This catalogue of a collection of Indian studies by Karl Moon, includes subjects from all of the important tribes of the Southwest. The territory represented is Southern Colorado, New Mexico, Arizona and California, where live the Navaho, Hopi, Apache, Zuni, Taos, Santo Domingo, Isleta, Laguna, Santa Clara, San Felipe, Acoma and other Indian tribes.

Although far from its completion the collection has consumed six years of time and much labor and study. Most exacting care has been taken in the selection of each subject, as it has been the desire to secure only representative types of each tribe, and to make not merely artistic, but faithful photographic reproductions of these interesting people. The historic and ethnologic value of these studies has not been sacrificed in any instance for artistic results.
