

(Harl. bur, at Terrington, grave\* Lovell's Ifall, in the Parish of Terrington St. Clement's, near Lynn, is an old grobled mansion standing in a small park, about a mile south of the church, on the road leading to Tilogy. It is believed to have been built, or rebuilt, in 1543, and was of larger extent than it is now. The lower stage and the projecting porch are of Barnack stone; the upper stages are of brick. It contains an old panelled room, and the walls are in some places four or five feet thick. The Manor of Lovell's Hall is not mentioned separately in Blomefield's 'History of Norfolk,' (ix., 84), but it seems to be the same as that originally called St. James, now destroyed. By his will, dated Sept. 10, 9th Henry V., he gives it to his second son Nicholus, who presented in 1424. William Lovell of Wretton presented in 1503. Blomefield (i.e., Parkin) says that it passed from the Lovells to the Howards, and was united with "Howards Manor" in the "Bardolph's Fee," of which "the whole right was in the Lovells," before 1416, when Thomas Lovell, of Barton Bendish, Norfolk, presented to the Chapel of same parish. But the family of Richers resided at Lovell's Hall, and held the manor for a very long time belove 1688, when it was sold to Thorowgood Upword's and Lovell's Manors still exist, separately. "Upwood's Title.—The title of Terrington Estate as it is derived to Thorow-good Upwood. John Richers, and his ancestors, has been possessed of this estate for sev'all hundred yeares: John Richers and his mother, who had a joynture, or righte of Dowry, morgages this estate to one Harwick.

John Richers afterwards sells this estate to Peter Barker, and has an assign<sup>m</sup> from Harwick and a conveyance from John Richers of the Inheritance to Barker and his heires for ever.

Peter Barker dyes Intestate, and without children.

Henry Lynhooke and Edm<sup>d</sup> Maxey are found to be heires att Law to Peter Barker.

Barker had two sisters (only), one marryes Lynhooke and the other Maxey.

Lynhook's eldest son by Barker's sister was Henry, who conveyes to Th: Upwood and his heires his moiety of halfe part of this estate.

Edm<sup>4</sup> Maxey, who was eldest son of the other sister, gives his moiety or halfe p'te to Amie his wife by his last will and Testam<sup>t</sup>.

Amie conveys her right to Th: Upwood, who is now in ye possession of it: their has been a Recov'y suffered from John Richers and also fro' Maxey. Maxey had some time morgaged his moiety to Edm<sup>d</sup> Rofe, who assigned to Upwood."
