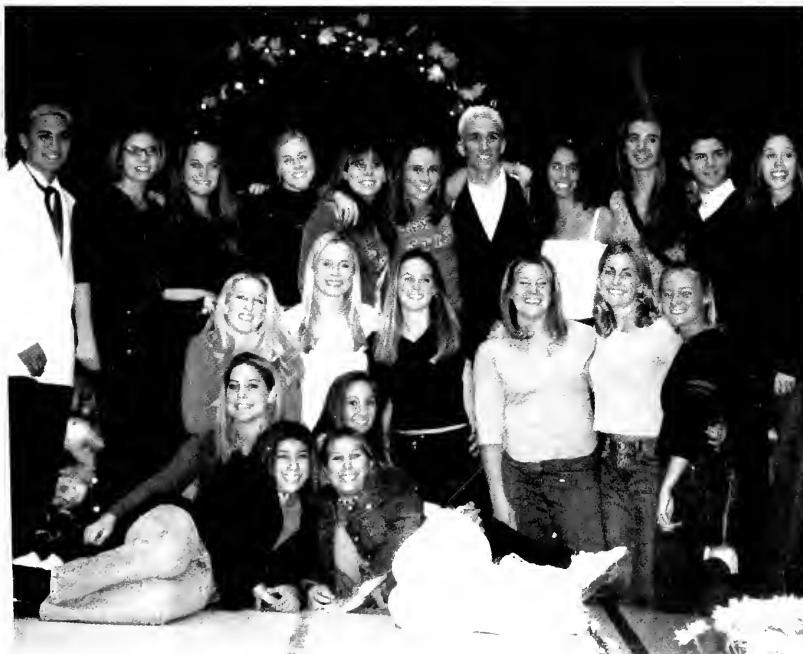
Varsity Cheerleaders Earn Tenth at Nationals

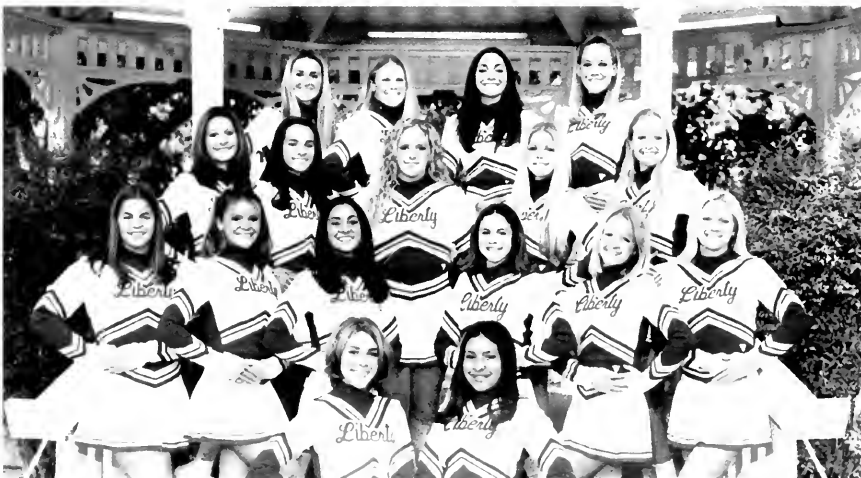

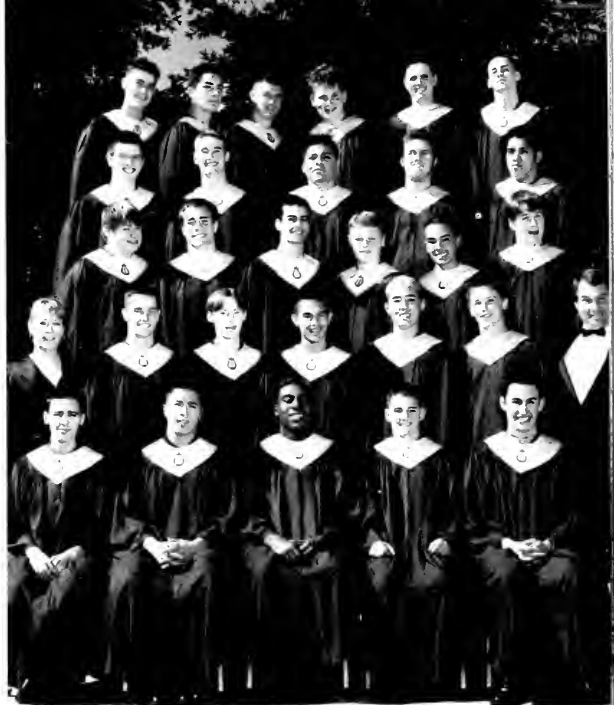

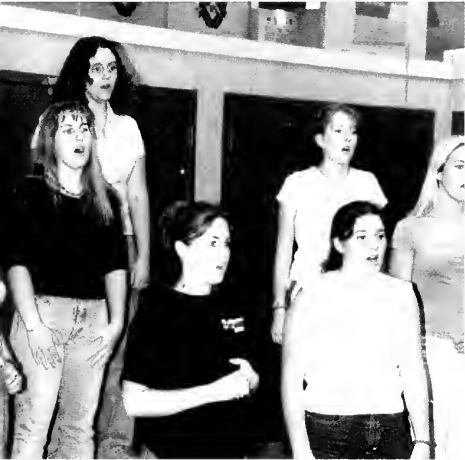

FFA Hosts First Youth Fair in Antioch

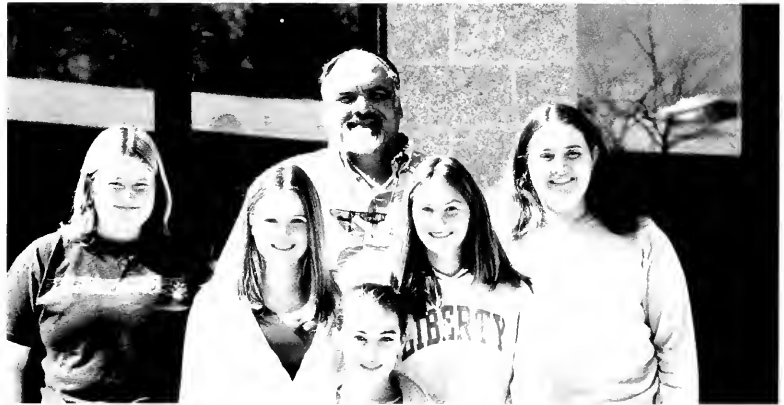

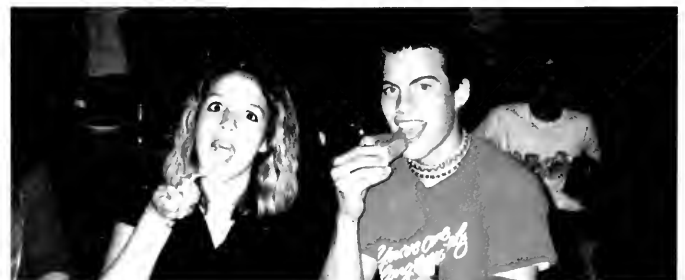

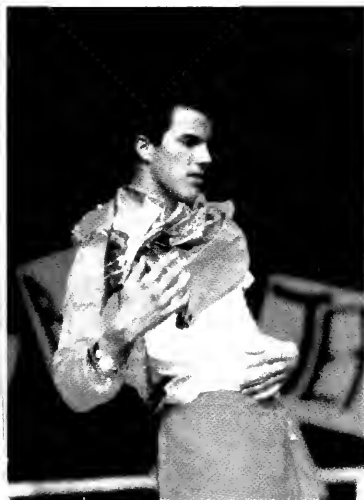

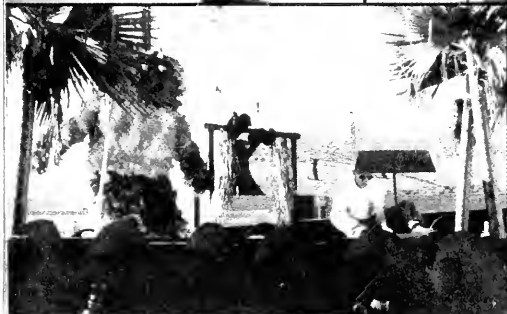

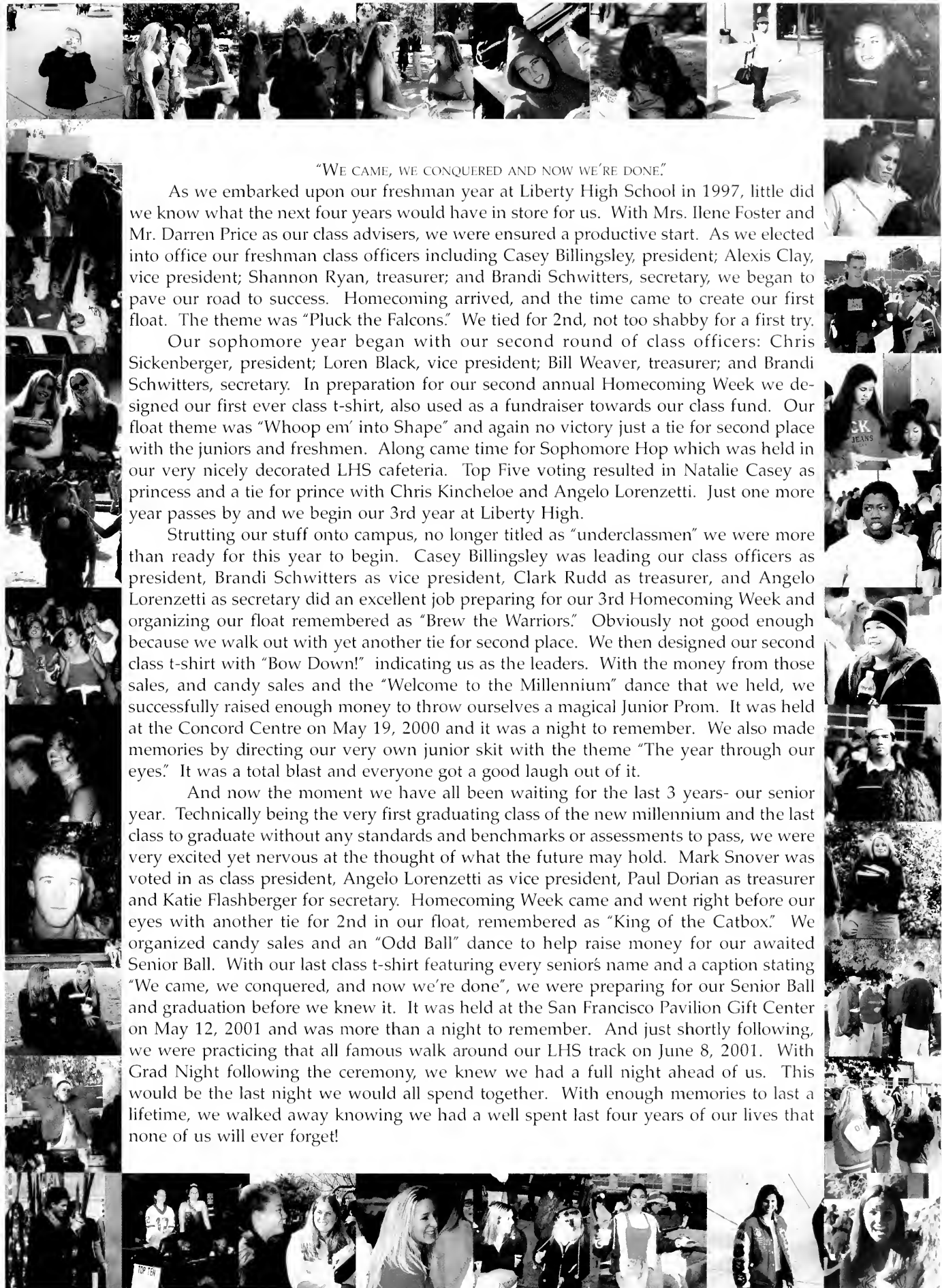
"WE CAME, WE CONQUERED AND NOW WE'RE DONE."

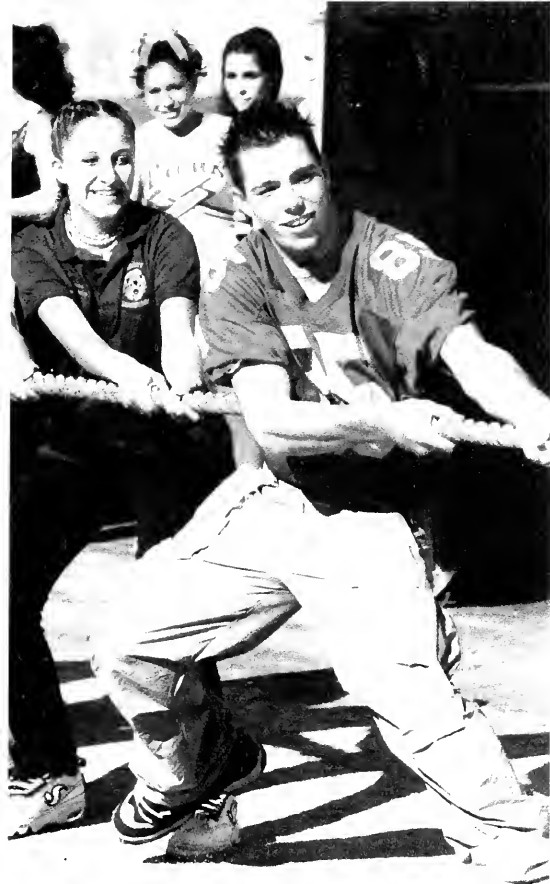

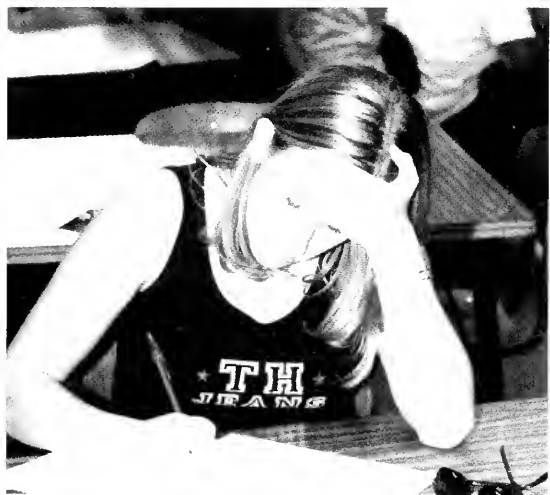

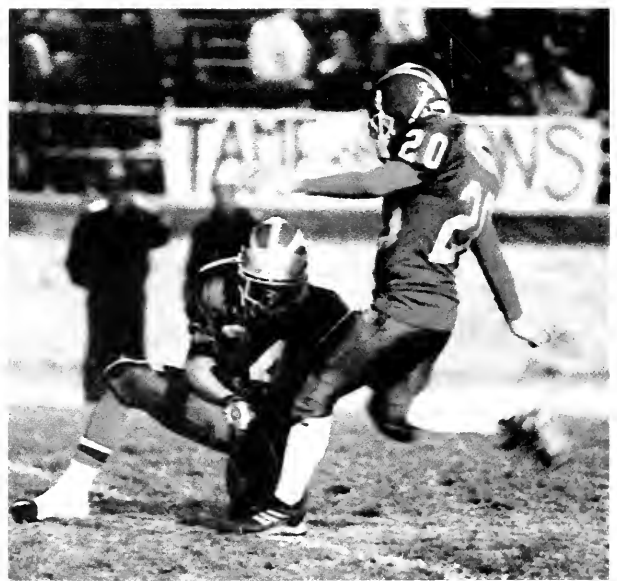

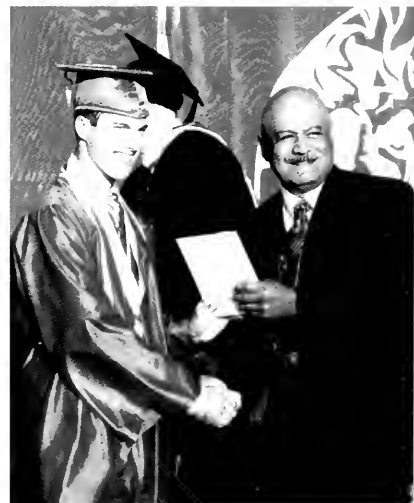

Bytheway, Hoffman Lead the Way for 2001

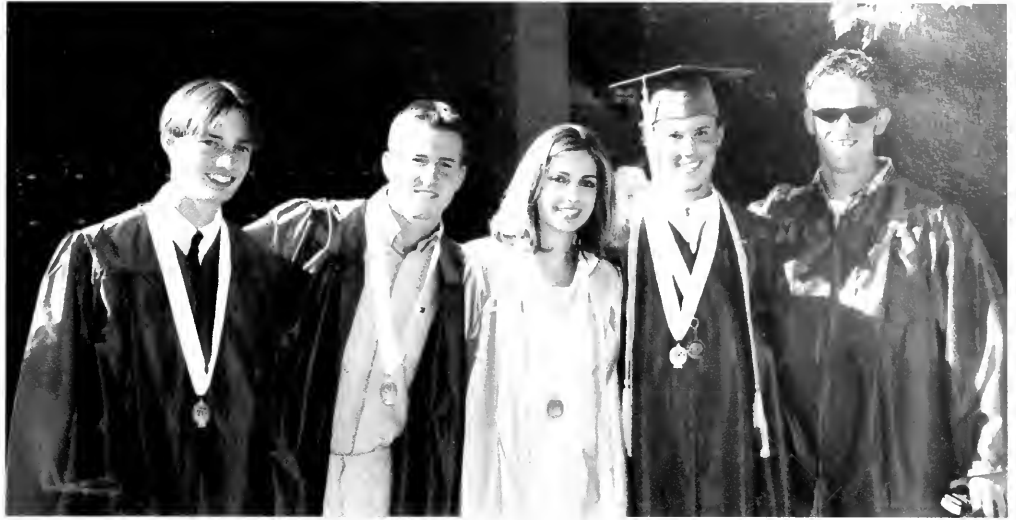
