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
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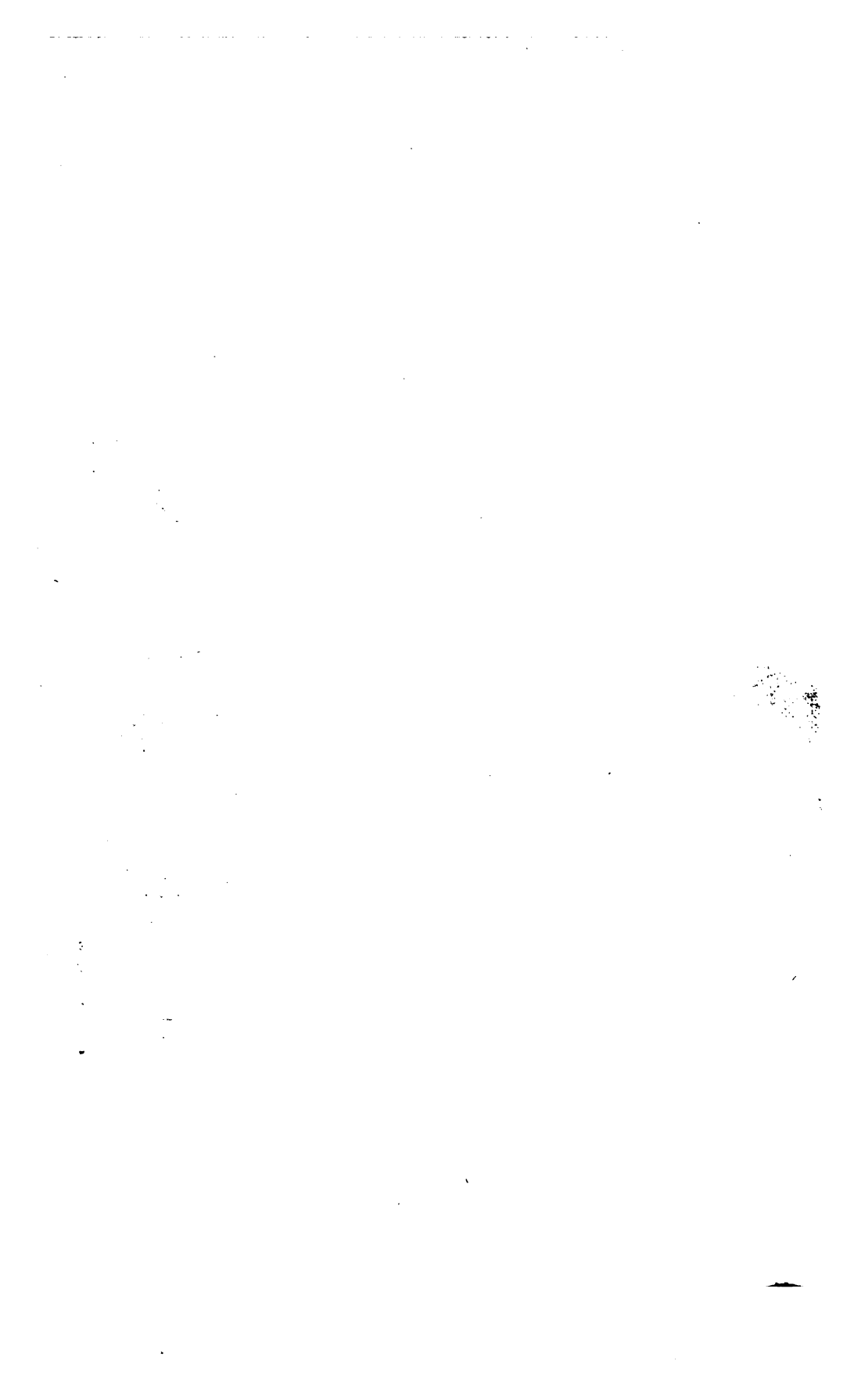
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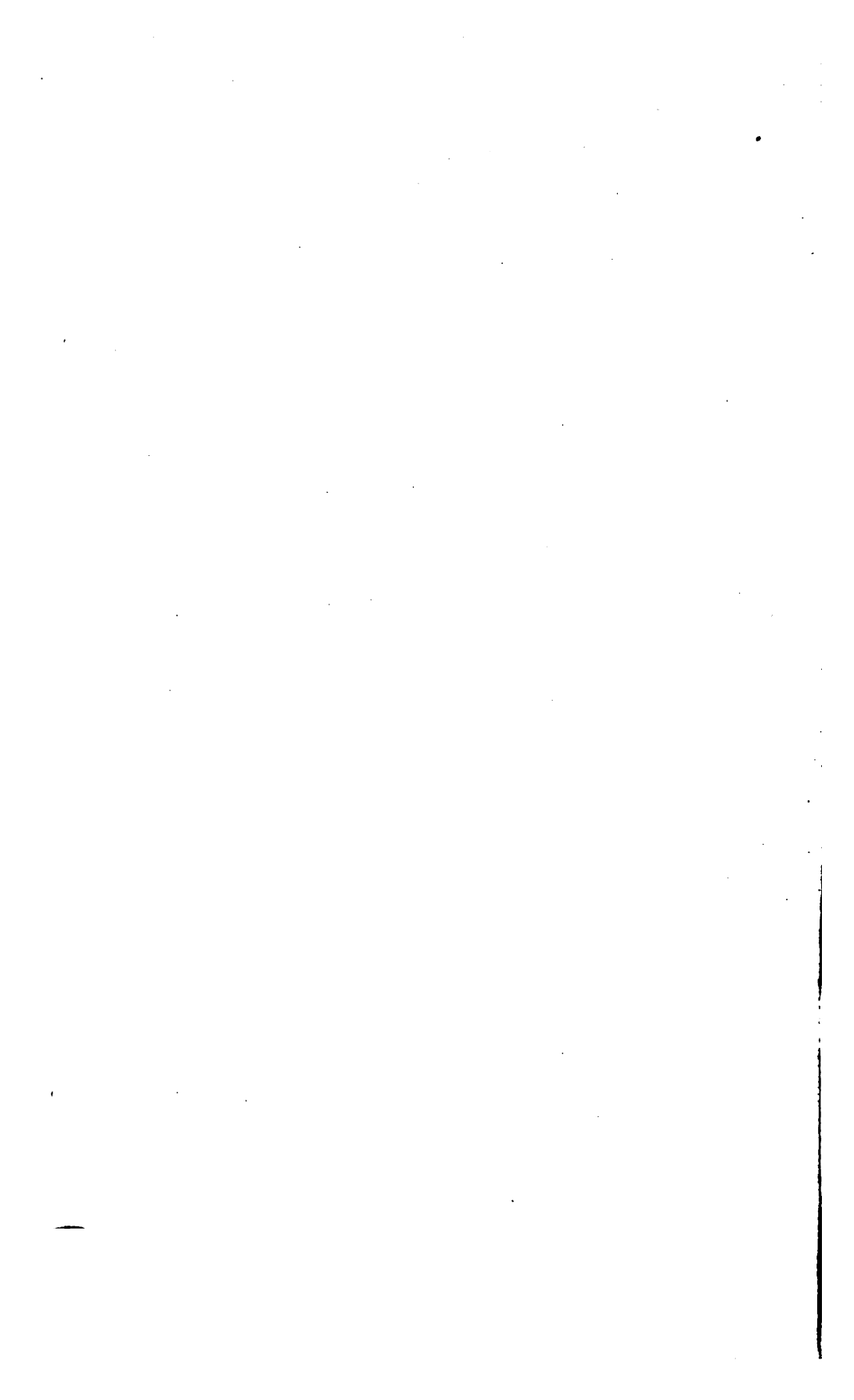

Preface.

THE early Registers of the Parish of Farleigh are unfortunately lost. The oldest Register Book now remaining is a paper volume bound in vellum covers; this measures $14\frac{1}{2}$ inches in length by 6 inches in width, and is in a very dilapidated state. It contains entries of Baptisms and Burials from the year 1679 to 1783, and Marriages from the year 1680 to 1765. The entries appear under separate headings, and to suit this arrangement the book is divided into three sections; there are also several blank pages. A list of the collections made in the Church, from the year 1707 to 1727, in response to "Briefs," is entered at the end of the book; the latter part of the list, however, seems to be imperfect. On the front of the cover is written "Farleigh Register," and there are also some other words which are now too faded to be deciphered.

Number II. Register Book is a volume of printed forms for Marriages, and is bound in brown leather covers. It measures 15 inches in length by $9\frac{1}{2}$ inches in width. The title page is as follows: "The Register Book for Marriages in all Parish Churches and Chapels, Conformable to an Act of the Twenty Sixth of King George II. Intituled:— An Act for the better Preventing of Clandestine Marriages,—"

Published according to Act of Parliament, By T. Lownds, in Fleet-Street, London, 1762." Only three leaves and one form have been used ; the remainder of the book is blank.

Number III. Register Book is a small parchment volume, measuring 8 inches in length by $6\frac{1}{4}$ inches in width. It is bound in stiff parchment covers, fastened together with two brass clasps. In this Register are Baptisms and Burials from the year 1784 to 1812, the Baptisms at one end of the book, and the Burials at the other ; there are several blank pages. The covers are inscribed : " Farleigh Christenings, 1784," and " Farleigh Burials, 1784," respectively.

Besides the volumes already mentioned, there are three sheets of foolscap paper, stitched together and placed in No. II. Register Book. On six of the pages are some entries of Banns of Marriage, ranging from the year 1776 to 1877 inclusive ; the remainder of the sheets are blank.

Every entry recorded in the Register Books prior to the year 1813 will be found in the following pages. The old spelling of the names has been scrupulously followed, but the unnecessary verbiage, such as " was baptised," " were married," " was buried," " his wife," etc., has for the most part been omitted. A list of the Curates, who at various times signed the Registers, is appended.

All the Monumental Inscriptions in the Church and Churchyard are printed in full, also those now destroyed, copies of which have been preserved by Aubrey, and Manning and Bray, in their respective Histories of the County.

PREFACE.

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The MS. from which this Register and the Monumental Inscriptions are printed was compiled in the year 1883, therefore it does not include any Inscriptions which may have been placed in the Church or Churchyard since that date.

MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS.

IN THE CHURCH.

There is a small and rather worn brass, still fixed to the original slab, which is now let into the south wall of the chancel. It consists of the effigies of a man in civilian costume and his wife. The male figure measures $13\frac{1}{4}$ inches in height, but that of the female is 1 inch less. Beneath their feet is the annexed inscription in black letter, and below it are two small groups of children, viz. : under the man four sons, and under the woman one daughter :—

“ Hic iacit Johēs Brook Ciuis dum vixit et Pult'er london
et Anne vxor eius qui q'dm Johēs obiit primo die mensis Maii
A^o domini Millmo cccclxxxv^o quorum āiab's ꝑpiciet' deus

Preface.

THE Registers of Baptisms, Marriages, and Burials from 1679 to 1812 are contained in three volumes, referred to hereafter as A, B, and C.

None of the volumes call for any special remark.

Everything within brackets, thus [], will of course be understood as explanatory interpolations by the Editor.

The following particulars of the Church are taken from "The History and Antiquities of the County of Surrey," by Manning and Bray, vol. ii, p. 409, London, 1809:—

"TATTESFIELD.

"The Church is small but neat, consisting of a Nave and a Chancel, raised one step, and divided from the Nave by a large arch, under which is an ancient skreen. Over the Communion Table the Decalogue, Lord's Prayer, and Creed are written in a most curious but very small hand, and behind them is a beautiful painting in perspective, representing the inside of a Gothic Church. There is no remain of painted glass or carved arms. The Font is a basin carved out of a plain square stone. The west end of the Church is inclosed, and over it, above the roof, within a small timber building, hang 4 small bells."

The old view of the Church is taken from "Views of the Churches in the County of Surrey," by C. T. Cracklow, Architect, London, printed in 1823, kindly lent by our Member, Mr. P. M. Johnston, F.R.I.B.A.; and the view of the Church is from a photograph taken recently by the Rector.

The Rev. W. Champion Streatfield, M.A., of Westerham, kindly lent for reproduction the original drawing of the view of the interior, made circa 1838 by his grandfather. It represents the interior of the Church before restoration in that year.

The following inscription appears on a triangular brass plate fixed on the front of the porch:—

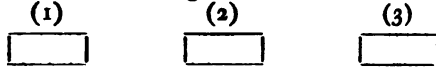

Preface.

THE Wanborough Register at present consists of sixteen leaves of parchment (stitched in a limp parchment cover) measuring 14 inches by 6 inches. The book, at a distant date, has been roughly re-sewn; one leaf [pages 23 and 24], containing the first thirty-two entries of Burials, had been lost, apparently before the re-sewing was done. It is a transcript as far as 1598. The subsequent entries exhibit considerable variety of handwriting:

On outside of cover: feare god. 1635.

On front of the inside of the cover: The Churche booke of wanbrow.

About the middle of the seventeenth century the Church (which is dedicated to St. Bartholomew) became disused (*vide* Frontispiece), and the regular use of the Register ceased. Subsequently to 1801, when the Register was examined by Manning and Bray, it was lost to the parish, but discovered in London about 1901 and restored to Wanborough.

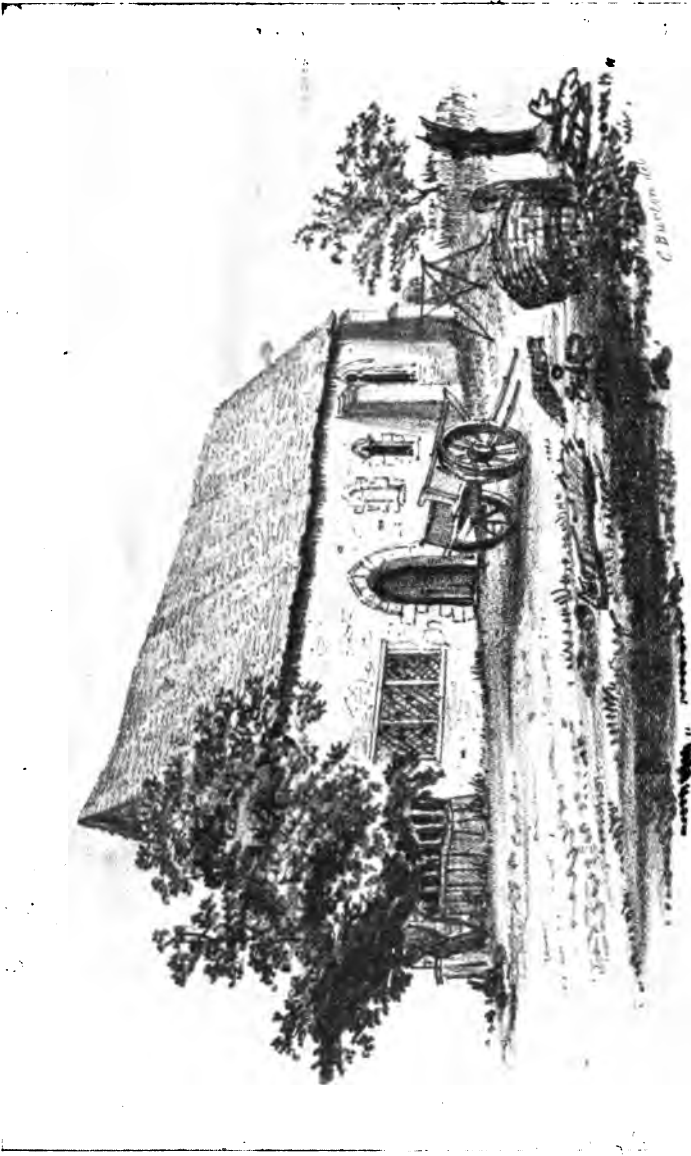
In the Parish Register Abstract of 1831 the Return for the Parish is in the following words: "*Wanborough C.* The ancient Chapel being ruined, the Inhabitants resort to *Puttenham Church* (GODALMING Hundred)."

Wanborough Church was re-consecrated in 1862, and a new Register provided. In this, Baptisms and Burials begin in 1861, Marriages in 1889.

The thanks of the Society are due to the Vicar for the kind permission to print the Registers, and to the Chief Librarian of the Croydon Public Libraries for the kind loan of the old view of the Church from the collection of Prints in the Central Library.

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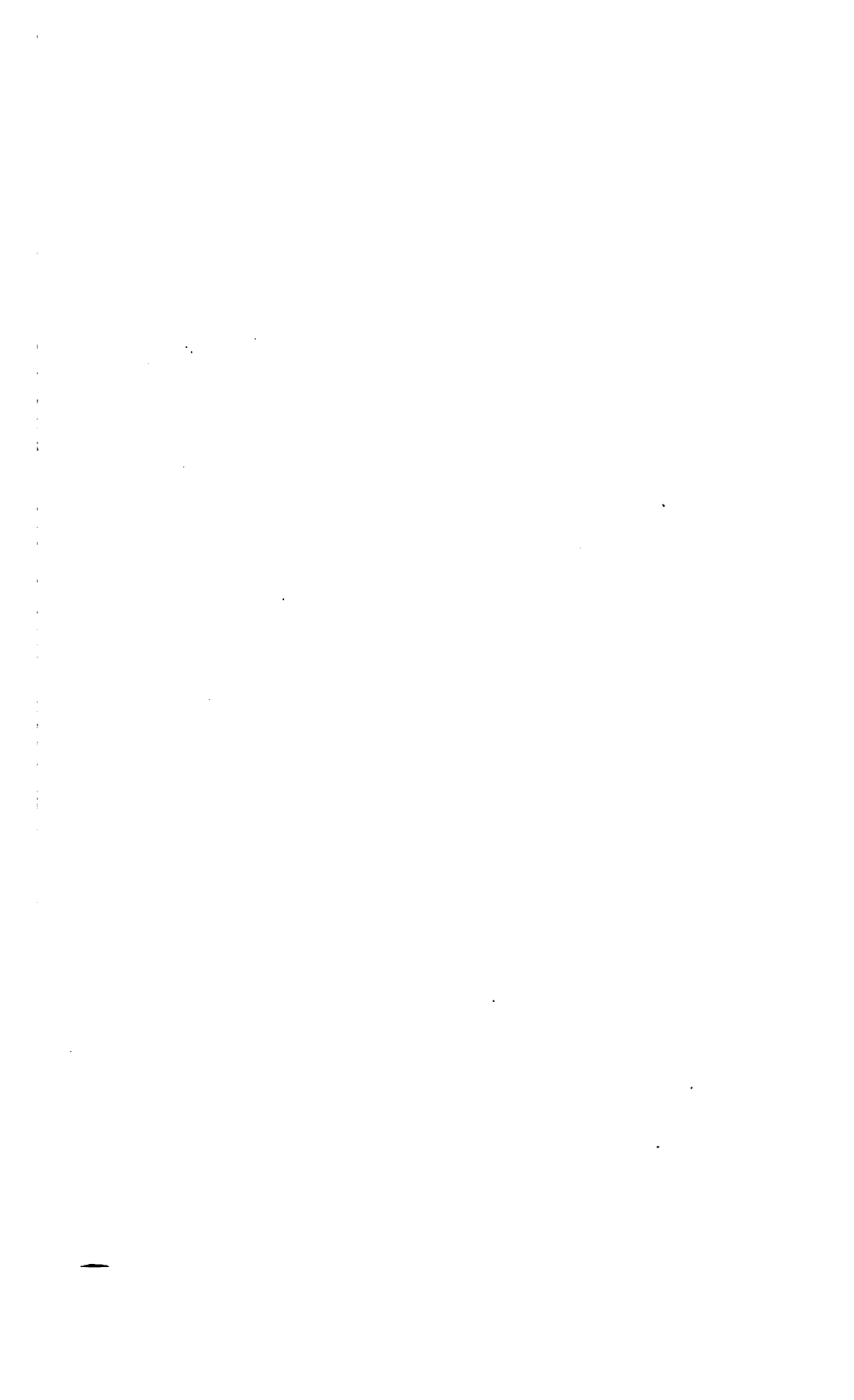

Preface.

THE following *verbatim et literatim* copy of the Register Book of Woldingham in the county of Surrey, which was in use from 1765 to 1812, is printed from a transcript made in the year 1883. The volume, which also contains two entries of Banns, dated 1819 and 1820 respectively, is a small paper book in cardboard covers. It measures $7\frac{1}{4}$ inches in length by $6\frac{1}{4}$ in width, and as it is covered with marbled paper, it is not unlike an old-fashioned ciphering book. The total number of leaves is thirty-eight, exclusive of four inserted ones; three parts of one leaf have been cut out, but the piece remaining is unused, as was probably the missing part. A considerable proportion of the pages are *blank*; these are noted in the transcript. The book, which is in good condition, has been used from both ends, viz., the Marriages entered at one end, the Baptisms at the other, and following the latter, but near the middle of the volume, the Burials. This Register Book is paged in pencil, commencing at the Marriage end, but omitting the inserted leaves.

In the *Parish Register Abstract of 1831 the Return for the Parish* is in the following words: "*Woldingham P. C.—One only Register.*"

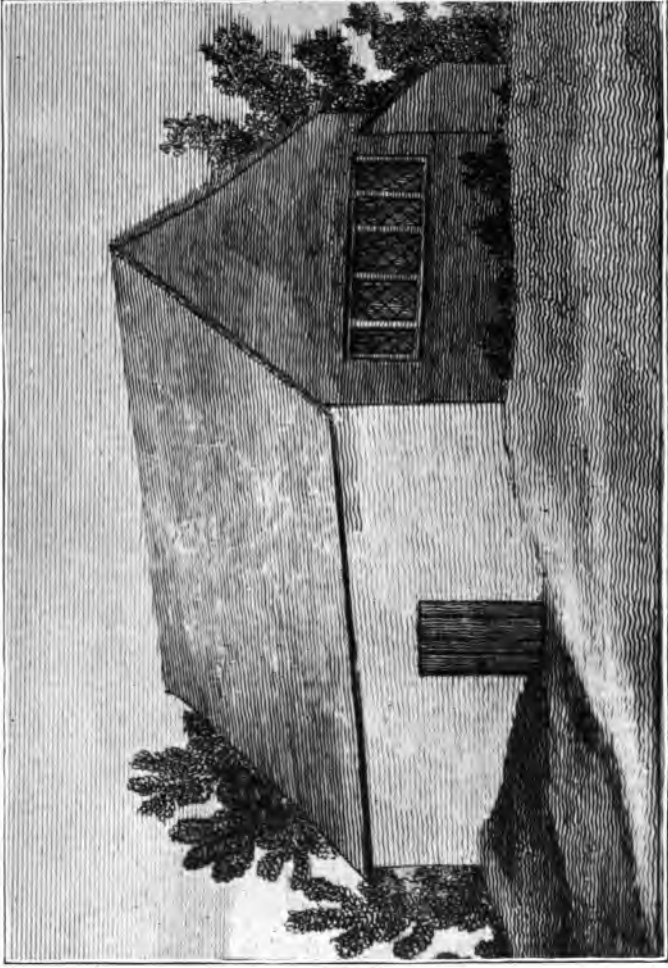

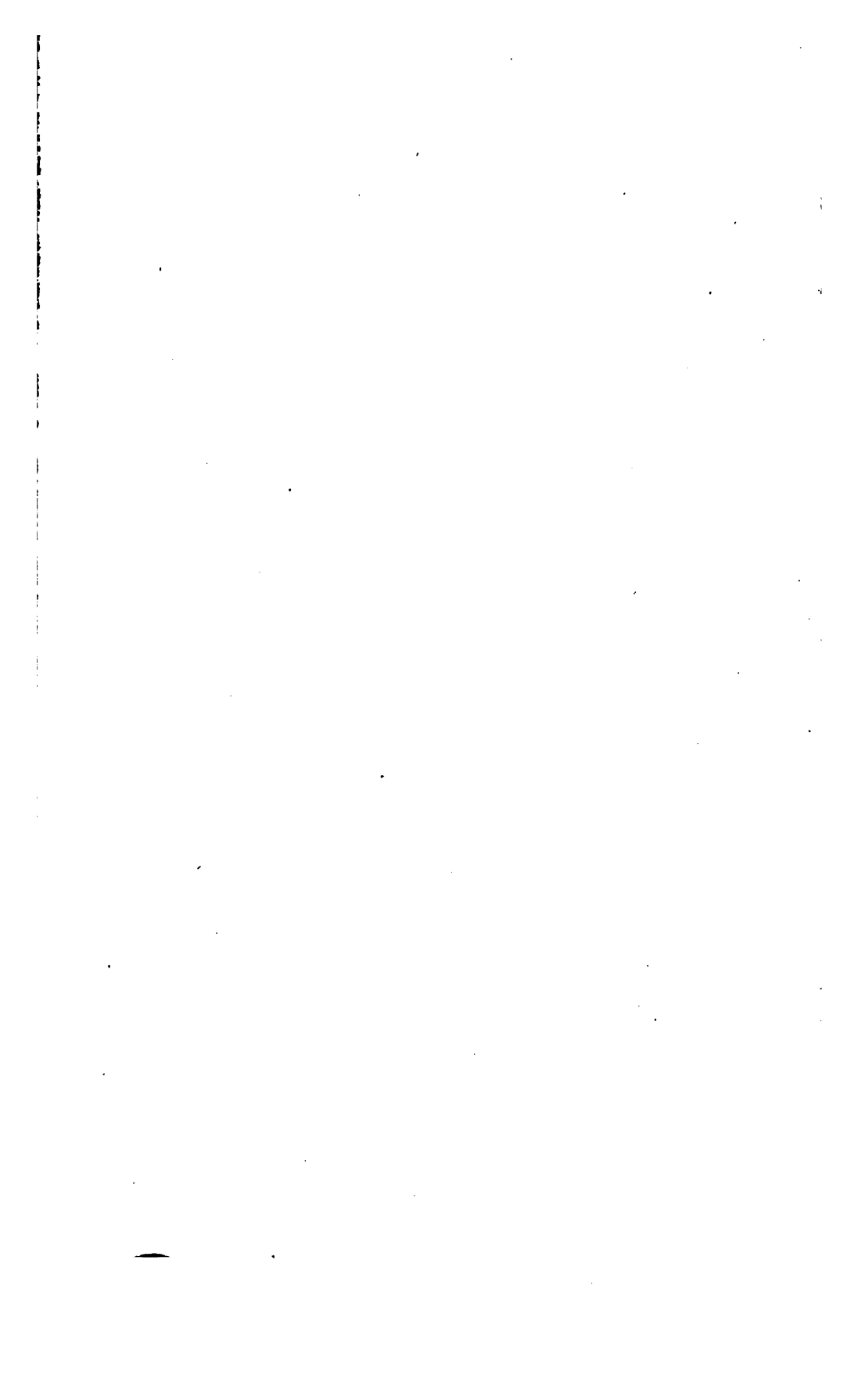
