### COLLEGE TO CONFER HONORARY DEGREE

The Rev. Elwood C. Zimmerman, pastor of Calvary United Methodist Church, Harrisburg, will receive an honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree from Lycoming College in a ceremony on campus on Tuesday, March 18, it was announced by Dr. Harold H. Hutson, president of the college.

The honorary degree will be conferred in conjunction with a continuing education seminar to be conducted at Lycoming by the Committee on Higher Education and Campus Ministry, Central Pennsylvania Conference, United Methodist Church.

The Rev. Mr. Zimmerman is a graduate of Dickinson Junior College, now Lycoming College, Bucknell University, and the Wesley Theological Seminary. He began his ministerial career in 1944 at the Montandon Methodist Church. He served pastorates in subsequent years at Snydertown, Wallaceton, Howard, Mechanicsburg, and Huntingdon before accepting his present position in Harrisburg in 1965.

### MODEL U. N. DELEGATION WINS RECOGNITION

A student delegation from Lycoming College was the only small college representation to win an award from among the more than 45 institutions participating in the Model United Nations Assembly held in February at Princeton University.

Two committees, each comprised of three Lycoming students, represented Iceland and Greece at the four-day assembly.

The "Iceland" committee was represented by Michael Cheslosky, Mark Bergren, and Richard Adams, and Cheslosky, who was appointed delegate head of the committee, was selected as the best delegate in the legal committee. The delegation was also awarded second runner-up for its performance during the General Assembly.

The "Greece" political committee consisted of Douglas P. Trump, Keith A. Kaiser, and Steve Smith. Trump was selected first runner-up for his performance as delegation head.

Lycoming has been participating in Model U. N. since 1953, and its student delegates have won recognition on numerous occasions.

### Explanatory Note

We know it is confusing to some of our constituents to see so many different funds, summaries, etc. Perhaps a brief explanation will be helpful.

The summary on page 1 accounts for all gifts and contributions received for all purposes from all sources in 1974. The total of \$512,472.28 includes the Lycoming College Fund and the Lycoming Progress Fund as well as the Loring B. Priest Library Fund and the Choir Tour Fund.

The Lycoming College Fund was once called the Alumni Fund and the Annual Fund. It is an annual fund, the purpose of which is to help defray the cost of operating the College each year. This fund is unrestricted and can be used where it is most needed. All unrestricted gifts from alumni, parents, friends, business, industry, and foundations become a part of the Lycoming College Fund. More than 1100 contributions totaling \$62,798.28 were deposited in this fund for 1974.

The Lycoming Progress Fund resulted from a capital campaign in 1968. Its purpose was to provide funds for new buildings and equipment. Approximately \$1.5 million was pledged and about \$220,000 remains unpaid. Some pledges covered a ten-year period.

The Choir Tour Fund is not listed separately in any of the summaries because it is not a

**FUTURE LOOMS BRIGHT FOR WARRIORS**

"Wait until next year!" was often heard around the Lycoming campus in the waning days of the winter sports season as both the young basketball and wrestling teams finished strong to arouse an air of optimism about their prospects for 1975-76.

Although Coach Dutch Burch's basketball team, comprised mostly of freshmen and sophomores, struggled to a 2-11 record in the first 13 games, they came on strong in the second half to win 5 of the last 12 for a 10-15 overall mark. They were promptly tabbed as the "Comeback Kids" for the exciting rebound from a disastrous first half. However, the turnaround didn't come in time to win them a spot in the Middle Atlantic Conference playoffs.

Coach Burch, pleased with the way the Warriors developed into a winning combination, termed it "a satisfying season" and is obviously looking ahead to next year when the entire team will be returning.

The resurgence was led by Captain John DiMarco, a 6-0 junior guard and the only starter back from last year's regular season MAC champions. DiMarco topped the team in scoring with 370 points, followed by Ray Riggin, a 6-5 sophomore, 262, Jeff Billman, 6-6 sophomore, 251, Bill Conroy, 6-6 freshman, 243, and Jim DiMarco, John's 5-10 freshman brother, who scored 189 points.

Coach Budd Whitehill's wrestlers, also dominated by freshmen and sophomores, failed to finish at .500 or better for the first time in 15 years. However, a strong finish in the final two weeks of the season almost continued the streak. The wrestlers went into the final two weeks with a 4-9 record and then won 5 of the last 6 to end the regular season with a 9-10 overall dual meet mark.

Four Warrior wrestlers placed in the post-season MAC championship tournament. Craig Savitsky finished second at 158, Harry Shaw (142) and Dan Hartrauff (167) won their consolation bouts to finish third, and Gary Felthousen won fourth at 134.

Swimming Team I, scheduled against girl's teams from other colleges, was the only winter sports team to record a winning season.
