ALUMNI PLEDGE \$138,808.00 TO FUND

Support of Development Campaign By Alumni Is Overwhelming

The Ahumni Fund of Lycoming College, still in its infancy (less than five years old), received a tremendous boost through the Development Campaign this spring. In 1956 the Alumni Fund totaled \$4,052 and last year crept up to \$6,026. The total of \$138,808 is for a three-year pledge which averages more than \$46,000 each year. This is roughly an increase of 750%, a percentage which staggers the imagination, and was beyond the wildest hopes of the most enthusiastic campaign workers.

Last year a Century Club was formed and certificates awarded at the Alumni Luncheon on June 1, 1957. Membership was obtained by contributing \$100 or more to the Alumni Fund of Lycoming College. Last year the club was very exclusive with a select membership of only ten alumni.

Century Club Multiplies


The eligibility requirements for this exclusive club were no less strict in its second year. Nevertheless, membership jumped from ten to eighty-four. This is a percentage increase consistent with the general increase of the Alumni Fund of Lycoming College over last year. Century Club certificates were awarded to the eligible members listed at right at the Alumni Luncheon on June 7, 1958. Many of those listed at right were present to accept their certificates and formally become members of the Century Club.

Warriors to Oppose Juniata Indians

As in 1956, the Homecoming Football game will once again see the Lycoming Warriors meet the Juniata Indians on the gridiron. None who witnessed the contest two years ago can forget the stuming upset which saw Juniata's unbeaten string of twenty-five games come to a sudden end. Juniata immediately returned to her winning ways and has another winning streak of thirteen games going into the 1958 season. Thus, Juniata's only loss in the last thirty-nine games was a 13-6 decision to Lycoming in 1956.

Last year, a flu virus forced Lycoming officials to close the College for eight days and cancel the football game with Juniata. The Warriors were scheduled to meet the Indians at Huntingdon for their Homecoming game. Thus, the featured athletic activity for Saturday afternoon, October 18, looms as a "natural." It is quite possible that both teams will enter College Field at 1:30 p. m. with unblemished records for the scason.
