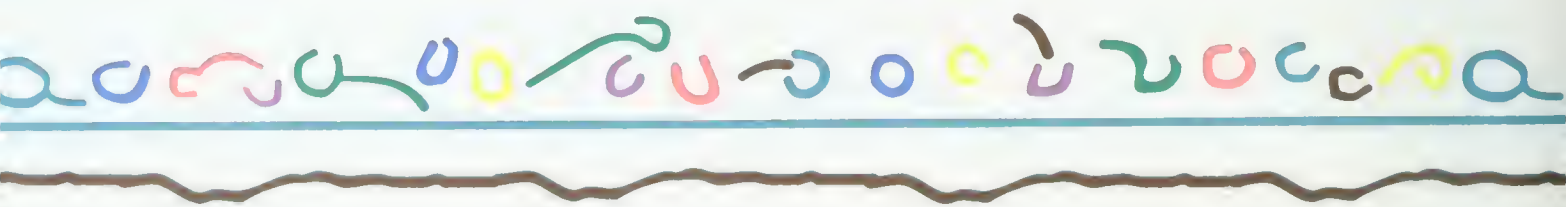

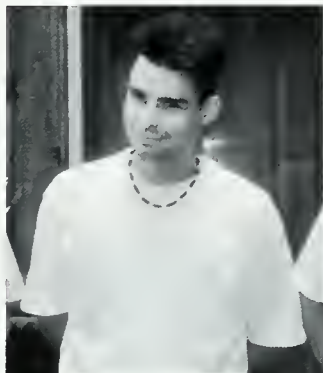
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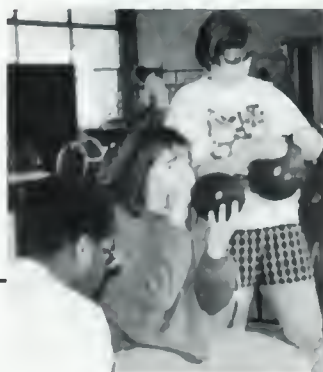

Dale and Steve are really feeling at home during the student council retreat at the lovely Nancy Doughty's. Steve looks a little too comfortable...



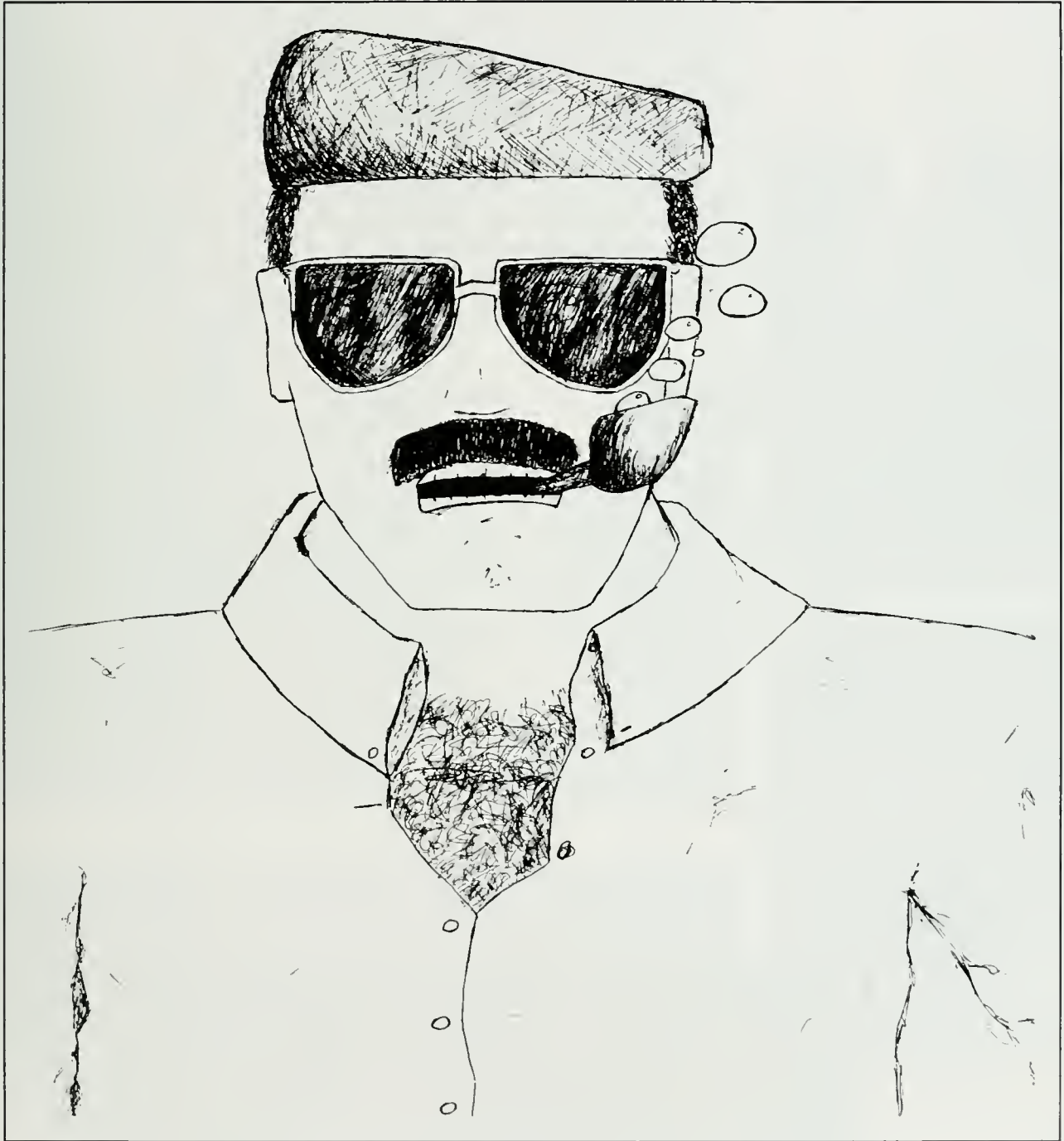
