# ALUMNI FUND . . . FINAL REPORT

\$30,000

GOALS

15% Participation

The Alumni Fund of Lycoming College closed its books for the year 1959-1960 on June 30. In the fall of 1959 the Alumni Fund Chairman, Henry Birkenstock, announced as goals a Fund total of \$30,000 with at least 15% Participation of the Alumni. A Progress Report in the April issue of the Newsletter suggested that the goal would only be reached through the receipt of some large contributions.

# \$56,341.37 GRAND TOTAL

The Alumni Fund Chairman, Group Leaders, and Class Agents can sit back with justified pride knowing that the goal of \$30,000 was greatly exceeded. In fact, even without the largest gift of \$25,000 the goal would have been met. The final tally indicates 518 alumni poured a grand total of \$56,341.37 into the Alumni Fund. The final two months of the fund year saw more than \$8,000 received. If there be a cloud on the horizon to cause any concern whatsoever, it would be the realization that these contributions came from only 11.71% of the Alumni. Nevertheless this is a significant improvement over the 7.2% of the Alumni who supported the Fund last year.

Many excellent reasons were given during the past year why you should make a contribution to the Alumni Fund. However, no reasons were forthcoming indicating the necessity of an Alumni Fund Report. Edison B. Allen, Coordinator of the Tulane Alumni Fund, has composed a bit of doggerel verse which may reflect the feelings of some alumni insofar as the need for such reports is concerned.
