Nearer to Thee!

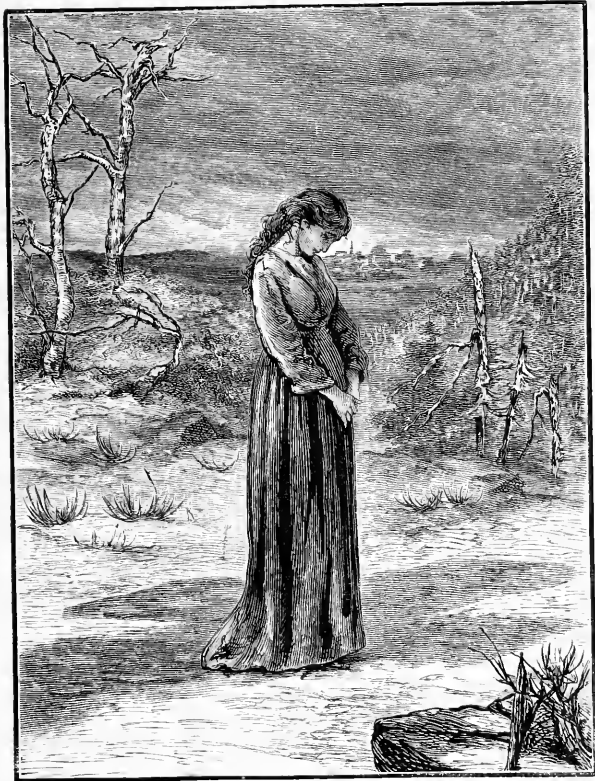
E'en though it be a cross

Daylight all gone,

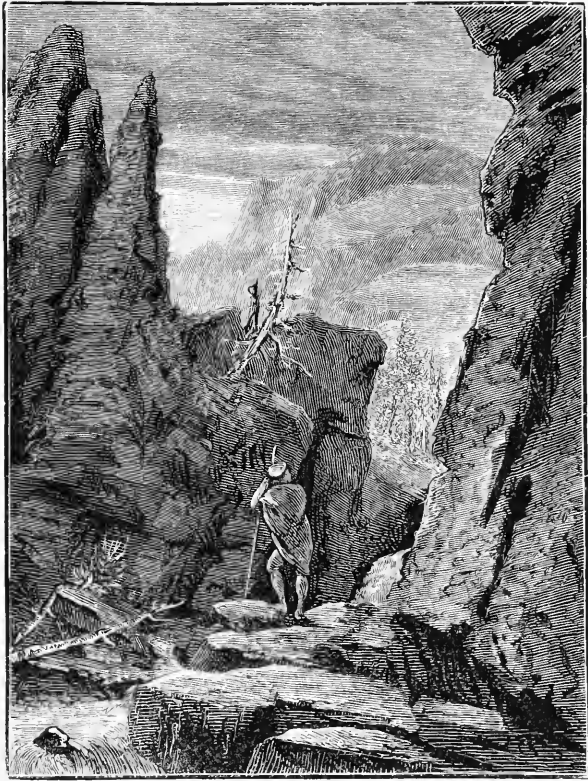
Darkness be over me,

Nearer, my God, to Thee,

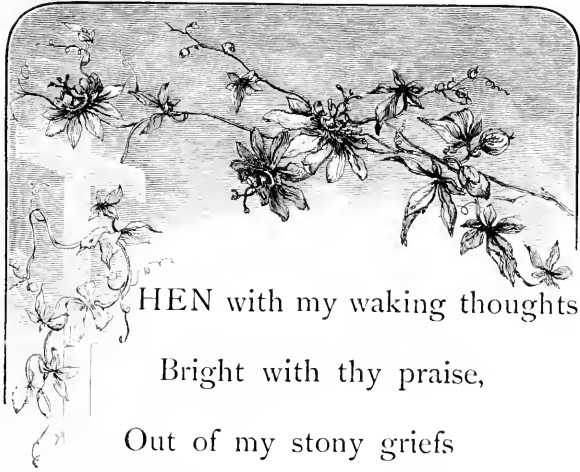
Nearer to Thee !

Bright with thy praise,

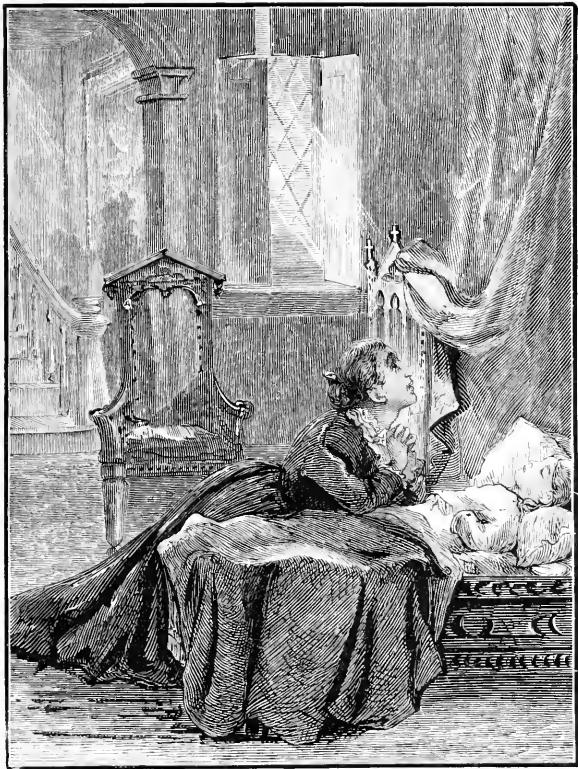
Out of my stony griefs

Nearer, my God, to Thee,

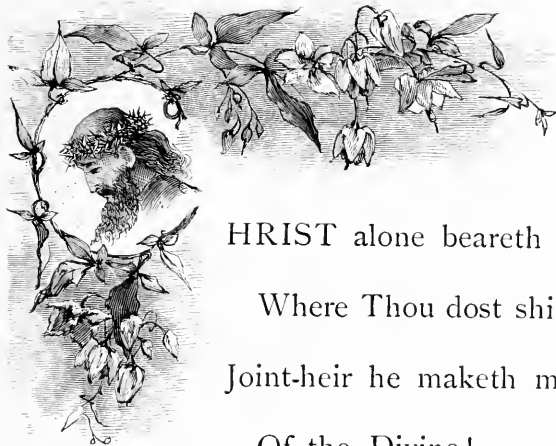
Nearer to Thee!

Nearer to Thee!



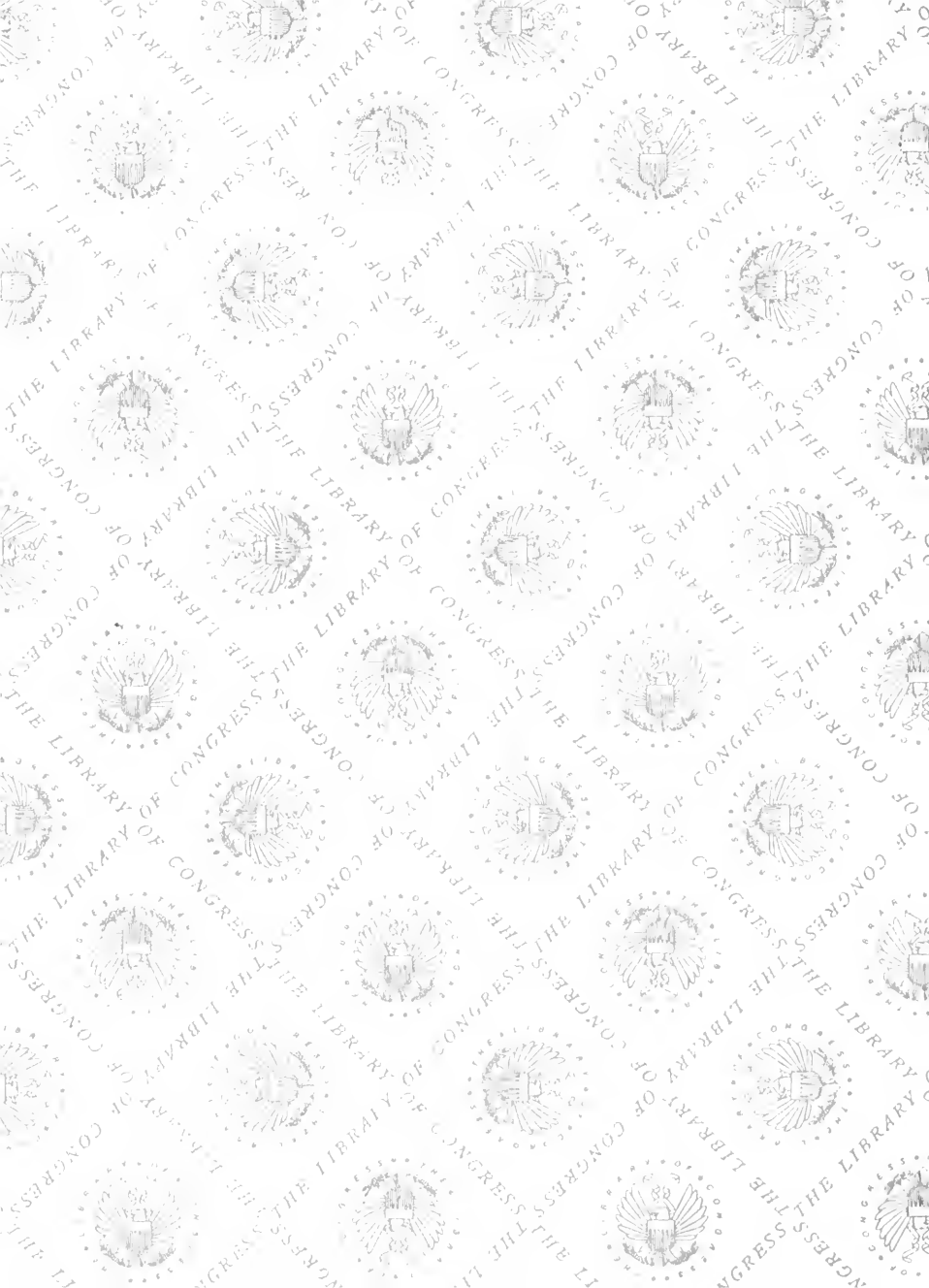


CHRIST alone beareth me
