MATTHEW AGEЕ CHAPTER

On December the 15th, 1955, under the leadership of Mrs. Frank J. Fava, organizing president, Matthew Agee Chapter, Colonial Dames of the Seventeenth Century was organized in Shreveport.

Mathieu Agee, the first of the name in America, was born near Nantes, France ca 1670. The family was of noble birth, but because of its espousal of the Huguenot faith, was forced to give up its claim to nobility when its lands were confiscated by the French government after the revocation of the Edict of Nantes by Louis XIV.

Accordingly, Mathieu Agee left France in 1688, went to Holland, and with some two thousand Huguenots joined the ranks of William of Orange and accompanied his troops to England. Later, William offered free passage to the new world to as many as wished to go, and free land grants to those who wished to till the soil. Mathieu Agee arrived in Virginia in 1690, received land grants west of Richmond and built a plantation home about seven miles from the site afterwards chosen by the Huguenots where was founded the town of Manakin. Here was established a church, King Williams Parish, and Mathieu Agee was for a great many years a communicant there. This church still exists, and in October 1936 a memorial tablet was placed in the church by descendants of Mathieu Agee in his honor.

This man was an ancestor of Mrs. Fava and in appreciation of her work in organizing this chapter, his name was selected as the name of the chapter.

Miss Mabel C. Gupton, President General, appointed Mrs. E. L. Kelly as State Organizing President of the Louisiana Society of the Colonial Dames of the XVII Century April 2nd, 1949. The National requirements are that fifty members constitute a State Society. Before the required number was completed Mrs. Kelly resigned. Mrs. Earl Middleton, President General, appointed Mrs. J. E. O'Donnell as State Organizing President, March 12th, 1952.

The name Isaac Monet, an ancestor of Mrs. E. L. Kelly, was selected as the name for the first chapter to be organized.

After the required number to constitute a State Society was elected, a committee was chosen to serve as the Nominating Committee to nominate State Officers and consisted of Mrs. W. H. Adams, Chairman, Mrs. W. B. Gurney and Mrs. E. L. Kelly.

On November 13, 1954, the Louisiana Society of the Colonial Dames of the XVII Century held the election and installation of State Officers at the Louisiana Room of the Heidelberg Hotel at 10:00 A.M. Mrs. J. E. O'Donnell, Organizing State President, presiding.

Mrs. J. W. Thornton, President General, installed the newly elected officers and presented the State's Charter to the newly-elected State President, Mrs. Robert Anderson Stafford.

COLONEL JOHN PAGE CHAPTER

Named after Colonel John Page, son of Francis Page, gentleman, of Bedford, Middlesex, England.

John Page was born in 1629 in England and came to Virginia in 1650. He owned Middle Plantation, Bruton Parish, a part of which is now Williamsburg. Together with his wife Alice Lukens, daughter of Sir Edwin Lukens - member of the Virginia Company, he gave the land on which the Bruton Parish Church and Churchyard are now located. His original elevated, flat tombstone bearing the Page Coat-of-Arms, broke into several pieces when the grave sank. It was put together and is in the foyer of the Church. In its stead an obelisk was erected. This, too, bears the Page Arms. Alice Luken's grave at the side of John Page's bears the Lukens Arms as she was her father's only heir.

Col. John Page was one of the first movers for William & Mary College. He holds a very prominent place in the history of early Virginia settlers.

He died in Gloucester County January 23, 1691/2. His will is recorded in the Clerk's Office, Yorktown, Virginia.

ROBERT RUFFIN CHAPTER

ROBERT RUFFIN came to Virginia in 1636 at the age of eighteen. He was the great grandson of the Earl of Gowrie, a romantic patriotic figure in the history of Scotland known as "Gray Steel" who appears in the works of Sir Walter Scott. The Ruffin family was banished from Scotland and the Earl himself beheaded after Gowrie and a group of discontented nobles captured their king, James VI of Scotland (later James I of England), and forced him to sign a proclamation vowing to end royal tyranny over the Scottish barons and to exile the hated favorites of James to France. Later, when James became the King of England, these favorites were restored to power and demanded the heads of those who had exiled them.

Robert Ruffin himself lead a distinguished career in the New World as the High Sheriff of the Isle of Wight County in Virginia. One of his descendants was the founding president of this chapter of the Colonial Dames.
