The following outline of the descendants of Nathaniel Durrell, of Kingfield, Me., is printed at the very earnest request of members of the family. The compiler does not claim that it is at all complete. It contains what he has been able to gather during his visits at Kingfield the past three years.

Cambridge, Mass., Aug. 3, 1910.

MOSES DURRELL was a soldier, enlisted from Gloucester, Mass., in the Narrangansett war in 1675.

The participants were promised besides their pay, grants of land, but for 57 years, during which time many of the soldiers died, this promise remained unfulfilled. However, in 1733, Narragansett No. 1, now Buxton, Me., was granted to one hundred and twenty of the soldiers. The following year this land was surveyed into 123 lots, none greater than twenty acres. The heirs of the soldiers, or those to whom the right had been sold, could draw. In 1755 Capt. John Greenleaf drew in the right of Moses Durrell, lot 22, letter B. In 1738 at a second allotment, Nathaniel Durrell drew in the right of his father, Moses Durrell, Lot 1, letter F. In 1742 the name of Nathaniel Durrell appears signed to a petition for protection from wild beasts and savage natives. At the outbreak of the French and Indian war in 1744 the town was deserted and many of the people went to Biddeford. A few returned in 1750-51. A petition dated in 1752, praying for a meeting to be held on the home grounds, rather than in Essex county, has the name of Benjamin Durrell among the signers. In 1753 Benjamin Durrell was administrator of the estate of Moses Durrell, of Biddeford. The Kingfield family is doubtless connected with these Durrells although no documentary proof has yet been found. The names, Nathaniel, Benjamin and Moses still persist. Benjamin Durrell, the father of Nathaniel Durrell, was 92 years of age at his death in 1820, this would make the date of his birth 1728. He might have been the one mentioned above who was administrator on the estate of Moses Durrell, perhaps his father.

BENJAMIN DURRELL, b 1728, Saco, d 1820, Wayne. He fought in the Revolutionary War, and was pensioned in 1818 by the government. He settled by the side of Androscoggin Lake. He married young, as he and his wife lived to celebrate their seventy fifth wedding anniversary. In 1764, John Sellea conveyed to his daughter Mary, the wife of Benjamin Durrell of Saco land in Saco; which, upon her death, was to go to her son, John Glidden Durrell. In 1796, Benjamin and Mary Durrell gave their right to Nathaniel Durrell, their son. This gives the name of Nathaniel's mother as Mary Sellea of Saco. It also shows that Nathaniel Durrell had a brother John Glidden Durrell. A child of Benjamin and Mary Durrell was baptized in Biddeford, August 15, 1759. This was doubtless True Glidden Durrell. We find the name Glidden occurring in True Glidden Durrell, child of Benjamin Durrell of Kingfield, son of Nathaniel Durrell. Besides True Glidden Durrell, Nathaniel had a younger brother named Theophilus.

NATHANIEL DURRELL, b Saco, d 1861, Kingfield; m 1792. Saco, Dorcas Gould. He was of a roving spirit and soon after marriage, he and his wife, together with his brother Theophilus Durrell, went to the northern most part of New Hampshire and settled in Stewartstown. The names of these two men appear signed to a petition dated May 11, 1795, to tax non-resident lands. The wife of Nathaniel Durrell, not finding the wilderness to her liking, returned to her people in Saco, although she was obliged to make the journey alone and on horseback. Nathaniel and Theophilus soon followed, and settled in Leeds, where the brothers and sisters of Dorcas had moved. After remaining here a short time, Nathaniel moved up to Kingfield. Theophilus remained behind and bought a farm in Wayne. Nathaniel Durrell was well known for his strong Christian character and his pronounced views in regards to temperance. He lived to the ripe old age of ninety six years and died in Kingfield, surrounded by his children and grand children.
