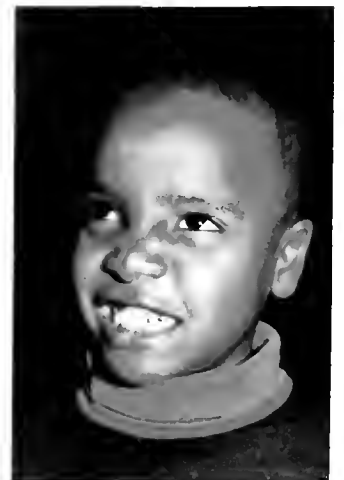
Dear Ann,
