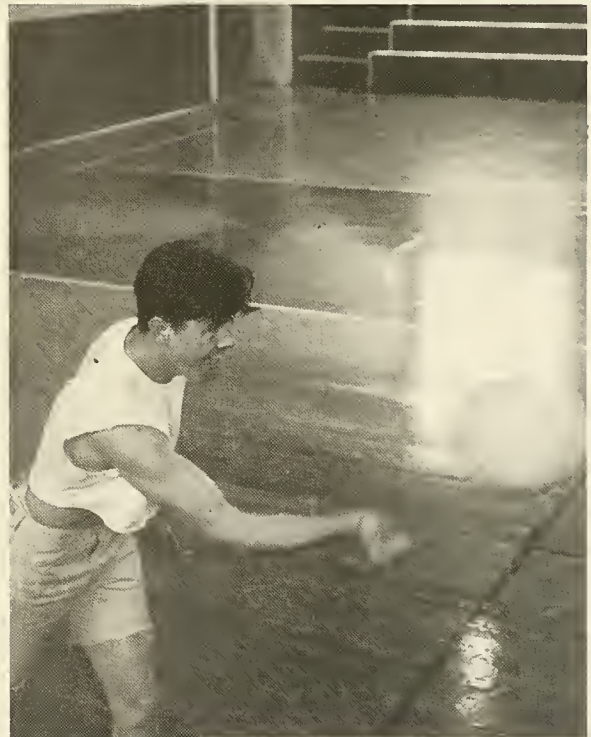
# TENNIS
