RECENT GRADUATES CONTINUE TO SET PACE

In looking over the report of class participation in the 1972 Fund, one has to be impressed with the record of our two most recent classes--1970 and 1971. (The Class of '72 will be solicited for the first time in the 1973 Fund.)

With 29% and 26% participation respectively, they are far out in front of all other classes in the four-year college category. Their loyalty to their alma mater serves as a challenge to all other classes. May your participation in the 1973 Lycoming College Fund equal or better that of our recent grads!

As this report is being prepared, the Class of 1973 is engaged in their Senior Pledging Program. Their chairmen, captains, and workers are personally visiting each senior requesting a five year pledge to the annual fund. We wish the Class of 1973 great success in this project!

TWO FOR ONE

About 500 companies, both large and small, now have matching gift programs as a part of their effort to support higher education. The plan is very simple: for every dollar (within stated limits) given to an institution by an employee, the employer also gives a dollar. Some companies will match only alumni gifts; others will match gifts of any employee. Matching gift forms and instructions are available at participating company locations.

In 1972, Lycoming received matching gift support from twenty-one companies. In some instances, the same company matched gifts from several different employees. We urge all donors and prospective donors to find out whether their employers have matching gift programs. There is no easier or less painful way to double your gift.

BEQUESTS AND DEFERRED GIFTS

Bequests have always been important sources of support for private institutions in America. Many colleges and universities were founded and named for the benefactors who left all or part of their estates to them. Many college buildings bear the names of generous alumni, trustees, and friends whose major gifts have been in the form of bequests. During the past five years, Lycoming College has received almost \$800,000 through bequests from people who believed in the College and wanted to help improve it. In a few instances, we did not know our benefactors and have not been able to find out why parts of their estates were left to Lycoming College. As a matter of fact, we have no way of knowing how many wills the College may be written into at any time, because many people are reluctant to reveal such matters.

We believe strongly that all people should exercise the privilege they have to decide what happens to their estates when they pass on. This much is certain: if you do not draw up a proper will, the state has one already prepared that will determine what happens to your estate, large or small. Another thing is certain: if you die without a will, no charitable institution--church, college, hospital, etc.--will receive any part of your estate. All of it will go to your relatives (close and distant) and to the state. If you have no relatives, the state takes all!

Another important source of support for colleges is the deferred gift. There are several variations, each of which has a specific name. In general, however, deferred gifts are arranged so that the donor makes a gift (cash, securities, real estate, etc.) to the College but retains the interest during his lifetime. During the past five years, Lycoming has received deferred gifts totaling over \$175,000.

The four best known types of deferred gifts are: the gift annuity, the charitable remainder trust, the unitrust, and pooled income funds. Each has certain features that recommend it in specific situations. Two others, the short-term trust and the deferred payment gift annuity, offer additional variations to suit the needs of certain individuals.

While the advantages vary with the circumstance of each individual, deferred gifts generally provide:

1. An opportunity to make a larger gift to one's favored institution than would be possible otherwise.
2. Relief from the trouble and worry as well as the time-consuming task of managing investments and other funds or assets.
3. Tax advantages which often provide more spendable income.
4. Regular income payments, the amount depending on the age of the donor, the size of the gift, and the type of deferred gift selected.

Since this form of giving should be tailored to the circumstances and wishes of the donor, it requires the services of estate planning specialists--attorneys and tax accountants. If you are interested in making a deferred gift, we can provide you with additional information. In any case, however, we recommend that you also consult your own attorney and/or tax accountant.

CAMPUS NOTES

A team of five students from Lycoming College was named one of five outstanding delegations participating in the three-day University of Pennsylvania Model United Nations Conference held in late February on the Penn campus in Philadelphia.

Lycoming's delegation represented Albania in the UN assembly. Participating were Helene and Patricia Boinski, sisters from Blossburg; Kevin H. Way, of Hyde Park, New York; Michael D. Lyon, of Canton, and David A. Walsh, of Oxford, New York.

Joining Lycoming as outstanding delegations were Princeton, Duquesne, Georgetown, and the host school. The "Albania" delegation from Lycoming sponsored three of the total of eight bills submitted for consideration in the model General Assembly session held at the conclusion of the conference.

Dr. Michael G. Roskin, assistant professor of political science and faculty advisor to the delegation, praised the accomplishments of the students for their "good, aggressive work in committees" that resulted in three of the eight "Albanian" sponsored resolutions being considered by the assembly.

Two seniors, both THEATRE MAJORS, have reached the semi-finals in the National Theatre competition. Brenda Willcutt, of Springfield, Massachusetts, and James Knight, of Midland Park, New Jersey, have been recognized for their talent and ability after attending screening auditions for more than 1,000 candidates entered in the competition sponsored by the University Resident Theatre Association.

Miss Willcutt, a costume designer, and Mr. Knight, a scene designer, were among 300 students chosen in 14 regional auditions held in January. Candidates were competing in both acting and technical theatre for admission to special graduate programs in theatres across the country. Both candidates have contributed many designs to productions of the Arena Theatre during the last four years.

WINTER SPORTS IN REVIEW

Paced by a fine 12-5 season by the wrestlers and a commendable 12-11 total by the basketball team, the three Warrior winter sports teams compiled a composite mark on the winning side of the record for the first time since 1968-69.

The "winning" season of 26 victories and 25 losses came despite a 3-10 record set by a swimming team severely handicapped throughout the year by lack of depth. The composite record in 1968-69 was 26-17-1.

Coach Budd Whitehill's wrestlers, in setting the pace for the over-all mark, continued a distinction of not having a losing season since 1957, the year after the sport was first introduced at Lycoming. They were 2-4. However, the wrestlers just did narrowly keep the record intact in the last two years by recording .500 marks each season. Whitehill, the only coach in the 17-year history of the sport at Lycoming, now has one of the best coaching records in college wrestling annals with a mark of 139-60.

Wrestlers who compiled outstanding dual meet records during the recently completed season include Wayne Goodrow (190), 14-3 and the Middle Atlantic Conference championship; Steve Wisner (177), 15-1-1, and Dave Webster (118), 9-5-1. Webster is the only senior on the Warrior wrestling team.

THE CONCERT CHOIR presented eleven concerts in ten days on their annual mid-winter tour which began on March 2nd and ended March 11th. Under the direction of Walter G. Melver, professor of voice, the group sang in Binghamton and Niagara Falls, New York; Lansing, Michigan; Geneva and Tuscola, Illinois; Dayton, Ohio; Racine, Wisconsin, and Albion, Beaver Falls, Indiana, and Lewistown, Pennsylvania.

264 BLOOD DONORS helped Lycoming County regain its priority rating at the Red Cross visit on February 20th. Another thirty-three persons willing to participate were rejected for medical reasons.

Junior captain Rich Henninger, one of the finest college players in the nation, led the Dutch Burch-coached Warrior basketball team to a playoff spot in the Middle Atlantic Conference for the first time since 1967-68. The Warriors compiled a 7-3 mark in the conference but lost, 100-88, to Scranton University in the championship playoffs.

Henninger continued his outstanding play of the last two years and during the season moved into second place in career scoring behind Vince Leta, who recorded 1,880 points while playing for Lycoming from 1950-54. The 6-5 junior from South Williamsport ended the season with 1,631 career points. He piled up 568 points in 23 games and finished 17th in the nation among all small-college players with a 24.7 per game average. None of the team will graduate this spring.

Co-captains Steve Muthler and Steve Marshall were the most consistent winners for Coach Mort Rauff's swimming team that sometimes lost an opportunity for valuable team points with empty lanes in some individual events. Both Muthler, a senior, and Marshall, a junior, had fine years by winning several individual events, primarily in the medley and free-style.
