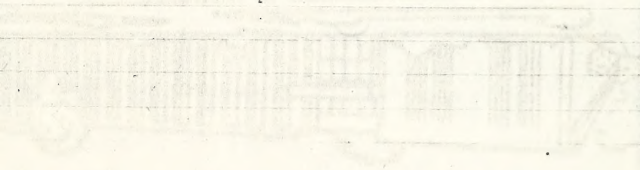

Samuel M<sup>c</sup>Kinstry (1) was born in the north  
of Ireland, in 1721 during the reign of  
King George I. of England, and came  
to America in 1739 with his brother Robert.  
It is probable that he sailed from Belfast  
and landed at Philadelphia. After  
staying about Germantown for sometime  
he moved to Bucks Co. Pennsylvania where  
he is supposed to have married.  
He had a sister in Ireland who was  
79 years old in 1803.

He and his wife are buried in Meshaminy  
Cemetery, Harrington Township, Bucks Co. Pennsylvania.

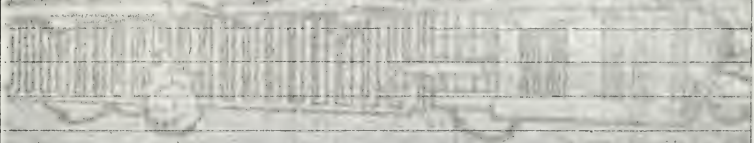

In 1838 his family moved into another house near the mill. In 1837 he moved on the farm now occupied by his son, Evan B. M<sup>c</sup>Vinstrey (48) near M<sup>c</sup>Vinstrey's Mills, Maryland, at first living in a house which was on the farm at the time of his removal thither until 1856 when he built the present dwelling. Here he lived at the time of his death on July 12, 1888. <sup>Deborah Engler, his first wife, was the daughter of Joseph Engler + Esther Binehart.</sup>

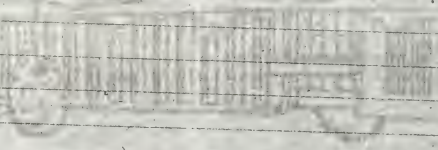
