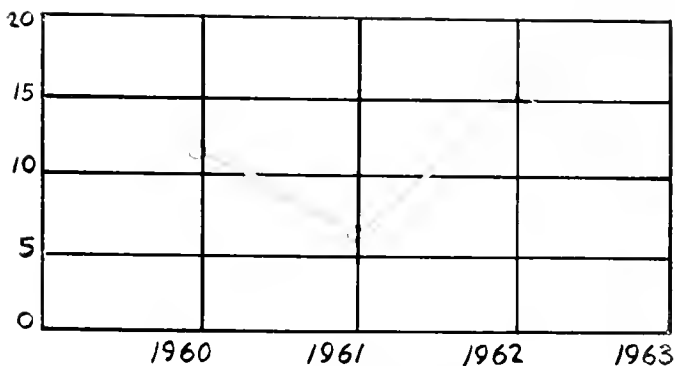

'62 ANNUAL ALUMNI FUND ... FINAL REPORT

THE LYCOMING ALUMNI FUND profited from the Sesquicentennial Bounce this year. Last year the *Newsletter* reported that the Alumni Fund has its ups and "downs." It came bouncing back this year with a record number of contributors.

Since the Annual Alumni Fund was begun in 1954 it has gone through a variety of birth pangs usually associated with new fund drives. It has fluctuated wildly from outside influences such as the Development Campaign in 1958 and the recession of last year.

The Sesquicentennial Year of the College saw a record 747 alumni send gifts to the Alumni Fund. Never before have as many as 600 alumni contributed to the Fund in a single year. This year 747 alumni sent \$21,006.57 to the College. In addition 16 friends added another \$333.00. The grand total for the year amounts to 763 gifts totaling \$21,339.57 for the Alumni Fund. This represents 15.47% participation by the alumni—also a record high, and more than double the participation of last year.

No small amount of credit should go to the General Chairman of the Alumni Fund Committee, Louis P. Nardi '33 and his diligent committee. Serving with him were Charles C. Bollinger '18, Bobbe Rogers Faris '36, George C. Kramer, Jr. '53, Henry Long '56, Logan Richmond '54, and Nathan W. Stuart '36.

The record success virtually dictated that Lou Nardi be named Alumni Fund Chairman for a second year. He is confident that there will be no relapse among alumni this year and his committee is aiming for at least 20% participation in the 1963 Alumni Fund.

GRIGGS GIVEN SECOND TERM

At the business meeting following the Alumni Luncheon, Saturday, June 2, 1962, Robert W. Griggs was elected to a second term as President of the Alumni Association. Chosen to serve as Vice-President was George C. Kramer, Jr. '53. Henry L. Long '56 was elected to the office of Treasurer. Nellie F. Gorgas '55 was elected Recording Secretary and Mrs. Hilda Heyler Barton '24 was named Corresponding Secretary. Selected as the 1962 Class Representative for a one-year term was Mrs. Orville Jensen.

Elected to serve on the Executive Board for a three-year term expiring June, 1965, were: Robert W. Gehrig '57, Morris F. Good '50, Keith R. Hamm '61, Jack Hirsh '37, Mrs. J. E. D. Huffman '13, Fred Y. Legge '53, and Mrs. Elmer B. Staats '30.

ATTENDING the Sesquicentennial Alumni Banquet was the oldest living local alumna, Miss Mary P. Purdy '89, a resident of the Park Home in Williamsport. Miss Purdy's mother, the former Annie S. Pollock, a native of Milton, attended Dickinson Seminary the day the school opened in 1848 and as a result was one of the Seminary's first pupils. Miss Purdy, who followed in her mother's footsteps and was graduated from the Seminary in 1889, attended the 50th anniversary of the Seminary with her mother in 1898. On Alumni Day she returned to the campus for her 73rd anniversary class reunion, her class now numbering but three.

Miss Purdy is a great niece of James M. Pollock, of Milton, who served as governor of the Commonwealth from 1855 to 1858.

Alumni Fund Stimulated By Class Competition

SOME credit for the record number of alumni contributors this year may be due to the interest created by the class competition based on percentage of participation. Rules for the Sesquicentennial Alumni Fund Contest were announced in a special mailing which was sent to all alumni in the spring. A decided increase in gifts was reflected following the receipt of this mailing. In one day the Alumni Office received more than 50 checks.

The announcement of the winning classes was reserved for a special place in the program at the Alumni Banquet. At the appropriate time Louis P. Nardi '33, Chairman of the Alumni Fund, made the presentations of engraved trophies to the winning class agents. He also presented the College with a plaque which bears the class year and class agent's name for the winner in each division, i. e. Seminary, Junior College and College. This plaque has been mounted in the Burchfield Lounge of the Student Activities Building.

SALUTE CLASS OF '61

Of particular significance is the record compiled by the Class of 1961. Historically, first-year alumni are not strong contributors to the Alumni Fund—at Lycoming or any other institution of higher education. It is therefore with considerable pride that we salute Lou Miorelli and the Class of 1961 and their 30 contributors—a total exceeded by no other class during the contest and matched by only one, the Class of 1957.

The results of the Sesquicentennial Alumni Fund Contest are reported in the box at the right. All percentages and totals are based on gifts received in the Alumni Office by May 15—the deadline for the contest. A summary for the entire fiscal year ending June 30 is found on pages 5-6.

As the base of alumni support continues to broaden, the Alumni Fund will become an increasingly important item in the budget of the College.
