



'63 Annual Alumni Fund \$14,684.31 Final Report

It would be like whistling in the dark if we were to suggest that last year's Alumni Fund was a resounding success. It wasn't! Perhaps the Sesquicentennial Bounce of the previous year, when a record 747 alumni contributed to the Fund, gave us an unrealistic feeling of elation. Maybe we "broke our arm patting ourselves on the back" instead of using it to dig a little deeper into the wallet. Suffice it to say that the bubble burst and the 10% participation this year was even less than that of three years ago.

In every category we had substantially fewer contributors than the previous year. Basically the promotion of the Fund handled by Chairman Lou Nardi '33 was similar to the previous year. Herein may be a fault; perhaps a fresh approach was required. One rationalization for the disappointing results is that many alumni may have felt a peculiar motivation to send a gift during the Sesquicentennial Year but in the succeeding twelve months that motivation evaporated. Whatever the reasons, the following figures tell the story most poignantly:

KRAMER ELECTED PRESIDENT

TEN YEARS WITER he received his baccalaureate degree the Rev. George C. Kramer, Jr. 53 was named President of the Alumni Association. The formal election took place at the business meeting following the Alumni Luncheon Saturday, June 1, 1963.

Chosen to serve as Vice-President was Louis P. Nardi '33. Eva L. Keller '13 was elected Recording Secretary succeeding Nellie F. Gorgas '55 who is one of three alumni representatives on the College Board of Directors. Re-elected for another year were Hilda H. Barton '24 as Corresponding Secretary and Henry L. Long '56 as Treasurer. Selected as the 1963 Class Representative for a one-year term was Nancy A. Gramley.

Elected to serve on the Executive Board for a threeyear term expiring June, 1966, were: Dr. Frank W. Ake '27, Dr. Victor B. Hann '24, Edward P. Heether '11, James J. Keller '50, Mrs. Dorothy Patton Knights '36, Douglas E. McWilliams '52, and Dr. T. Sherman Stanford '32.

908.55. Seven Alumni gave \$3,850.30 but designated it for particular purposes other than the Loan Fund. The balance, \$8,925.16, has been placed in the Alumni Loan Fund. It could be used to assist as many as 18 seniors (\$500 maximum loan) or as many as 45 freshmen (\$200 maximum loan). Alumni will be kept informed of the activity of this account.

Two Classes Repeat

The table at the right summarizes the results of the 1963 Alumni Fund Contest which closed May 15, 1963. Two of the three winners were repeaters from last year. In the Junior College division the class of 1933 was a clear-cut winner and their Class Agent, Mrs. Nina Cummings Lofgren, was on hand to personally accept the trophy. The College division winner was again the class of 1949 and again Class Agent Harvey H. Kulms, Jr. was present to accept a second trophy. The new entry to the winner's circle occurred in the Seminary division where the class of 1904 replaced the class of 1912—the winner last year when they were observing their 50th
