## INTRODUCTION

"Know then thyself, presume not God to scan;
The proper study of mankind is man."

Joseph H. Choate, Esq., the United States Ambassador to Great Britain, has said that this is a most invaluable volume for him, for between its handsome covers, in compact space, are the faces of more than a thousand of his own personal acquaintances, including a large number of his friends and intimate associates, all classified and indexed, a desirable album, which he could not otherwise obtain at many times its cost.

Two thousand three hundred and thirty-seven (2337) portraits make this the most comprehensive collection ever published for any city in the world. The portraits being exact reproductions of photographs from life, have value beyond those engraved by hand. More than fifteen hundred original photographs have been made for this collection, and to make a reasonably satisfactory selection it was necessary to accumulate more than five thousand photographs. They are arranged mainly in a succession of groups, and as any one looks over the pages, each successive group increases the interest.

The titles are brief, and condensed in every instance to two lines below the name—usually given in full. Often it would be easier to write a page of ordinary biography than to try to indicate a man's career in two lines, for according to Shakespeare, "one man in his time plays many parts."

Besides the portraits, with their titles and classifications, there is only an index, divided into two sections: First, the names; second, the topics or vocations. And while this is seemingly a simple compilation, these 616 pages required nearly three years of painstaking labor.

The scope of this aggregation made it impossible to include every one of prominence in each and every vocation, and yet, in looking into the lawyers' section, one might say offhand that it is an illustrated directory of New York lawyers; but there are only 200 out of over 9000, and many of those omitted would easily rank with those selected. Likewise, but sixty doctors have been chosen out of nearly 6000, etc.

#### INTRODUCTION

The title "New Yorkers" has been used in its very broadest sense, regarding the territorial limits of "New York" to include the whole of the Cosmopolitan City—the Metropolis of America. It has been interpreted to mean men who—wherever born or brought up, or wherever their place of home or business—represent interests or connections within its borders that give them both vital interest and pride in the city's welfare.

The work is not complete nor perfect, but yet it is hoped that in its entirety the collection will receive general approval, as it brings together the faces of so many who are to-day worthy of note in their respective walks of life.

The uses of this collection will be unlimited. It will be of constant reference value in libraries, newspaper offices, countingrooms, etc., and generally in the homes and places of business of New York people everywhere.

There has been an oft-repeated necessity of noting the passing away of men whose portraits appear in this book. During its making more than one hundred and fifty have died, and those who have gone beyond were not only those who had passed three score and ten, but many of the younger and middle-aged men whose successes in their various occupations seemed to augur eminent futures.

# THE MAKERS OF THIS BOOK

The first edition of this book—50,000 copies of 616 pages each is a notable single undertaking of these times. Each sheet is a solid form of 32 pages, containing 128 portraits, every one of which must be brought out for its full value. As regards the printing or "press-work": A great newspaper sends its stereotyped pageforms to its wonderful octuple presses, and in a few minutes its 16-page papers are being delivered, all folded, pasted and counted, at the rate of 50,000 an hour. In fine book-making, only one side of a single sheet can be printed at a time on the best book presses, and instead of a few minutes to start it requires several days' careful preparation for a form one-quarter the size of a newspaper, and the book-printer does well to get off 50,000 well-printed sheets of this character in two weeks. This volume, 20 different forms—1,000,000 sheets, 36 x 50 inches—on which two modern book presses have been kept constantly running for five months, shows the difference between book and newspaper work, and the time required accounts for many seeming discrepancies in the inscriptions. The printing was done by Bartlett & Company, and would tax the best capacity of any printing-house to equal it.

As to the photographs: More than 1000 were made expressly for the book by the Alman Photograph Gallery, and taken together, comprise a wonderful collection of high-art work. There are, also, many exquisite productions from photographers in all parts of the world; and especially from these New York galleries:—


The binding—40,000 in silk cloth, and 10,000 in full morocco with gilt edges—is the work of Robert Rutter & Son and William Launder. More than 1000 reams of fine coated paper, made by Samuel D. Warren & Co., of Boston, were supplied through Henry Lindenmeyr & Sons, of New York. Three thousand engravings were made by the Gill Engraving Co., Bartlett & Company, and the F. A. Ringler Co.; and the designs are by Ludwig S. Ipsen, of Boston.

In the compiling and editing there has been much co-operative work, by scores of people. Special mention is due to the late A. Oakey Hall, ex-Mayor of New York, who was working on this volume at the time of his last illness; Henry H. St. Clair, for twenty years on the editorial staff of the New York Tribune; James E. Geer, for ten years with the Buffalo Express and the Matthews-Northrup Co., of Buffalo; Joseph N. Starin, a publisher for many years; Miss Annie M. Buckminster, a New England teacher, who has had supervision of the work during its preparation; and the proof-readers of Bartlett & Company.

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
