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P R E F A C E .

THE REGISTERS OF HORTON KIRBIE are contained in three volumes:—

VOL. I is bound in sheepskin measuring $13\frac{1}{4} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ in., lettered outside "BAPTISMS HORTON KIRBY 1684—1812 ALSO MARRIAGES FROM 1684—1748."

Inside the cover is pasted the printed Act for levying a stamp duty of 3^d on baptisms, marriages and burials after 1 Oct., 1783. It is composed of three paper pages at beginning used for Inductions, &c., two blank paper ones at end, and 52 vellum pages, of which 26 are used for Baptisms and three for Marriages, the rest being blank.

This is well kept and well written, the List of Rectors compiled by Rev. R. Williams being of great interest.

VOL. II, the usual book devoted to Marriages after the passing of Lord Hardwicke's Marriage Act, is bound in sheepskin, and printed by Joseph Fox, and measures 15×10 in.

It contains (from 1754—1812) 147 Marriages; the second part of the volume records Banns from 1754—1823, and is not half full. Mr. Williams in entering the Marriages which took place by Banns refers to the number in the Banns Book, and someone has made an index of the brides and bridegrooms at end of book. On outside cover: "MARRIAGES 1754—1813 PUBLICATⁿ OF BANNS AND MARRIAGES IN HORTON KIRBY." In good condition.

VOL. III is bound in sheepskin measuring $12\frac{1}{4} \times 8$ in., lettered on front cover: "BURIALS AT HORTON KIRBY 1678—1810"—two pages cut out at beginning, then 37 pages mostly written on both sides, then 90 blank ones and 9 with notes, all of paper. It is in good condition and very legible; the date of Affidavit is always given, but only one or two specimens are given here. The word "interred," sometimes "entered," is used up to 1738, after which "buried" is used.

Mr. Hopkins' writing is good and full of character.

There is a gap of two years—1811 and 1812. See note on the subject on page 69.

In the titles to the Baptisms and Marriages in Register I the Parish is written "Horton Kirbie," while in Registers II and III it is written "Horton Kirby."

The Registers were copied and revised from the originals in 1905 by T. C. Colyer-Fergusson, Esq., of Ightham Mote, Kent, who has very kindly placed the transcript for printing at the disposal of the Parish Register Society, thus saving the Society the cost of transcription.

The Parish Register Society wish to place on record its appreciation of Mr. Colyer-Fergusson's kind act.

The churchwardens immediately to indorse y^e time of receiving y^e same wth his name & y^e briefs to be delivered over to y^e several ministers, curates, &c., & they to indorse y^e time when received.

The minister shall some Sunday wth in two months after receipt of such copies before sermon begins read openly such briefs & y^e church wardens to collect y^e sums given y^t on either in y^e assemblies or going from house to house, &c., y^e sume collected to be indorsed in words at length on y^e brief & signed by y^e minister & churchwardens, &c., & y^e money so collected & briefs & be delivered to proper persons taking a receipt for y^e same in a book for y^t purpose & y^e persons refusing or neglecting to do any matters before required to forfeit £20, &c.

Person dispersing y^e briefs shall wthin Six Months after delivery in y^e respective parishes demand y^e moneys received y^t(?) on & on payment to give receipts on forfeiture of £20.

In each parish a register to be kept by y^e Minister of all moneys collected.

Ask for y^e letters patents & ye deputation.

“To The Rev^d Geo. Rashleigh Horton Kirby nr Dartford.

My dear Sir Rochester 18 June 1821.

I fear you must think that I have quite forgotten the extracts from the registers. I had a search made here, but without success; indeed there are hardly any copies of registers here (of a date previous to the passing of the late Act) for those parishes within the Deanery of Dartford; and this being the case I wrote to Mess^{rs} Farquhar the Registrars in London to search among their records. In their answer they say that they have no registers in their possession; and as I conceived they might be under a mistake I wrote to them again, but have not received any reply to this second letter.

The delivery of these transcripts was very irregularly made, so much so that I think the probability of their having been given in for Horton & Sutton for the years in question is much against us.

If they are to be found in London I shall no doubt receive them tomorrow & in that case they shall be sent to you by that days post. If you hear nothing more from me you may conclude that this second search has proved fruitless.

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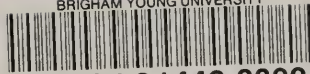
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
