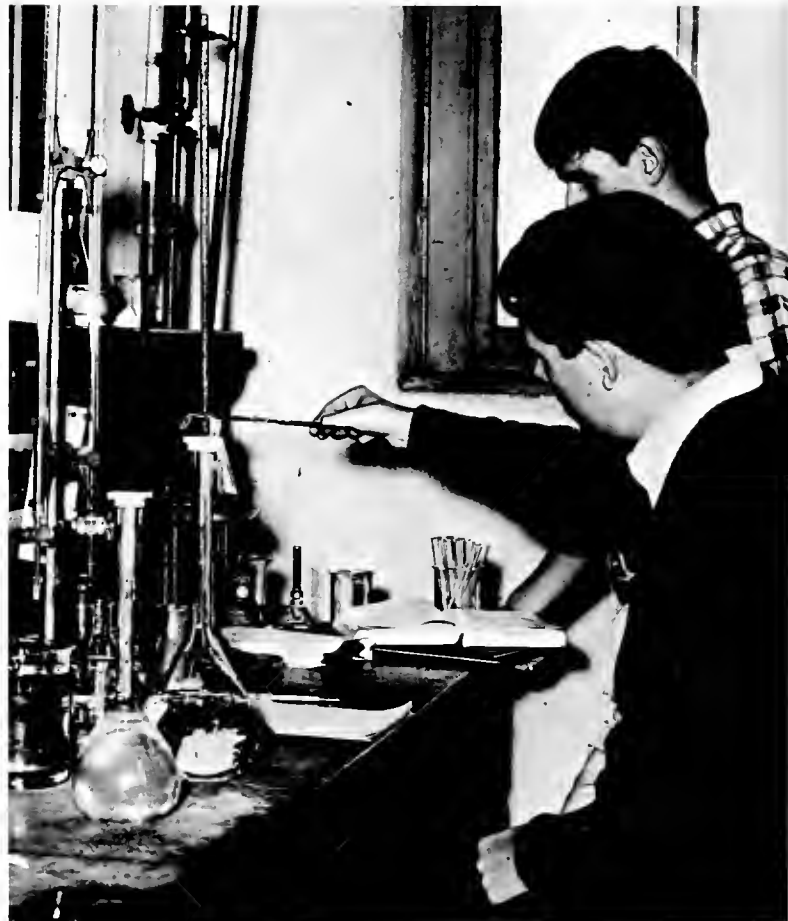






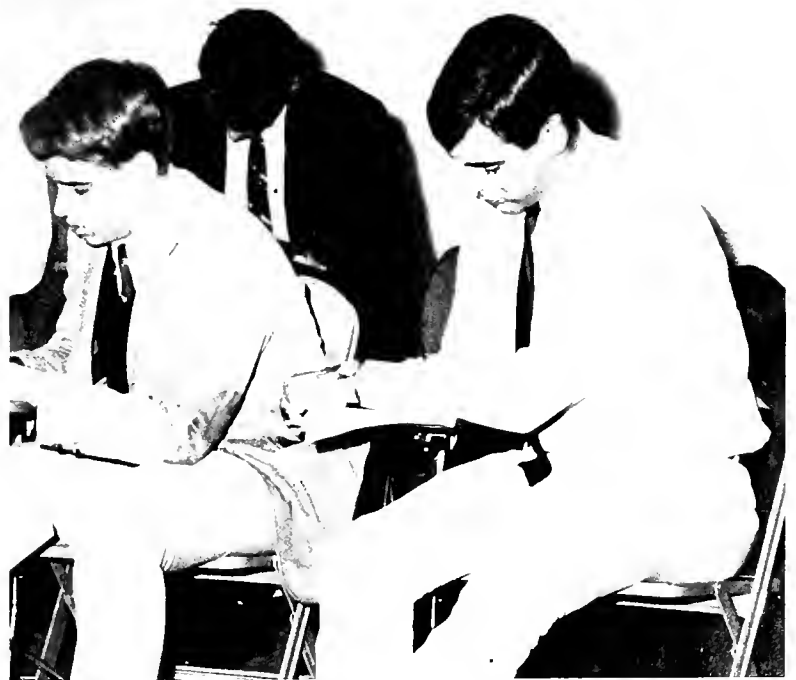

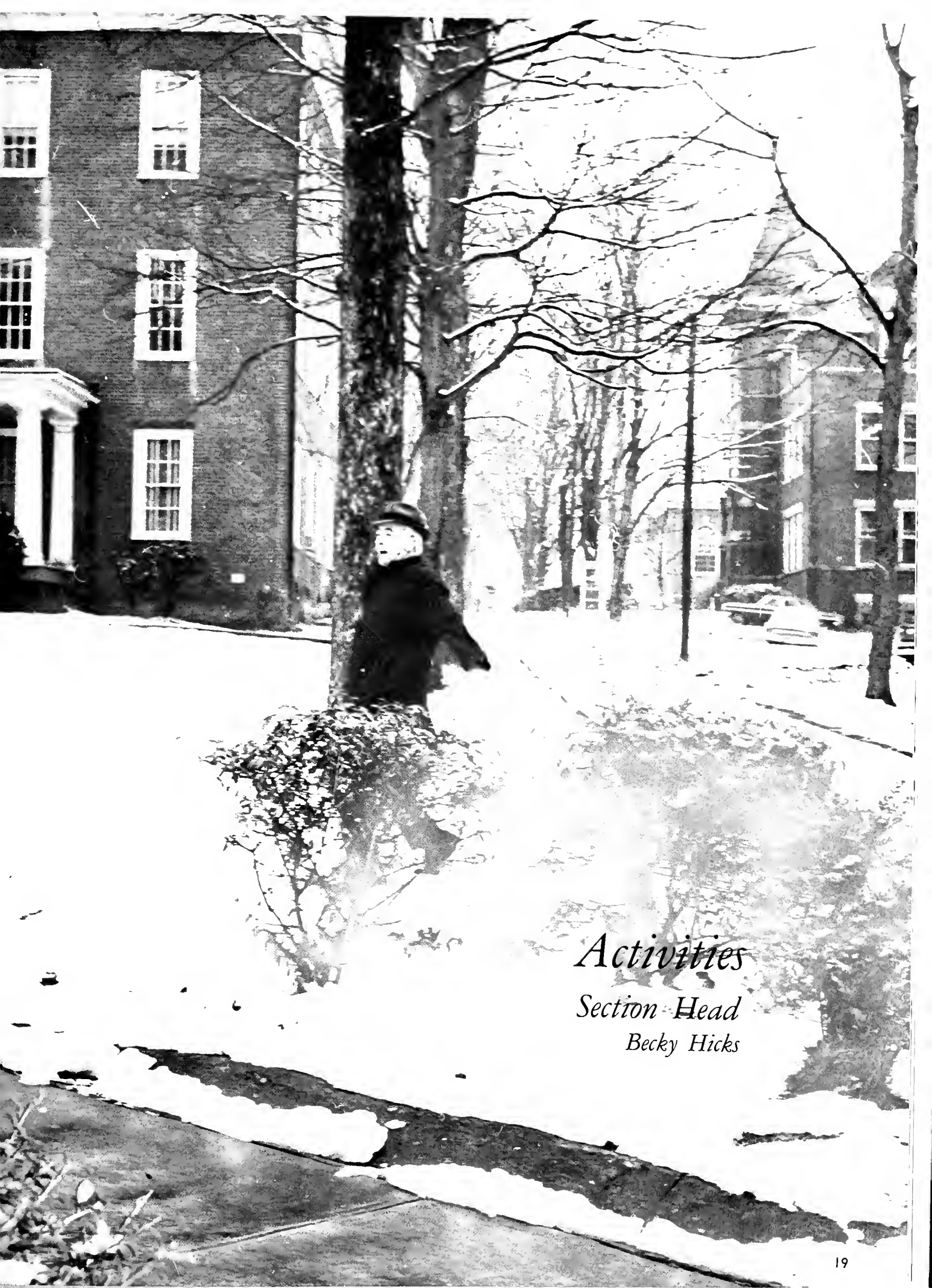
In appreciation for the guidance and friendship so freely given, we, the Nocatula staff of 1967, honor Dean Paul Reviere by dedicating to him this our annual.

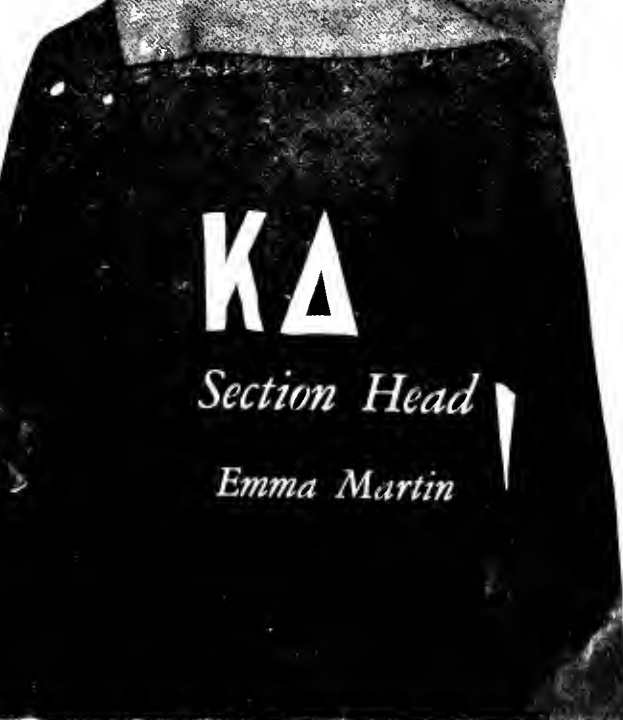
