SIR: The subjoined table exhibits the extra clerks *anticipated*, as well as already *authorized* by you since my last estimate was submitted, and for whose payment an additional appropriation by Congress of \$25,000 will be required, viz:

Ten additional clerks authorized, February 1st to June 30th,
1863..... \$6,250

OFFICE OF THE QUARTERMASTER GENERAL.

Ten additional clerks authorized, February 1st to June 30th,
1863..... 6,250

FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION AMONG THE BUREAUX.

Twenty additional clerks anticipated, to meet increasing current business, February 1st to June 30th, 1863..... 12,500

Total amount..... \$25,000

If it meet your concurrence, I would respectfully suggest that Congress be asked to make the above appropriation at an early day.
