

INTEELLO, one of the most beautiful towns in Indiana, is in an ideal location on the banks of the Tippevance river, some seventy-five feet above the bed of that stream, and is located almost midway between Chicago and Indianapolis, at the crossing of the Lozansport and Effiner division of the Pennsylvania Lines and the Chicago and Indianapolis division of the Monon Route. The town now has a population of about 2,500.

It is a town devoid of the "rougher element" and is an ideal place in which to create a home.

In the past ten years the improvements of the town, in the way of residences, business houses and public buildings, have almost doubled in value, and have given the town a great reputation wherever known.



Dozens of places can be found along the Tippecanoe, in close reach of Monticello, ideal for summer residences.


The town is prosperous now and has a bright future. If you are looking for such a place, do not overlook Monticello.








