Historical Sketch of the First Presbyterian Church of Stockton, N. J.

"Some twenty years ago (about) a Presbyterian Church was organized and a suitable house of worship erected, at Rosemont with which a goodly number of the families of Stockton were connected. But, in the course of time believing the location unfavorable, and the distance greater than convenient, a desire was manifested by them for a new organization and a location more eligible.

The Presbyterian families of Stockton and its vicinity have long had it in their hearts to build them a Temple for God, which they could call their own. An effort was made some four or five years ago, and a subscription put in circulation, but, for want of sufficient patronage it failed at the time, though it was never entirely abandoned.

In the Spring of 1867 it was found that there were at least thirty Presbyterian families in the village and its vicinity, a goodly number of whom were still desirous that a Presbyterian church should be organized and a house of worship be erected in said village, and believing the time had fully come for them to rise up and build, a subscription was speedily obtained amounting to \$3,500.

Being greatly encouraged by this success and having every reason to believe that the village would increase and that other Presbyterian families would come in, they felt it their solemn duty to take measures to secure the organization of a Presbyterian Church in connection with the (Old School) General Assembly in the United States of America, and the erection of a suitable house of worship."
