TIBERIVS ob uirtutem, ac peritiam rei militaris cognomento Nero, quod Sabinorum lingua fortem, & robustum significat. Neroni quoque morum similitudine coniunctus fuit, feram immanem, sordidamq; naturam in fine imperij ostendit. O mutabiles hominum uoluntates, o quam difficiles humanitatis progressus, quam timentum, quam sperandum est semper, quam exitus expectandi priusquam certa dentur de rebus iudicia. Modo enim Tiberius amicos colit, adulatorem odit, temperatos mores amplectitur, sed paulo post omni humanitate, & uirtute spoliatur. nunc in Deos pius, in homines beneficus, in omnes liberalis, sed postea pietatis contemptor, officiorum defertor cernitur. iam sponte illi sese donat senatus, mox eius morte magnopere letatur. DOMITIVS NERO, à quo quisque impius, & sceleratus cognomen sumpsit, cum Caligula patruo magnamorum similitudine coniunctus fuit, præterquam primo quinquennio, quod in proverbum abiit, usque adco per id tempus & probus, & temperatus princeps habitus est. sed effrenis postea, & dissolutus in omne uitiorum genus delapsus, paricidys, rapinis, stupris uitam coinquinavit, senatores, amicos, fratrem, genitricem, præceptorem, & seipsum denique interfecit. Efferata uoluptate, a se incensam urbem conflagrare ab alto spectabat. qua omnia subsecuta sunt magna imperij, & dignitatis detrimenta. Armeniam Parthi, Romanis sub iugo missis, recuperarunt: & Britannia amissa, ac imperium è manibus successorum, Augusti, & Liuiæ abreptum est. Nec fas est mandare scriptis, quæ ipse in se pertulit, nec immanem eius feritatem propalare.
