MINUTES.

Through the goodness and mercy of God, the delegates composing the Little Vine association, have been permitted to meet pursuant to adjournment, with the Fork of the Buttabatchie church.

I. The introductory sermon was delivered by A. J. Taylor, from the Prophet Isah, 59 chapter and 21 verse.

II. After a short intermission the delegates assembled in the house for business. Organized by J. J. Godsey, and appointed J. Winsett, clerk, pro tem. Prayer by A. J. Holcomb.

III. Called for letters from different churches and names of delegates enrolled. See total.

IV. Called for petitionary letters, none presented.

V. Elected J. A. Holcomb, moderator, and John Winsett, clerk.

VI. Called for correspondence letters. Received minutes from Buttabatchie association, presented by G. W. Noleh. Visitors seated, right and of fellowship extended to correspondence. Minutes from Moseell Shoals association, no correspondent.

VII. Appointed a committee on arrangements, viz: M. H. Glenn, B. W. Howell and W. M. Davis with the moderator.

VIII. Appointed a committee on preaching, viz: M. H. Glenn, B. W. Howell and W. M. Davis

A. M. Mays, E. W. Creel and J. A. Beasley.

IX. Appointed a committee on finance, M. H. Glenn and B. W. Howell.

X. Adjourned until Saturday morning 9 o'clock. Prayer by J. A. Owens.

XI. Saturday morning. Met pursuant to adjournment. Prayer by J. J. Godsey.

XII. Calling of the roll, a quorum found present.

XIII. Called for committee on arrangements. Report read, received and committee discharged.

XIV. Called for committee on preaching. Report received and committee discharged. They appointed J. J. Godsey and A. J. Taylor for the forenoon, J. A. Owens and J. T. Harris for the afternoon.

XV. Appointed the next session of this body to be held with New Hope church, Marion county, Ala. 7 miles north of Hamilton, commencing on Friday before the 3rd Sunday in Sept. 1895.

XVI. Elected J. T. Harris to preach the introductory sermon, J. T. Harris alternate.

XVII. Arranged district meeting to commence with New Salem church Itawamba county Miss. commencing on Friday before the 3rd Sunday in August 1895. J. A. Holcomb to preach, J. Winsett alternate.

XVIII. Elected Brother J. T. Harris to write circular letter

and present at our next session

XIX Elected brethren to fill the stand on Sunday, viz: J. A. Owen and J. T. Harris in the forenoon and J. A. Holcomb in the afternoon.

xx. Called for report of committee on finance. Reported from different churches \$5.

xxI. Appointed the clerk, treasurer, and instructed him to have 200 copies of the minutes printed and reserve 50 copies for correspondants.

xxII. M. H. Glenn and B. W. Howell distributing agents.

xxIII. Called for reading of corresponding letter, read and received.

xxIV. Moved and seconded that we send letter and messengers to Buttahatchie association by the following brethren, viz; J. T. Harris, J. A. Holcomb, A. J. Taylor and J. J. Godsey.

25. Called for circular letter, read, received and ordered printed in these minutes.

26. Called on the moderator to tender our thanks to the brothers and sisters and friends for their kindness to us during our stay with them.

27. Having gone through with the business of the association we adjourned to meet at the time and place set forth in these minutes

CIRCULAR LETTER

To the Little Vine Association now in session.

Dear brethren:

According to an appointment of your body at her last session you will expect, from me, something in the form of a circular letter based upon some portion of the scripture and for that purpose I have selected the following scripture as a subject to write on. 1st. Cor. 2nd. ch. 2nd. ver. "For I am determed not to know anything

among you save Jesus Christ and him crucified.

We first will notice that the person of Jesus was a man after the flesh, for Peter said Acts 2nd ch. and 22nd verse: "Jesus of Nazareth a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs which God did by him", also that he hath appointed a day in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath given assurance unto all men in that he raised him from the dead.
