Henderson is situated in the northern portion of North Carolina, county seat of Vance County, one of the richest and most productive tobacco and cotton counties in the State. The city has a population of 6,345 people, however, the city proper with the suburbs within a radius of a mile from its center, has a population of 12,000 or more.

Henderson is served by two of the largest railroads operating in the State, and has bus and truck lines extending out to all points.
