PUBLISHER'S ANNOUNCEMENT.

“**M**EN OF OHIO IN 1900” needs little or no introduction or preface. It represents the portraits of 1,068 representative men of the State of Ohio. No work of this character can be absolutely complete, and in several cases names are unavoidably omitted owing to the impossibility of securing portraits, although the date of publication was delayed to obviate this as far as practicable. Between the covers of this volume will be found pictures of men who have distinguished themselves in all the leading professions as well as in the manufacturing, wholesaling, jobbing and retailing industries.

Below each name will be found a brief title or description. For purposes of uniformity these titles are limited to two or three lines, and an effort has been made to select such descriptions as are most up-to-date and distinctive. To have enumerated every past and present office of some of those whose

pictures are given would have required nearly a page of space, and would have changed the work from a presentation of portraits to a collection of biographies.

An alphabetical index of portraits is appended. In the body of the work the classification is as accurate and complete as was possible to make it, but in a state of aggressiveness and public spirit, in which the leading men aid to respond to every movement for the common good, and where exclusiveness is the exception rather than the rule, no plan of classification by trades or professions can be invariably followed.

“Men of Ohio in 1900” is the result of careful and painstaking work, and will be preserved as a work of reference for generations to come. Never before has so complete a work of this character been published in Ohio, and it will be in almost daily use in newspaper offices and libraries, as well as in the homes of subscribers. As a portrait album alone, apart from its value as a work of reference, it is unique. Many of those who examine it will find accurate and artistic portraits of many of their personal friends and acquaintances. To make such a collection in the ordinary way would involve weeks of labor and a large outlay of money.

As to the photographs, more than 900 were made expressly for the book by the leading photographers of the State, and especial credit is due the well known galleries of Mr. Theo. Endean, and Geo. W. Edmondson, of Cleveland, who have made more than one-half of the entire collection; also to Messrs. R. P. Bellsmith, Cincinnati; F. J. Trost, Toledo; W. J. Porter, Youngstown; Courtney Studio, Canton; Snook and Killmer, Akron; Fred J. Becker, Massillon; Edmonston Studio, East Liverpool, and others.

The printing and binding was done by the well-known establishment of J. B. Savage, Cleveland, and it would tax the best effort of any printing house to equal it.

The engravings were made by the Columbia Engraving and Electrotyping Co. of Chicago, and will be found uniformly good.

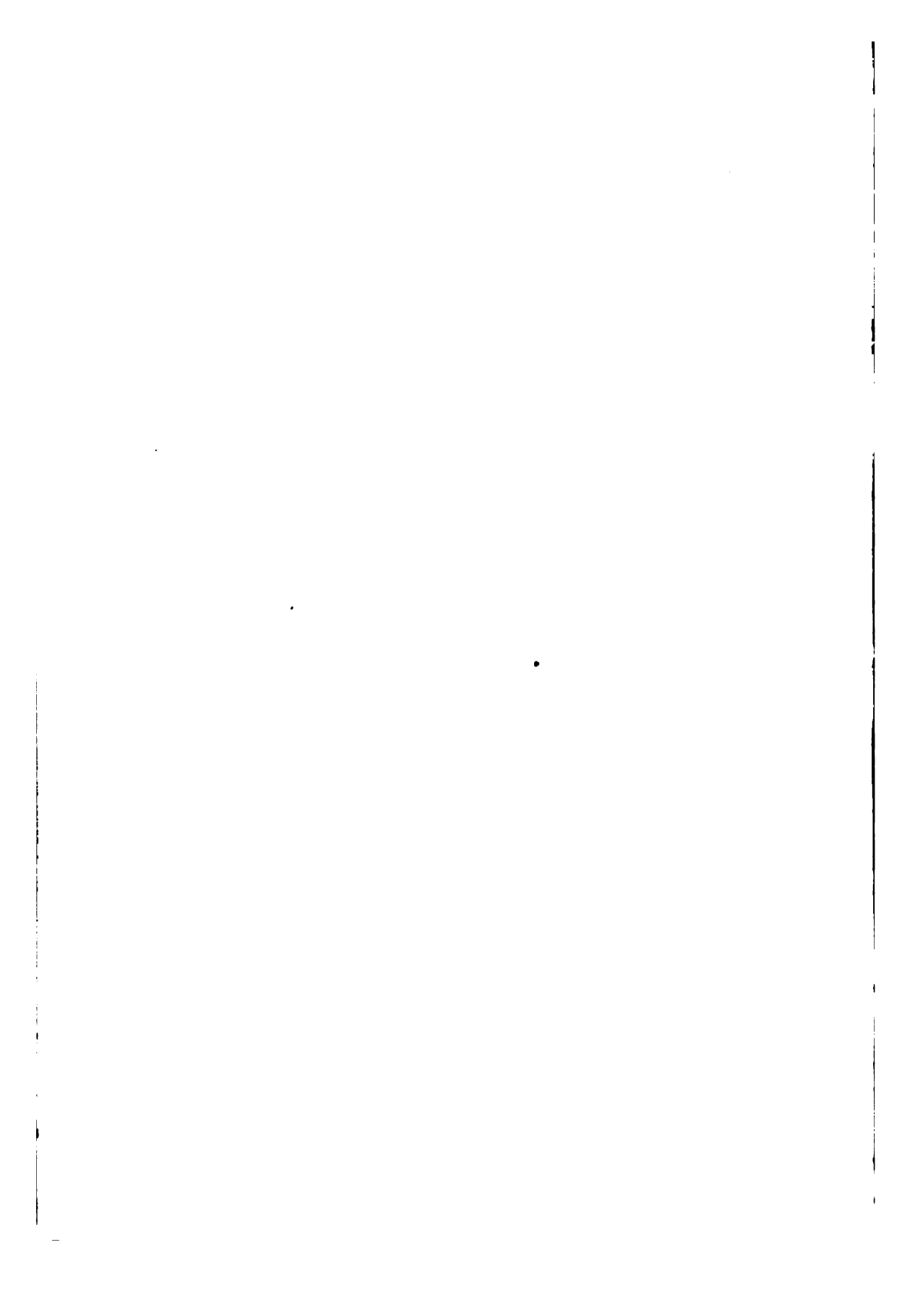
While the work is not absolutely complete nor perfect, the publishers hope that in its entirety the collection will merit the approval of the public.
