AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS THERETO AND PRESCRIBING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oakland, as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a City Planning Commission in the City of Oakland to be known as "City Planning Commission of the City of Oakland", pursuant to the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California, approved May 21, 1915, and entitled "An Act to provide for the establishment, government and maintenance of City Planning Commissions within municipalities, and prescribing their powers and duties." (Stats. 1915 p. 708)

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of said Act the Mayor appoint by and with the consent of the Council five members, one of which shall be a member of the City Council; and in addition thereto the City Attorney and the City Engineer shall be ex-officio full members of said commission; and provided further that the Mayor shall also in addition thereto be an ex-officio member of said commission but without any right of vote in the deliberations thereof, except in the case of a tie. The five members of the first commission so appointed hereunder shall so classify themselves by lot that one of their number shall go out of office at the end of the current calendar year, two at the end of one year thereafter, and the other two at the end of two years thereafter. Vacancies for any unexpired term shall be filled by appointment as in the first instance. Non-residents shall be eligible to appointment on the City Planning Commission. Excepting the Secretary hereinafter mentioned, the members of the commission shall not receive any compensation for their service, but the Council shall fix the amount of compensation, if any, to be paid to the secretary.

SECTION 3. That said City Planning Commission shall have all the powers and duties prescribed in and be subject to all the requirements and limitations of the said Act of 1915.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PLANNING COMMISSION ACT, 1951, TO PROVIDE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION SHALL BE A BODY OF EIGHT MEMBERS, TO BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION SHALL BE A BODY OF EIGHT MEMBERS, TO BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION SHALL BE A BODY OF EIGHT MEMBERS, TO BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND.

SECTION 1. The City of Oakland hereby creates a City Planning Commission in the City of Oakland to be known as the "City Planning Commission" of the City of Oakland, pursuant to the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California, approved May 21, 1951, and entitled "An Act to provide for the establishment, government and maintenance of City Planning Commissions within municipalities, and vesting their powers and duties." (Stats. 1951, c. 705)

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of said Act the Mayor appoints and with the consent of the Council five members, two of whom shall be a member of the City Council; and in addition there to the City Attorney and the City Engineer shall be ex-officio members of said Commission; and provided further that the Mayor shall also in addition thereto be an ex-officio member of said Commission but without any right of vote in the said Commission, except in the case of a tie. The five members of the said Commission so appointed hereunder shall so classify themselves by lot and one of their number shall so act at the end of the current calendar year, two at the end of one year thereafter, and the other two at the end of two years thereafter, the date of any expiration term shall be fixed by appointment on the City Planning Commission. Non-residents shall be eligible for appointment on the Commission. Excepting the Secretary hereinafter mentioned, the members of the Commission shall not receive any compensation for their services, but the Council shall fix the amount of compensation, if any, to be paid to the Secretary.

SECTION 3. That said City Planning Commission shall have all the powers and duties mentioned in and be subject to all the requirements and limitations of the said Act of 1951.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
