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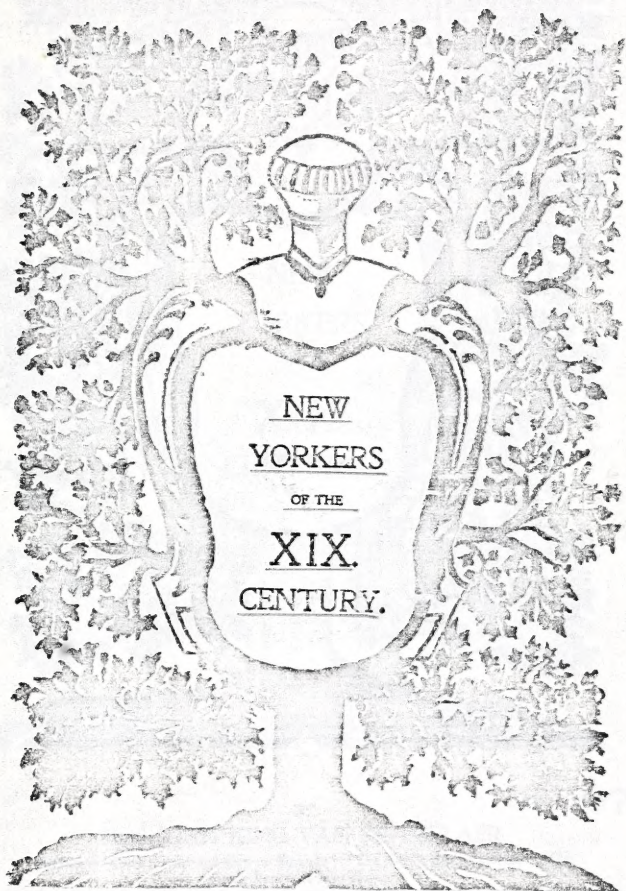


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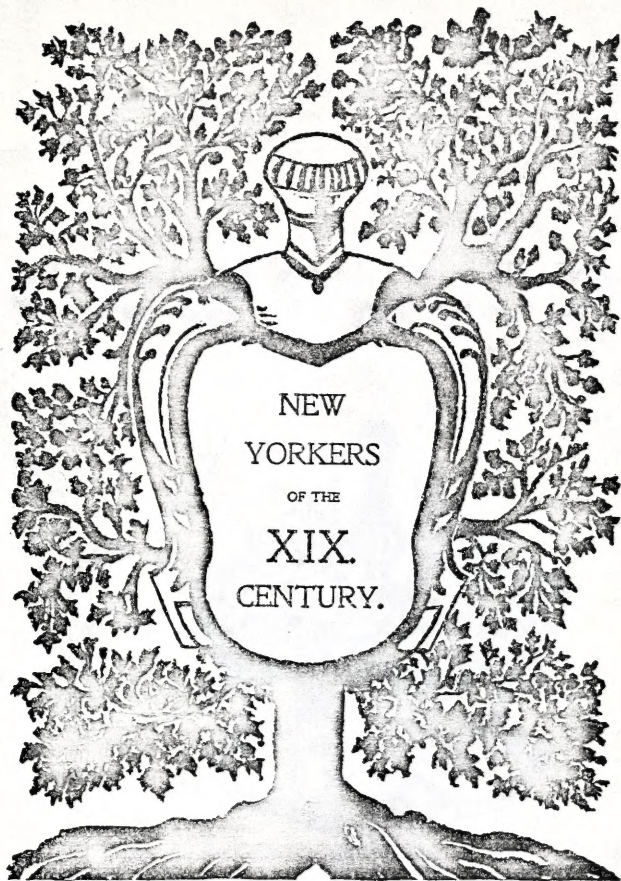

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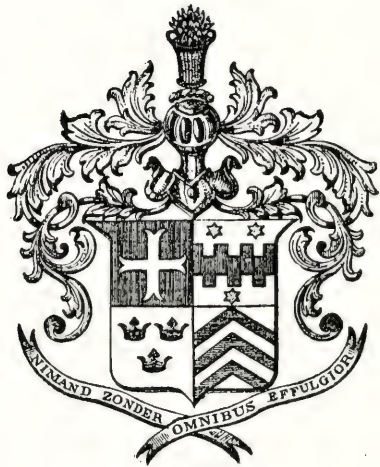

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FOREWORDS.

N a secret drawer of an old Japan writing desk was found, several years ago, a crumpled sheet of paper, on which was written in faded ink a number of names. It was identified as a Visiting List, which had been compiled about 1830 by my Grandmother, whose husband was at the time the President of Columbia College, and as both the President and Mrs. Duer were descended from the earliest settlers of Mana-ha-ta, and were closely connected with the chief families of the city of New York, the list contained the names of nearly all of the prominent people of the place.

It interested me to trace the descendants of my Grandparents' relatives and friends, and to do this I have sought the assistance of the different members of each family, and by their aid have compiled the charts covering the period of the nineteenth century on the Island of Mana-ha-ta. Where there have been mistakes or omissions, it has been due to the oversight of some member of the family, as of course I was not personally acquainted with all its branches.

But although most kindly helped in the arrangement and compilation of the data, I have not relied solely on these contributions, but have compared them with the dates of marriages and deaths that have been published not only in the daily papers, but in the New York Genealogical Record, various historical publications, and other such authentic sources, and reference to them will at all times show the authority for the data.

It would have been impossible for me to have done the work at all without the assistance of my Mother, whose wonderful memory has supplied all the principal details. It is due to her energy that the marriages of her friends and relations were cut daily from the newspapers and regularly pasted in note books, and it is to this record, so faithfully kept by her for so long a period of years, that the compiling of these charts has been possible.

It has been difficult to select from the mass of material at hand the charts that should be published at this time, since such choice would almost appear invidious. The charts of the twenty families, now issued, were taken at random, and when a couple who had been married during the last decade of the eighteenth century possessed a very large family of sons and daughters, it has been sometimes found desirable to follow the male line only, and reserve the female line by classifying it under the lady's married name.

BRIEF NOTES CONCERNING THE FAMILIES ENUMERATED.

BARCLAY.

The Reverend Thomas Barclay was of the Rectory of St. Peter's Church, Albany. He married the daughter of Andrew Drayner, or Drayner, a Dutch Albany settler in Albany and became one of its dignitaries. The Reverend Henry Barclay, the youngest son, followed his education in that land, and after serving as a missionary among the savages, he was called to New York as Rector of Trinity Church, October 31, 1783. Three years afterwards he married Mary Rutgers, and by her had five children. Their eldest son, Thomas Barclay, entered King's College, New York, when not quite fifteen years old, studied law and was admitted to the bar about 1795. Col. Thomas Barclay was a distinguished member of the University and distinguished in the breaking out of the war with England, he remained loyal to his King, and was afterwards honored with many positions of trust, being appointed one of His Majesty's Commissioners for the American boundary between Canada and the United States, which was one of the duties of the country enabled him to gain material advantages for his royal master. He became the representative of the English government in New York, where he died in 1810, universally respected and beloved.

BARD.

Dr. John Bard was the foremost physician in the city of New York during the last decade of the eighteenth century. His sympathies had been with England during the war of the revolution, but so soon as the colonial cause triumphed, Dr. Bard threw all his energies into promoting the welfare of the city of his adoption. He was elected by his countrymen to the office of Mayor of New York as Rector of Trinity Church, October 31, 1783. His office was held for one year, and a medical society was founded next to the almshouse, which at that time adjoined the City Hall. The New York Medical Society, founded in 1784, chose Dr. Bard for its first President, and he with Dr. Peter Middleton, Dr. John Jones, and Dr. Samuel Bard (his son) reorganized the New York Hospital, which was chartered in 1787. The oldest son of Dr. Bard was brought up under his personal direction, and the "old Doctor and the young," as they were affectionately called by their patients, were loved and revered by all classes of society. The doctors of Dr. Bard were noted for their charming and courteous manners. Miss Susanna Bard became the wife of Nathaniel Pendleton, and Nancy, the second daughter, had a fashionable wedding in Trinity Church, which was characterized as a notable event in the history of the church. Her sister was married to the house of the bride. Neither she nor her youngest sister, Mrs. Pierce, left descendants.

BRONSON.

Colonel Isaac Bronson was descended from one of the first settlers of Waverbury, Connecticut. He studied medicine and entered the army as junior surgeon in the Revolutionary War November 16, 1776, in the Second Regiment Light Dragoons, Connecticut Line. It unfortunately fell to his lot to have the charge of Major Andrus during the latter's captivity. It is a matter of history that the English officer, when asked whether he was a doctor, requested that an express should be sent to New York for his valet and wife, and that in the interim he requested Colonel Bronson to issue him a charge of lines, which was done, and an hour's talk with Colonel Bronson was present to the execution of Major Andrus. In after years, Colonel Bronson could never bear the slightest allusion to this painful episode of his life. After peace was concluded Colonel Bronson abandoned medicine and made a voyage to England, where he returned in business as a Banker. He founded the bank at Bridgeport, Connecticut, May 15, 1800, and settled in New York after his marriage with the daughter of Thomas Cuyler. The young couple selected for their country home a most beautiful spot on the banks of the Connecticut River, near Newburgh. The house has been owned by Dr. Dwight, who wrote many eulogies and sonnets in praise of his rural retreat.

BUCHANAN.

Thomas Buchanan was named March 17, 1766, in the Second Presbyterian Church of New York by the Rev. Dr. Briggs. It is a matter of history to visit the site of his birth, which he alone belonged to one of the sturdiest Quaker families of Long Island, but the influence of her husband caused her to become a firm member of the church of her adoption, and the members of her children are all city residents in the house of the church. Her son was born October 31, 1795, married Thomas Wilkes, a farmer, Withelme Wilkes, was a celebrated judge.

DELAFIELD.

Mr. John DeLafield was born in London and emigrated to New York in 1765, where he married Miss Ann Hallett the daughter of a British merchant. She had two daughters, one of the names "Susan," and some of the delightful entertainments given at this home are mentioned by Mrs. Walter Brown, the writer of the beautiful "A Girl's Life Lightly Told." Washington Irving founded one of the lanes on the corner of West 10th and 11th streets, DeLafield's name. It was called "The Walk." Colonel Richard DeLafield was second Superintendent of West Point. It was remembered that during his term of office the government ordered white marble columns to be placed in the park at the post, commemorating the memory of the British who had served in the war of the Revolution, and on each stone was carved some autobiographical description of the warrior whose name it immortalized, and a discussion arose as to what should be done in the case of the late Benedict Arnold. Many officers wished to omit the category entirely, but Colonel DeLafield persuaded them to place one on the altar that should be inscribed with his name only and a brief account of his services. "I am," he said, "a man who has done nothing for his country, but I have forgotten that the once trusted general was a traitor to his country, so it is useless to record it." The grandsons of Arnold have since then been known as DeLafields, and some have inquired the reason. She had never heard the true story, having been educated in England, and was lamentably shocked on learning it. Messrs. Henry and William DeLafield were twins and celebrated brass in their day. Dr. Edward DeLafield was one of the best known and beloved of New York's physicians.

DUER.

Colonel William Duer emigrated to America in 1764 after having served with Lord Clive in India. The young Englishman bought property on the Hudson River and was one of the Indian Commissioners just before the outbreak of the war with his mother country. Colonel Duer fell in love with the younger daughter of Major William Alexander, King a Cooper for the Colony of New York and also for the Colony of New Jersey, and afterwards Major-General of the American Army. Colonel Duer was Commissary for the Army and was one of the first to be killed in the war. One day separated him from his fiancée for long periods at a time, so it was decided that the young couple should be married at the country seat of the bride's father without waiting for the termination of the war. The wedding ceremony took place at the house of the bride's father, who was in the presence of the bride's father, who could not leave his command. His Excellency General Washington, gave away the bride, and the ceremony was performed by his own Chaplain, the Rev. Mr. Armstrong, after which, as the request of the bride's father, the couple retreated out on the lawn in front of the house, where they were received with cheers. The mother-in-law of Colonel Duer was the Honorable George Ross, the friend and correspondent of Paine. The eldest son of George Ross was one of the heroes of the Creek war, and is best known by the story he told on his trip to his bravery at Cold Spring Harbor. Colonel Duer's eldest son and wife were one of the first marriages of the Colonial States, but he left the sea and pursued a career in the army, assisting General Livingston in raising the famous "Sixty thousand" of the Louisiana Code, which has been ever since the frame and standard for such States as it covered the

Union. William Duer was appointed Judge of the Third Circuit Court of New York, and in 1816 was elected President of Columbia College. John Duer, the second son of Colonel William Duer, was an eminent jurist and was raised to the bench, and his works on the law of the State are even to-day recognized as standard text-books.

EMMET.

The name of Thomas Emmet will forever thrill the hearts of all her own worshippers. The reasons for his regard to his country are too well known to need recapitulation. His children became patriotic citizens of his adopted country and are distinguished as well as their father for their talents and genius. One of them acquired an education in the "Spartan-American War," two of them are celebrated physicians in New York, and one of our most ardent and well-known authors. Mrs. Arthur Murray Sherman, who married her first husband in New York, and Mrs. Robert Emmet lived at the corner of Warren and Church streets until they moved to the Dutch fashionable quarter of the city, which was considered "out of town." No so Vanick Street, close to Mr. Thomas Adams' house, who lived at No. 41 Hudson Street. Those old-fashioned houses were the centre of hospitality, and the large family connections and friends designed in the frequent gatherings held at them.

FISH.

One of the heroes of the Revolution and a founder of the celebrated Society of the Cincinnati was Nicholas Fish. He was a member of a family that had early settled on Long Island, and he married the daughter of Peter Suydam, the great grandson of the celebrated colonial governor of New Amsterdam, Petrus Stuyvesant. The only son of Colonel Fish was named after the great statesman, Alexander Hamilton. The Honorable Hamilton Fish was Governor of the State of New York, Secretary of State under President Grant and held many important positions of trust. He was a kind and genial man, and his name is well known to all New Yorkers. He was loved by his 1400. His wife was Mrs. Hamilton Fish, who had been called to the 120th street, where she and her high office. Nicholas Fish, the first son of Hamilton Fish, devoted his only son to the service of his country, and was killed at the battle of Gettysburg on the breaking out of the Spanish-American War, and was the first man killed at La Guayama, Cuba June 24, 1898. A gallant soldier envying the heroic deeds of his forefathers.

GLOVER.

The Glover family of New York are descended from two Englishmen, who, like many others of their countrymen, fled to the United States as soon as the young nation was created. John Glover, the first of the name, was a member of the Continental Congress, and was one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. One daughter named Stephen Linnell, who may well be remembered as having been one of the first women to be admitted to the New York Inland Navigation and Steamship Association. Robert Glover was the elder son of the young man, and was a well-known physician. Dr. Edward Newburgh Bibby, whose wife was a descendant of the White and Van Cortlandt families, early settled of Massachusetts.

HOFFMAN.

Nicholas Hoffman was the grandson of Col. Martinus Hoffman, who came to America to raise and conduct a beautiful plantation near the mouth of the Connecticut River. Nicholas Hoffman and his descendants allied them with the Brinckbarth, Ten Broeck, Livingston, Helms, Maynard, and other well-known families of the colony. Of the generation that lived during the first part of this century, one of the best remembered was Charles, formerly of the Dutch Colony, whose half-brother was affianced to Washington Irving, and whose early death threw such a cloud on the life of that great man, as though with his memory revived. The marriage of Col. Hoffman was always carried out by his own hand, and he was a well-known and successful lawyer and is now in the possession of her great-niece, the daughter of the President of the New York Historical Society.

JAY.

The name of Jay is linked with all that is honorable and beloved in the State of New York. Descended from a long line of Huguenot ancestors who emigrated to America as a form of protection under the benign rule of the Dutch government, John Jay, Chief Justice of the United States, Governor of New York, etc., married Sara, the youngest daughter of William Livingston, that Governor of New York. Jay's family covered the country during the war of the Revolution, with her relatives, and she was one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. She was a well-known and successful lawyer and is now in the possession of her great-niece, the daughter of the President of the New York Historical Society. KING.

The forefathers of Rufus King originally settled in Massachusetts, and moved to Malwa while that settlement was only sparsely inhabited by the aborigines. His father and uncle were with distinction at the battle of Oursay, where the former acted as Commissary, and the latter had command of a troop of war. Richard King, the father of Rufus King, was an officer of the "Royal Marine," which was one of all corresponding with that of Ranger of the Forest of Windsor and other royal reserves, positions that are generally held by members of the Royal family, must have been a post of considerable honor as well as emolument. Rufus King graduated at Harvard, 1795, and was made LL.D. in 1816. He represented the country in 1818 as one of the major of the State of New York, and was one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. He was a member of the Committee appointed to draft the Constitution of the United States, and was one of the signers of the Constitution of the State of New York. He was a member of the family, his uncle, William King, being its first governor. The son of Rufus King was also distinguished men. John William King was the Governor of the State of New York at the breaking out of the Civil War. Charles King was President of Columbia College, James Gore King, a prosperous banker, Frederick King, a well-known doctor, Mr. Philip King was his duty that "General Edward King was a fine young fellow like all the rest of the family, who were young and beautiful in the eyes of the world, and he was a member of the Governor of the State and practiced law. He was rapidly in public estimation and it soon became one of the most distinguished names in the State. The celebrated author and biographer, Col. Charles King, was a descendant of Rufus King. His father (the eldest son of Charles King) was one of the Ministers to Rome.

BRIEF NOTES CONCERNING THE FAMILIES ENUMERATED.—Continued.

LYNCH.

Donnick Lynch, son of James and Annalisa (Jove) Lynch, was born in Garway. He married his cousin, who was the daughter of Arthur Lynch, and by her had twelve children. The young couple started housekeeping in Street, Hartford, but thinking that the new world afforded many attractions they emigrated to New York, arriving June 20, 1765. The following notices I copied from the newspapers of the time, reciting the marriage of the eldest son: "At Albany, February 20th, 1765, was solemnized the marriage of John Lynch, of the city of New York, to Miss James Tidgcomb, daughter of Mr. Barclay, Mr. James Lynch of the city of New York, to Miss James Tidgcomb, daughter of Thomas Tidgcomb, Esq., Secretary of this State." Another son married the daughter of John L. Norris, and Mr. R. H. R. in his diary describes the death of Mrs. Henry Lynch: "Her September 28th, and says: 'she was one of the most beautiful women in New York.' Her daughter who married Commodore Wilkes was celebrated for her beauty. The fourth child of Mr. Lynch, and she first one to be buried in this country, is still well remembered by his contemporaries as 'a great wit and gourmand.' His sister, Mrs. Pringle, wrote what was known as the 'Peer Green letters.' These episodes were frequently met mysteriously at the house of President Deane in Columbia College, and they were deemed to amuse anecdotes and descriptions of well-known people of the day. It was many years before the author of these entertaining letters was discovered.

McVICKAR.

Mr. John McVickar married the only daughter of John Moore, a descendant of one of the first settlers of Long Island, or of its father, John Moore, the Island of St. John, and as all the currency of the savages was these same shells, those who lived near the seashore were the wealthy tribes of the country and respected accordingly. The cousin of Mrs. McVickar was the well-known divine, Benjamin Moore, Bishop of New York, who married, in 1795, Miss Charity Clark. "The Royal Gazette," New York, May 17, 1795, celebrates the wedding by the following notice:

"The good Patron deserved a good Clerk,
Such happiness rare had in store,
'Twas Charity drew up the Spark,
And read the bright State in one Moore."

The Reverend Dr. and Professor McVickar was one of the foremost men of his day in New York. His various duties as Professor of Columbia College were always discharged with conscientious fidelity. By his marriage with Miss Eliza Ford he became connected with one of the prominent Tory families of the State, his pretensions that he had been a courtier, did little to improve the breach that had been made by the rebellion of the Colonies, when families took opposite sides and reciprocal feelings broke out, that it took years to heal. The descendants of Professor McVickar will be found quietly doing good and honor in the city of New York, always highly esteemed by their friends and associates, and identified with the best interests of the place of their birth.

MORTON.

"Madame Johna Morton," as he was always known, was a conspicuous figure in New York during the last days of the Colonial war, and after its termination was closely identified with the welfare of his beloved native place. He married the descendant of an old New York family, Miss Maria Sophia Knapp, whose real name has faded from the annals of the city, her grandfather having left no male heirs. Among the most distinguished descendants of "Madame Johna" are General Jacob Morton, who fought gallantly for his country, and whose later days were saddened by the amputation of his right leg, whose clothes having caught fire, he was bound to death. "The General," as he was usually affectionately called, was a conspicuous figure on all public occasions, as he had inherited the manly figure and good looks of his father. The Rev. Henry Jacobson Morton was one of the earliest divines of the Episcopal Church in his father of the present President of the Stevens Institute at Hoboken. It is due to the pen of Mrs. Josiah Quincy that one of the best chronicles of the daily lives of some of the Revolution is placed on record, with their marks, passions, and heroic courage, will-read and inspire.

RENWICK.

Mr. James Renwick was a distinguished Professor of Columbia College who married Miss Margaret Anne Brewster, the descendant of one of the first settlers of the State of Massachusetts. One of the most distinguished members of the family, where many are now living, is Mr. James Renwick, whose fame as an architect is well known, and to whose genius we owe many of the beautiful buildings that now adorn our city. It is impossible to overestimate the quiet influence that is wielded by this family, who, without seeking notoriety are always foremost in all the charitable enterprises that are necessary for the welfare of their beloved country. To their generosity many are indebted who would be surprised if they knew to whom their thanks were due, since the family seeks always to "do good by stealth, and blush to find it named."

RUTHERFURD.

"The family of Rutherford are directly descended from Robertus Dominus de Rodrynoze, who was one of the men who witnessed the Charter granted by David I. of Scotland to De Beval, A. D. 1124." The elder branch of the family means the estate of Elgin, which has been in their possession since 1660, when it was granted to James Rutherford, Walter Rutherford, the ancestor of the family in New York, came to this country in 1702, as an officer in the British Army. He held many important positions, received the arms of Rutherford at Fort Niagara, and the letter of Montreal when it was placed. The following entry appears in his diary: "Married by Dr. Barclay in the presence of Mr. Alexander and the nearest relatives." In the widow of Eliza Parker, daughter of

James Alexander. The letters written by this couple have been published by a member of the family. One of their descendants, Robert Rutherford, was a member of the New York State Assembly in 1810, and served many succeeding years. His son, Philip S. Rutherford, was a distinguished scientist, and devoted himself to astronomical photography and spectroscopy, and also made many other scientific observations. His name is associated with the making of photographs of the moon, which it is believed have never been surpassed.

SCHUYLER.

The numerous descendants of Philip Schuyler, the first emigrant, would fill a volume by themselves, and to enumerate all would require more space than is available, even some of the distinguished Major-General of the Revolutionary war, Philip Schuyler, could not be contained on one page of this work. His wife, Catharine Schuyler, married John Batey Church, and her descendants must be recorded for a later publication. Eliza Schuyler married Alexander Hamilton, Cornelia Schuyler married Washington Morton, and Catharine Schuyler first married James B. Malcolm, afterwards James Cochran, and their descendants will form part of another edition of this work. The two sons of General Schuyler are the only ones that can be published with the exception of Margaret Schuyler who married the Baron Van Rensselaer. Philip Schuyler, the elder son, married twice and both wives were noted for their grace and charming manners. John B. Schuyler married the daughter of Stephen Van Rensselaer, the Seventh Baron, and died after a brief married life. His widow married to John Blesker of Albany. It is unnecessary to state the heroism of Major-General Schuyler, his services to his country being too well known to need recapitulation.

STUYVESANT.

It would be impossible to include the descendants of the great Governor Peter Stuyvesant in the compass of this work, or even to record those living in New York in the nineteenth century. Peter Stuyvesant, third in descent from Petrus, married the youngest daughter of Gilbert Livingston. They had four daughters and two sons. The eldest daughter, Judith, inherited the name of her maternal ancestor, Judith Vanst, who was bred as a witch in Connecticut, and was regarded with difficulty from her persecutors. The charge against her seems to have been her inability to speak English, and her bewitching beauty. Miss Judith Stuyvesant married Benjamin Withrop, General Stuyvesant's first wife, married in 1715, in the French West Indies. Miss Margaret Stuyvesant, another elder, lived until 1815, and died unmarried. Eliza Stuyvesant, the youngest child, married Nicholas Fish, and her descendants are chronicled under the name of her distinguished husband. Peter Gerard Stuyvesant married twice, first Miss Barclay and secondly Miss Rutherford, and left no children. Nicholas William Stuyvesant was named after his distinguished grandfather, the second son of the great Governor, and the progenitor of all bearing the name in America.

VAN RENSSELAER.

When the Dutch East India Company resolved to colonize the Island of Manhattan, one of its Directors determined to found a "Plantation" on his own account, and for that purpose received permission from the Dutch government to purchase land from the well-to-do and wealthy at his own expense in the New World. The Hon. Kiliaen Van Rensselaer established a settlement on the Hudson River, surrounding what is now the city of Albany. His possessions were twenty-four miles in breadth by forty-eight miles in length, and contained some acres. The Hon. Van Rensselaer received the title of "Patron" and governed his colony as a sovereign prince, in accordance with the laws of the States General of Holland and the local government of Manhattan, and he appointed his own Governors and also acted as judge. When Van Rensselaer, a Director of the latter, The Mayor of Rensselaerswyck determined a direct line to the great Patron, General Stephen Van Rensselaer, who was an instant on the breaking out of the Revolutionary war, and as his father was dead he was under the guardianship of his uncle, General Ten Broeck. After the establishment of the Federal Government the "young Patron," as he was styled, resigned his rights to an independent principality that up to that time had been preserved in his family, although still under a plain American citizen. One of his sons was distinguished during another war, Henry Van Rensselaer, entered West Point, and after graduating at the Academy and serving his country for a year, he married and settled down to a quiet country life. On the breaking out of the war of the Revolution he immediately offered his services to the government and was made aide to General Scott, and soon rose to the rank of Brigadier-General. His career was cut short by a fall a victim to an attack of typhoid fever and died suddenly. It is related that the Baron Van Rensselaer had a number of beautiful daughters and one of them, Miss Catharine Van Rensselaer, was particularly noteworthy. Mr. Josiah Quincy in his memoirs states that the Baron considered her one of the handsomest women that he knew. The fame of her beauty extended far and near and reached the ears of the great and rich, and she was the object of much admiration. She was the son of a refugee from St. Domingo, and gained himself on his birth, which was considered as far above any of the neighbors who lived here, and one of the young ladies were of pure enough blood for him to marry. Hearing of Miss Van Rensselaer's beauty he believed that with her fortune and the aid of his neighbor that she might be considered almost equal to be selected by this child, to which he had four horses attached, with a horse-drawn carriage of peculiar description. The presents and favors reached this great equine which he brought out of a country circuit, and could only have been accepted by a recluse who knew little of the customs of the country of the day, and in this state the St. Domingo gentleman with his intentions of the herds drove across to Albany directly to the Baron's House, and without delay requested to see the Patron. The astonishment of this gentleman can be better imagined than described, when the St. Domingo gentleman, who had been told that he could not be married to any one, but that he had concluded to overlook that detail and had concluded to demand the hand of Miss Catharine Van Rensselaer in marriage. The Baron would not have listened to such a proposal, and the same night the St. Domingo gentleman and his neighbor were both dead.
