Blast From The Past



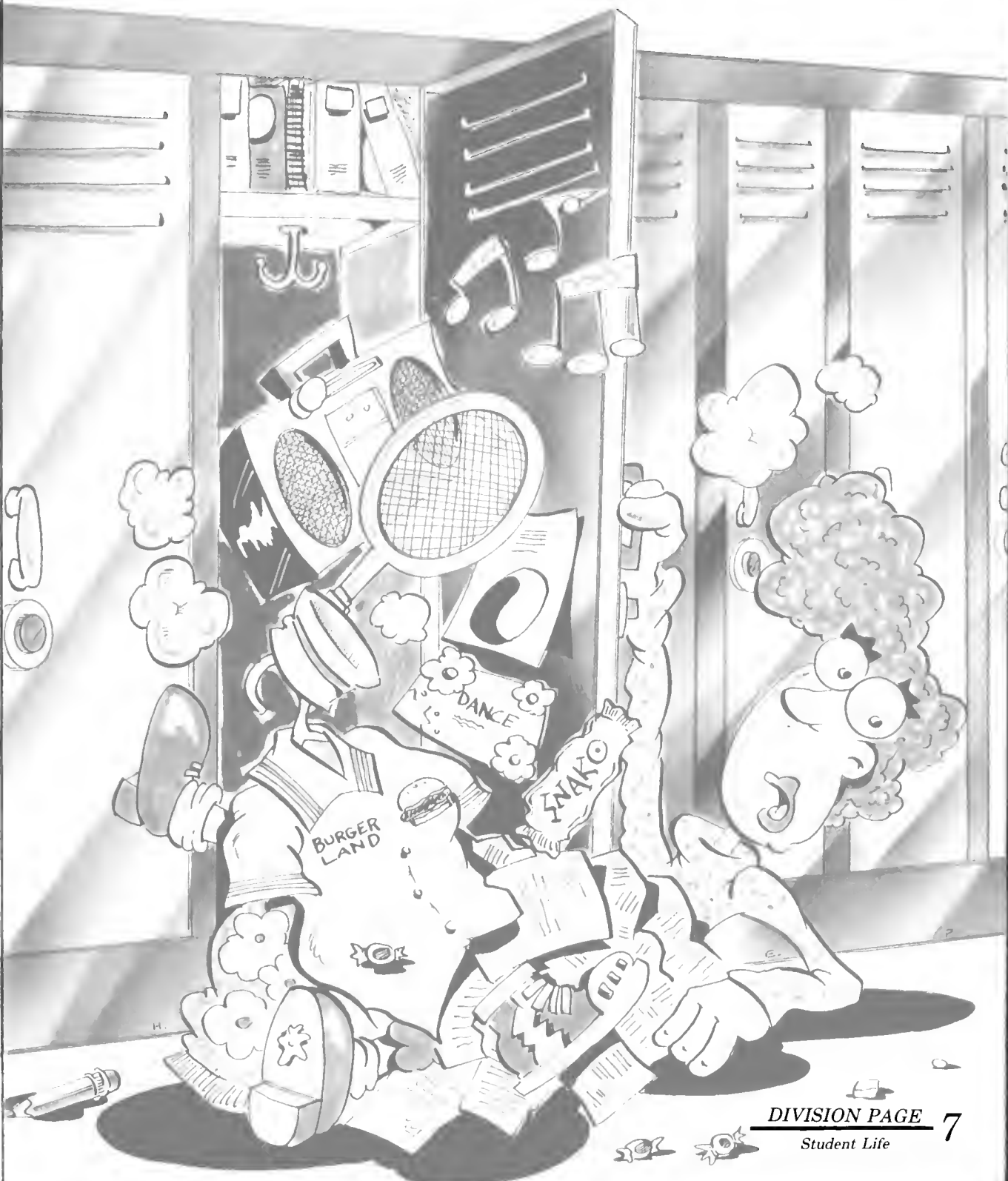

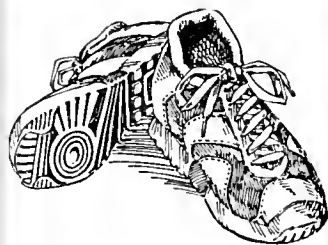

Tis The Season

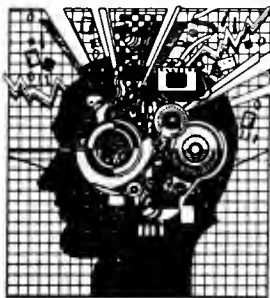

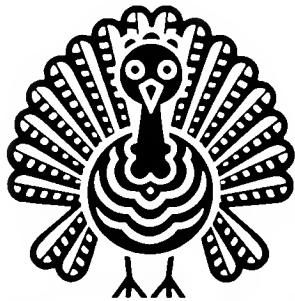

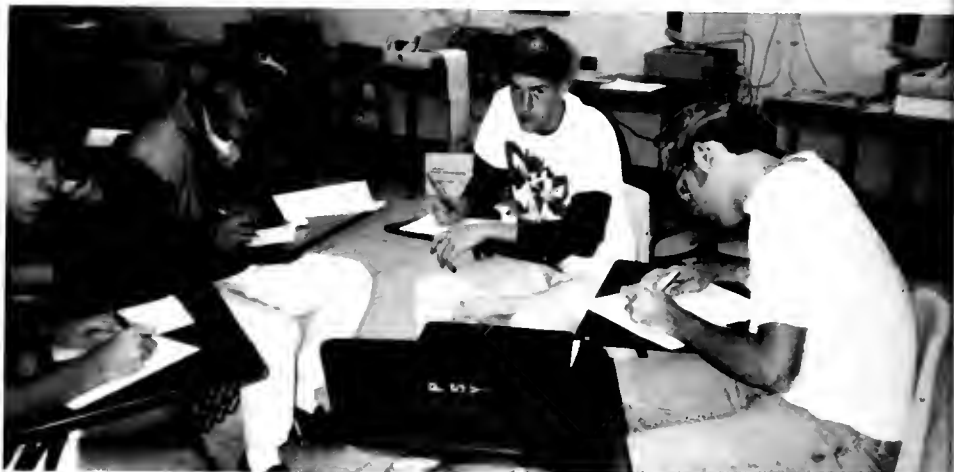

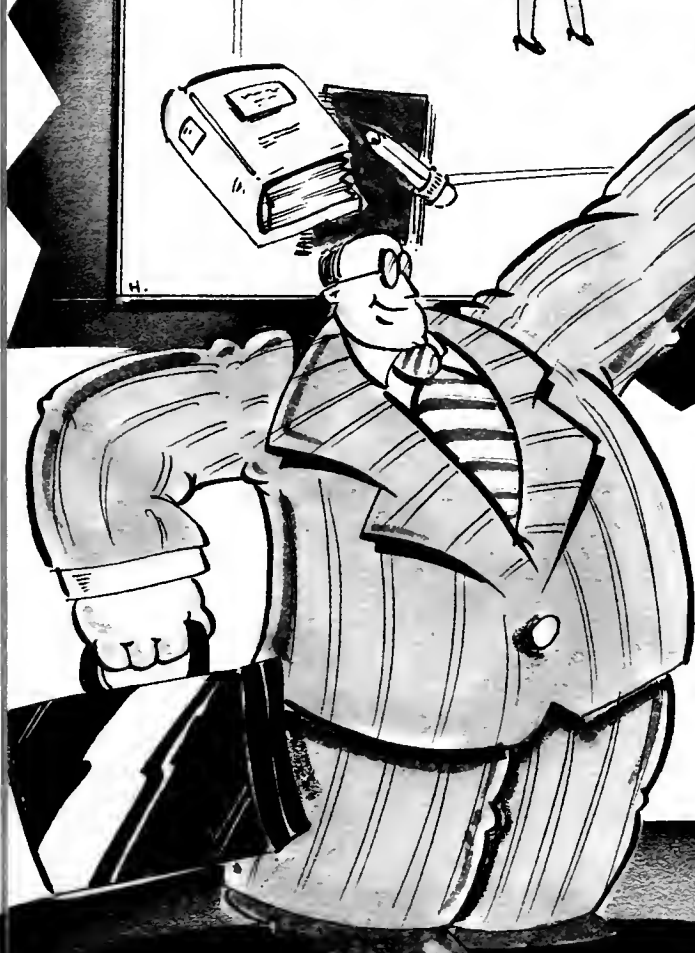
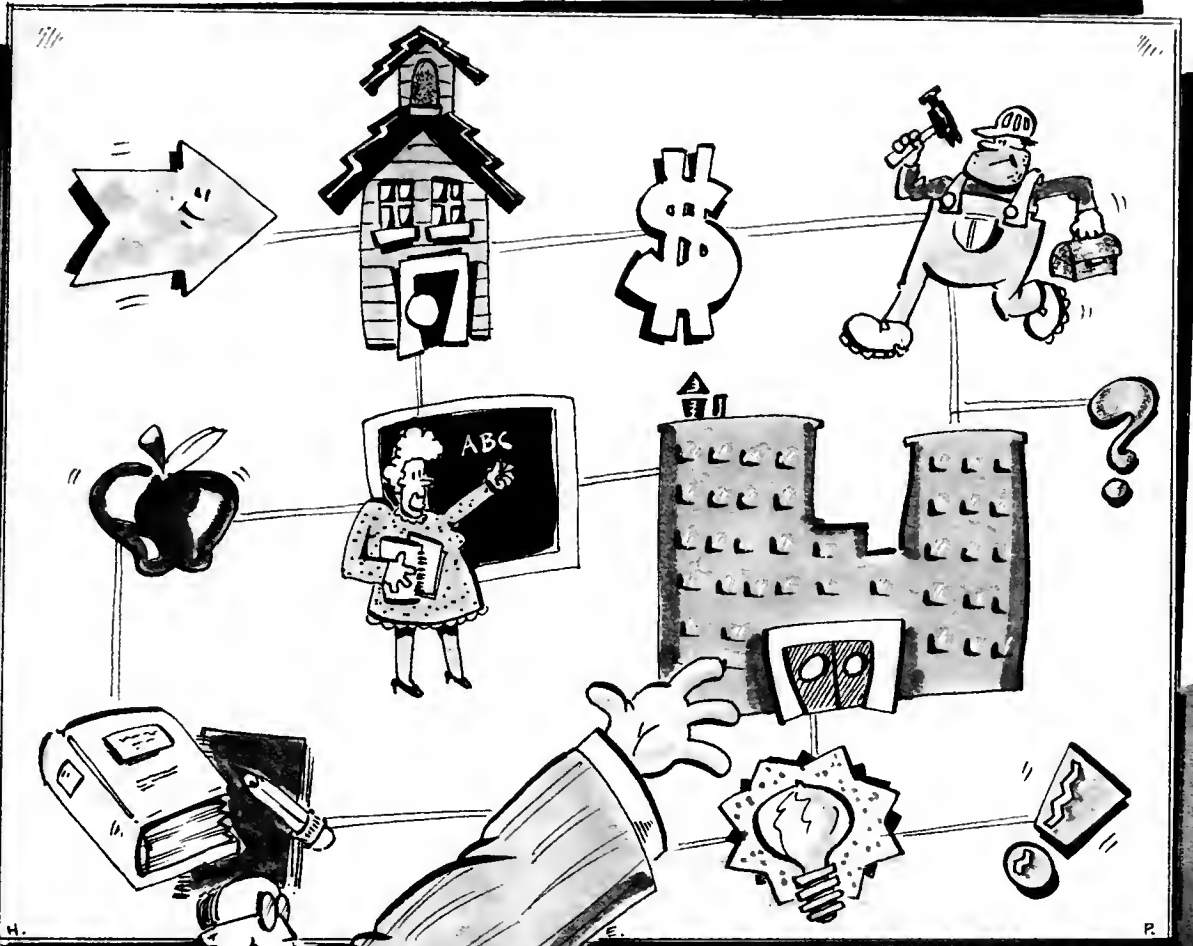

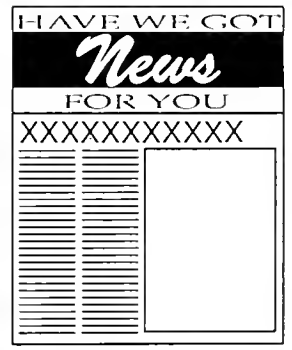

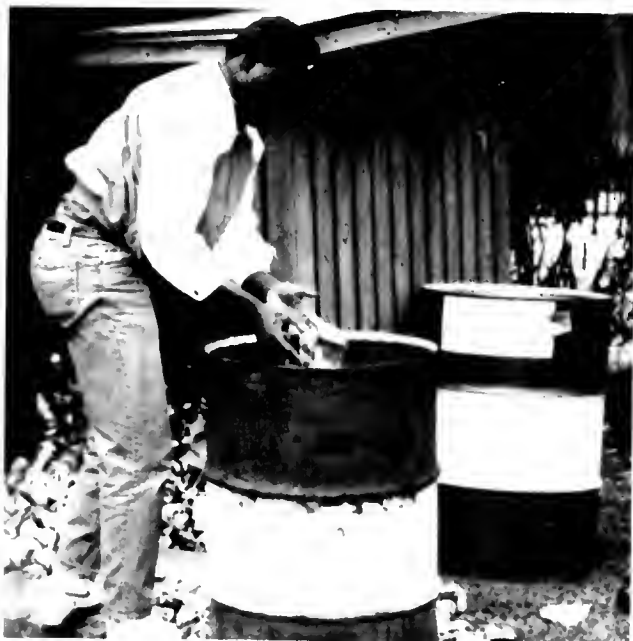

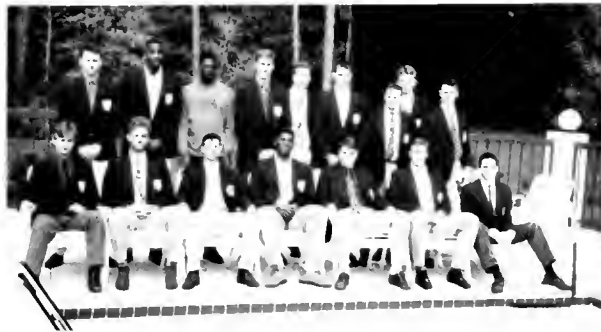
