ALUMNI GIVING REACHES \$50,000 FOR SECOND YEAR

Total alumni giving from all sources for 1966-67 exceeded \$50,000 for the second consecutive year. The grand total amounted to \$50,369.89, which is approximately \$140 less than last year's record. Although the Alumni Fund Committee expressed some concern over the dollar decrease they were more concerned over the drop in the number of contributors. The total of 722 donors represented a 9% loss from the 794 in 1965-66. Giving to the Annual Fund alone, however, showed the greatest gain in recent years, increasing over 50% from last year. The fiscal records for the last five years are indicated below:

Kane Heads Alumni Association for Third Term

Herbert G. Kane '60 was elected to a third term as president of the Alumni Association at the annual meeting Saturday, June 3, 1967. Raymond A. Miller '58 was elected vice-president and Frank Tripoli '63 was elected treasurer. Other officers re-elected were Joyce Kelchner Knittle '55 as recording secretary and Lois Derr Fetterman '52 as corresponding secretary.

The following alumni were elected to three-year terms as members of the Executive Board: Jean Davies Van Baelen '52, Doris Losch Maynard '41, Clinton W. Smith '55, Jay W. House '53, Donald E. Shearer '59, Dorothy Long Spotts '32, Robert E. McManigal '58. Victor B. Hann was elected to

a one-year term of office and Eva L. Keller was elected to a two-year term on the Executive Board. Both Hann and Keller are filling unexpired terms.

James R. Palmquist was named by his classmates to be the 1967 Class Representative to the Executive Board. His term of office is limited to one year. A new ex-officio member of the Executive Board is T. Sherman Stanford '32. He succeeds Robert W. Griggs '50 as the alumni representative to the Board of Directors and will serve for three years in this capacity. He joins Dorothy Patton Knights '36 and Nathan W. Stuart '36 as alumni representatives to the Board of Directors of the College.

New Clubs Introduced

Upon the recommendation of the Alumni Fund Committee, two new clubs were inaugurated last year. There had been a steady increase in the number of Century Club members. However, the Committee wanted to find a special way in which they could recognize the more substantial donors. The result was the establishment of the Dean's List for those alumni who make an annual gift of \$500 or more and the President's Cabinet for those alumni who make an annual gift in excess of \$1,000. The Committee was aware that there

would likely be a decrease in the number of Century Club members the first year after the new clubs were started. There were—exactly two! In 1965-66 there were 64 Century Club members while last year there were only 62. But, in the initial year there were seven charter members of the Dean's List and nine charter members of the President's Cabinet. It was these larger gifts that accounted for much of the increase in the Annual Fund, pushing it over the \$20,000 mark for the first time. A record of the Century Club, Dean's List, and President's Cabinet is reflected in the box below:

Classes of '64, '65 and '66

One of the most encouraging signs of last year's Alumni Fund results was the response by two of the youngest classes, 1964 and 1965. The Class of '64 was slightly off its record-setting pace of 41 contributors of the previous year with only 38 contributors last year. The Class of '65 took over as the leader in number of contributing alumni with 39 for the 1966-67 fund year. Particularly noteworthy was the effort of the Class of '66. Among their number of 30 contributors they counted 3 Century Club members in the first year after graduation, more than any other class.

Richmond Retires

No previous Alumni Fund chairman had served more than one year. Logan Richmond '54 willingly accepted a second term as chairman and last year permitted himself to be drafted for an unprecedented third term. Under his diligent leadership and constant encouragement the Annual Fund reached record totals. During his second year as chairman, alumni giving broke the \$50,000 barrier for the first time. His term of office on the Executive Board expired June 3, 1967.
