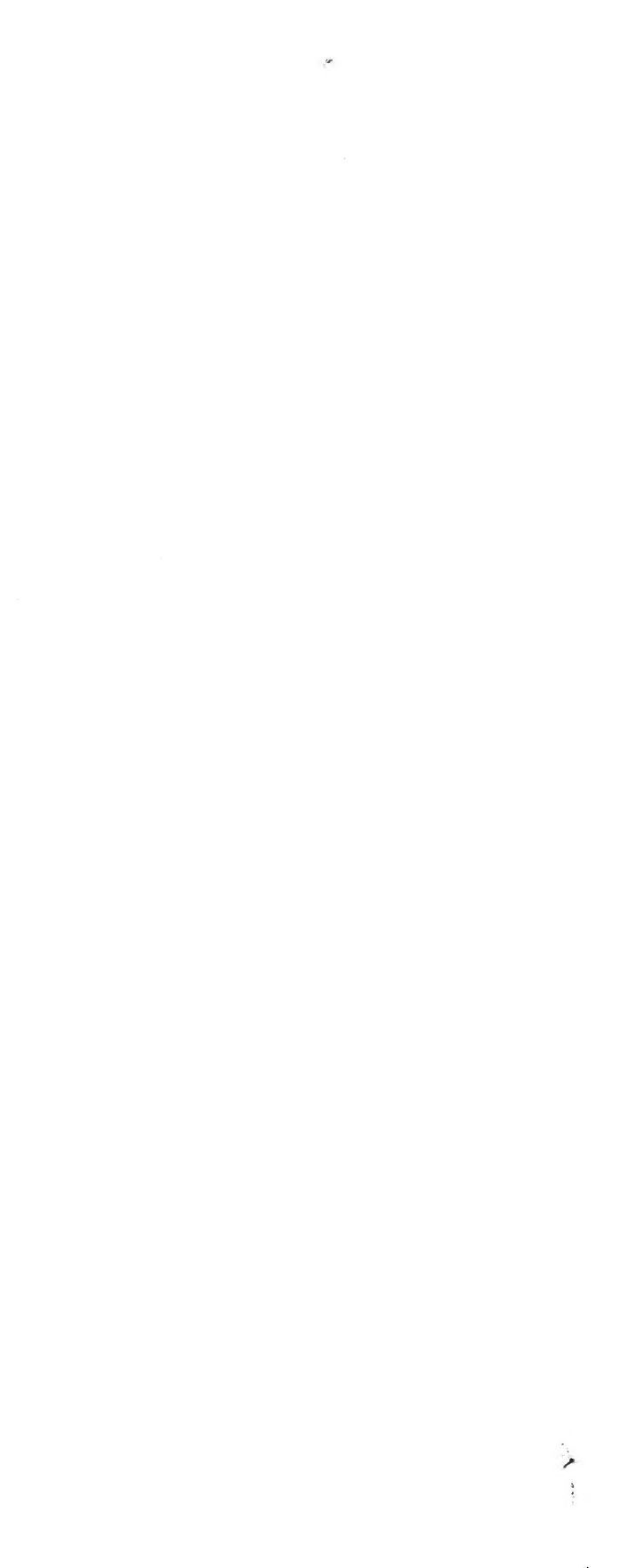

WEED AND BRUSH KILLERS
