

[NOTE. These prayers are arranged so that by choosing a prayer from each group it will be easy to secure considerable variety for personal or family prayer. Pronouns can easily be changed.]

The Lord's Prayer—"Our Father," etc.

Thanksgivings

I give Thee humble thanks, O heavenly Father, that Thou has vouchsafed to call me to the knowledge of Thy grace and faith in Thee; increase this knowledge and confirm this faith in me evermore. Grant that I may daily be renewed by Thy Holy Spirit, so that all sinful affections may die in me and that all things belonging to the Spirit may live and grow in me; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O offer unto Thee, O Lord, my praises and thanksgivings or all Thy mercies multiplied upon me, more than I can number and far greater than I can express. More especially do I praise Thee for these spiritual blessings which Thou has revealed to me in the life of Thy dear Son. Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Thou, O God, has prepared for them that love Thee. Give me grace to love Thee more and more, till I come to Thine everlasting kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Almighty God, Who hast given Thine only Son to be unto us both a sacrifice for sin, and also an ensample of godly life; Give us grace that we may always most thankfully receive that His inestimable benefit, and also daily endeavour ourselves to follow the blessed steps of His most holy life; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

We give Thee humble and hearty thanks, O most merciful Father, for all Thy goodness and loving-kindness to us and to all men, for the blessings of this life, and for the promise of everlasting happiness. Especially do we praise Thee for the mercies which we have ourselves received from Thee during the past day. We thank Thee for every blessing of soul and body; and do Thou add this, O Lord, to Thy other mercies, that we may praise Thee not with our lips only, but with our lives, always looking to Thee as the Author and Giver of all good things. We ask it for Jesus Christ's sake. Amen.

Morning Prayers

Our Father, the day returns and brings us the petty round of irritating concerns and duties. Help us to play the man, help us to perform them with laughter and kind faces. Let cheerfulness abound with industry. Give us to go blithely on our business all this day, bring us to our resting beds weary and content and undishonored, and grant us in the end the gift of sleep; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Preserve us from slothfulness, and make us so to live that we may always be found striving earnestly to finish the work Thou hast given us to do; through Jesus Christ our Saviour. Amen.

Keep us just and truthful in all our dealings. Guard our spirits from anger. Make us pitiful towards all those who toil with us or for us. Teach us to be patient with those who are ignorant. Let us not forget to give the hand of friendship to those who are unfortunate or to those cast down by affliction. May everyone who has resolved on a better life find encouragement in our example and fellowship. Give us resignation to Thy will when losses and disappointments come to us. Be graciously pleased to take us and all things belonging to us under Thy fatherly care and protection. All this we ask in the Name of Him Who loved us, and gave Himself for us, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Almighty God, our heavenly Father, go forth with us, we pray Thee, to the duties of this day, so that all may be done in Thy holy Name. Make us diligent to

perform whatsoever our hands find to do. Preserve us from covetousness and from complaint of our opportunities.

Our Heavenly Father,—with gratitude for Thy protection during the night watches, we begin the new life of a new day. Our path will be the busy thoroughfares; walk Thou with us unseen.

Let not our hearts cleave to worldly things, but through the sweet influence of Thy Spirit incline us to seek the things that endure. In times of temptation give us to know the right and the power to do it.

Let not trifles ruffle our tempers, nor disappointments unman us. Let not exacting duties make us selfish and churlish. Give to each of us a sunshiny face, a ready hand, and the joy of a word fitly spoken to some timid, discouraged soul.

Strength for the day's service give us in such measure as Thou willest. Pass by our sins of omission:—and, when the shadows fall, bring us again unsullied by word or deed to sweet, refreshing sleep; Through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

O Lord, grant that each one who has to do with me to-day may be the happier for it.

Let it be given me each hour to-day what I shall say, and grant me the wisdom of a loving heart that I may say the right thing rightly.

Help me to enter into the mind of every one who talks with me, and keep me alive to the feelings of each one present.

Give me a quick eye for little kindnesses, that I may be ready in doing them and gracious in receiving them.

Give me quick perception of the feelings and needs of others, and make me eager hearted in helping them. Amen.

Regard, O Lord, with Thy favor all the members of this household. Bind us together in love, sympathy and forbearance. Brighten our daily existence with those endearing graces that come from Thee. Help us to live each for the other, and to find our happiness in doing good and denying ourselves; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Let peace abound in our small company. Purge out of every heart the lurking grudge. Give us grace and strength to forbear and to persevere. Offenders ourselves, give us the grace to accept and to forgive offenders. Forgetful, help us to bear cheerfully the for-

getfulness of others. Give us courage and gaiety and the quiet mind; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of Whom every family in heaven and earth is named; Grant unto our friends, and to all the members of this household, that, according to the riches of Thy glory, we may be strengthened with might by Thy spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in our hearts by faith; that we, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth and length and depth and height, and to know the love of Christ which passeth knowledge, that we may be filled with all the fulness of God; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Prayer for Absent Ones

sympathy and kindly help where I have had the opportunity but missed it; and enable me so to live that I may daily do something to lessen the tide of human sorrow, and add to the sum of human happiness; through Him Who died for us and rose again, Thy Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

O Merciful Father, to Whose house of many mansions Thy child shall one day approach alone, by lying down to sleep; let Thy gentle renewing hands be upon me, and Thy loving eyes behold me, as I go to sleep this night. Thou Who givest Thy beloved sleep, grant that I may rest at peace with Thee, and with all Thy creatures. Renew my body, and cleanse my heart and soul, by Thy creative power, and grant that the morning light may make me rejoice alike in rendering new service to Thee, and in being one day nearer to the vision of Thy face; for His sake Who died for us, and rose again, Jesus Christ our Lord. Remember all who are in need. Quicken Thy Church with divine life. Have all our dear ones in Thy holy keeping, and grant them gifts according to Thy love. And may the quiet of the evening and the sleep of the night bring strength, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Abide with us good Lord, this night and for ever. May we lay us down with all trust in Thy goodness and in perfect charity with all men, and be raised up again to praise Thee for all Thy mercies through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Save us, O Lord, waking, Guard us sleeping; that awake we may watch with Christ, and asleep we may rest in peace. Amen.

The Lord Almighty grant us a quiet night and a perfect end. Amen.

Let Thy peace rule our spirits through all the trial of our waning powers. O God, open the eyes of our hearts that we may see the wonderful things out of Thy law; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, our Great Companion, lead us ever more deeply into the knowledge of Thy life and ours, and

make us interpreters of life to our fellows, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, who alone canst uphold the minds of men, without Whose beauty and goodness our souls are unfed, without whose truth our reasons wither and die, we consecrate our lives to Thy will. Give us such purity of heart, such depth of faith, such steadfastness of purpose, that in Thy good time, we may come to think Thine own thoughts after Thee; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, the Might of all them that put their trust in Thee; Grant that we may be more than conquerors over all that makes war upon our souls, and, in the end, enter into perfect peace in Thy presence; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O most loving Father, Who willest us to give thanks for all things, to dread nothing but the loss of Thee, and to cast all our care on Thee Who carest for us; Preserve us from faithless fears and worldly anxieties, and grant that no clouds of this mortal life may hide from us the light of that Love which is immortal, and which Thou hast manifested unto us in Thy Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O Lord, by all Thy dealings with us, whether of joy or pain; of light or darkness, let us be brought to Thee. Let us value no treatment of Thy grace simply because it makes us happy or because it makes us sad, because




