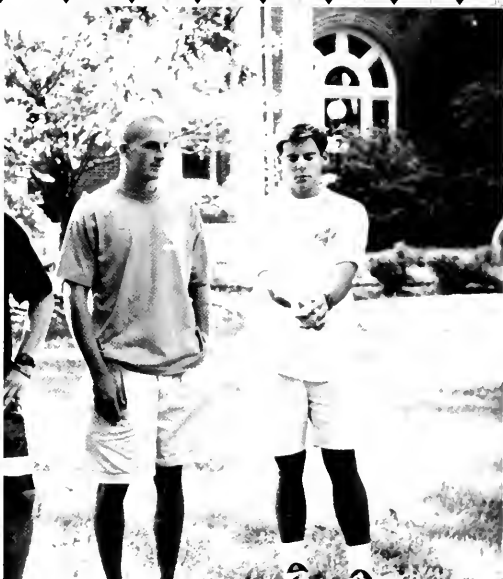
# GETTING TO KNOW YOU

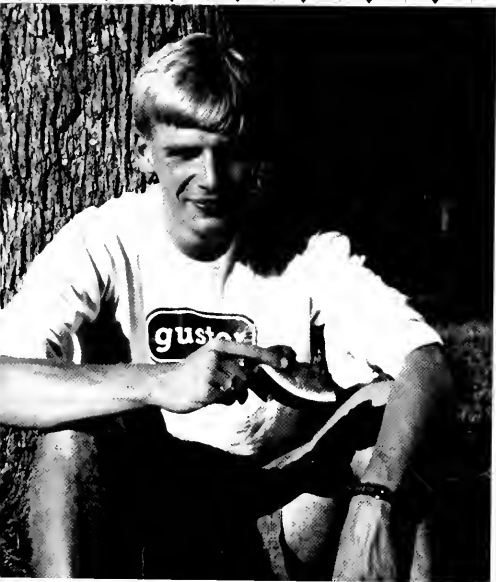

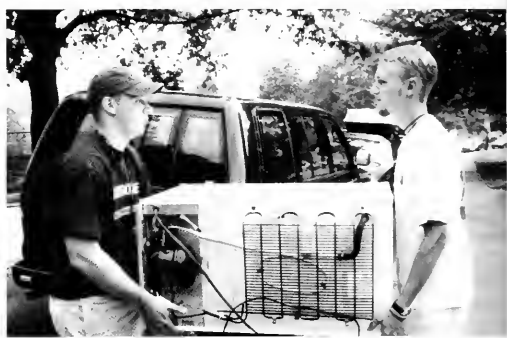

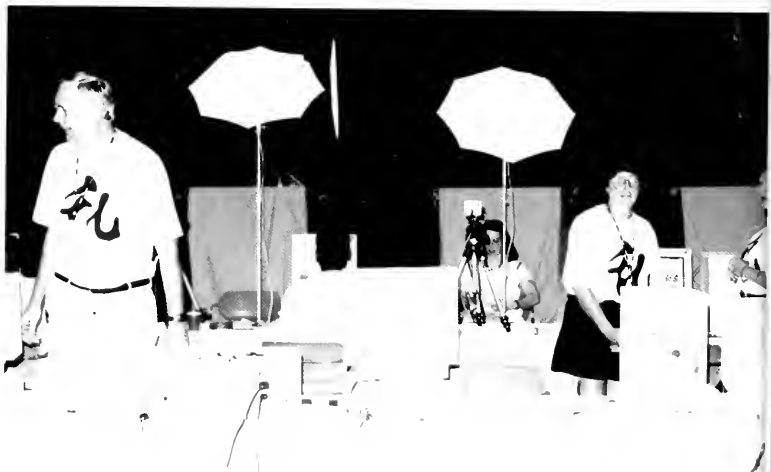
# TIMES THEY ARE A CHANGIN'

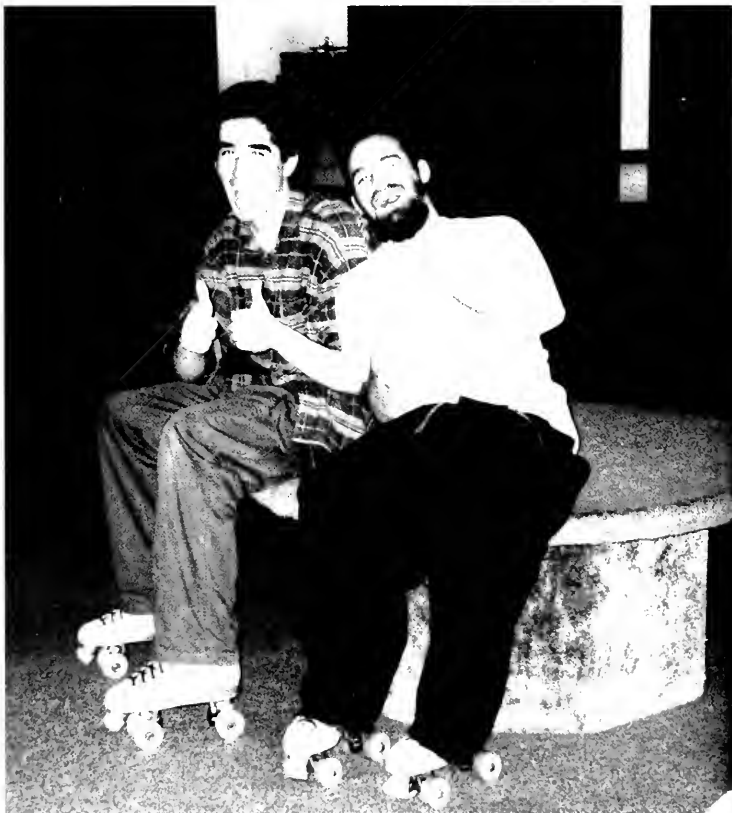

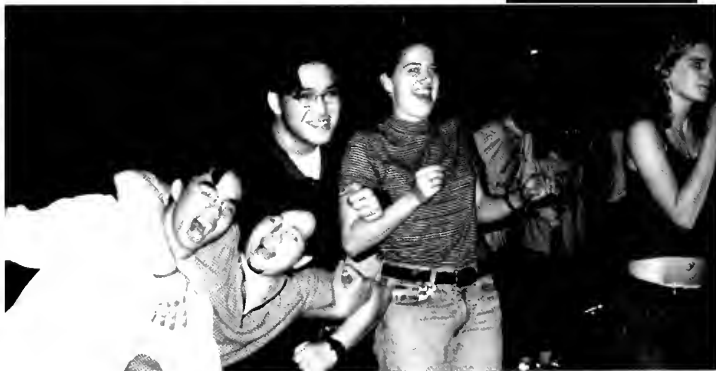

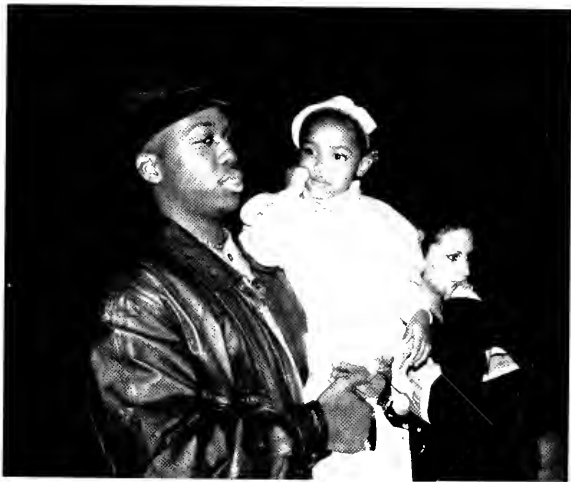

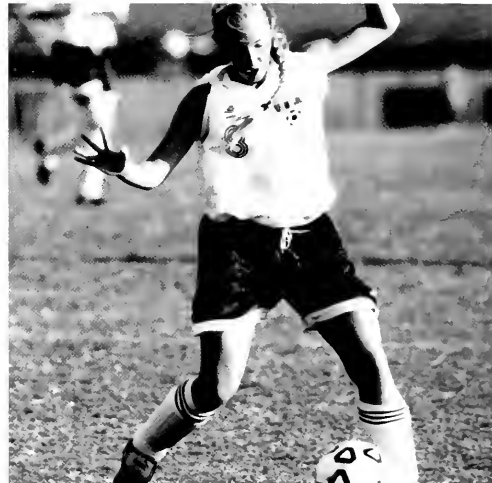

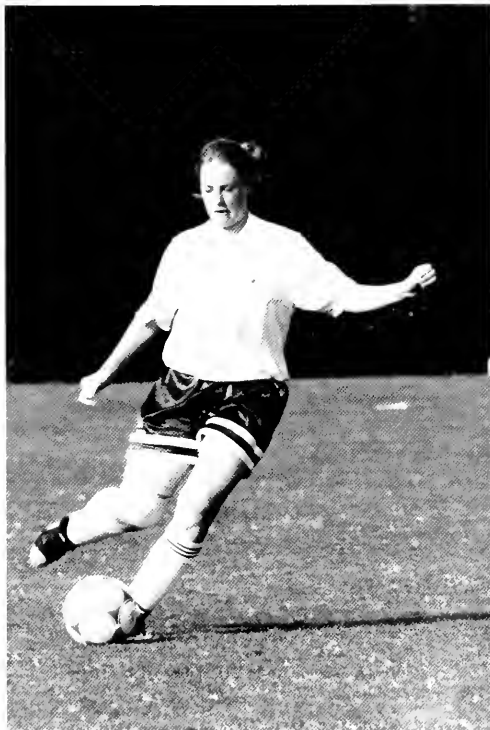

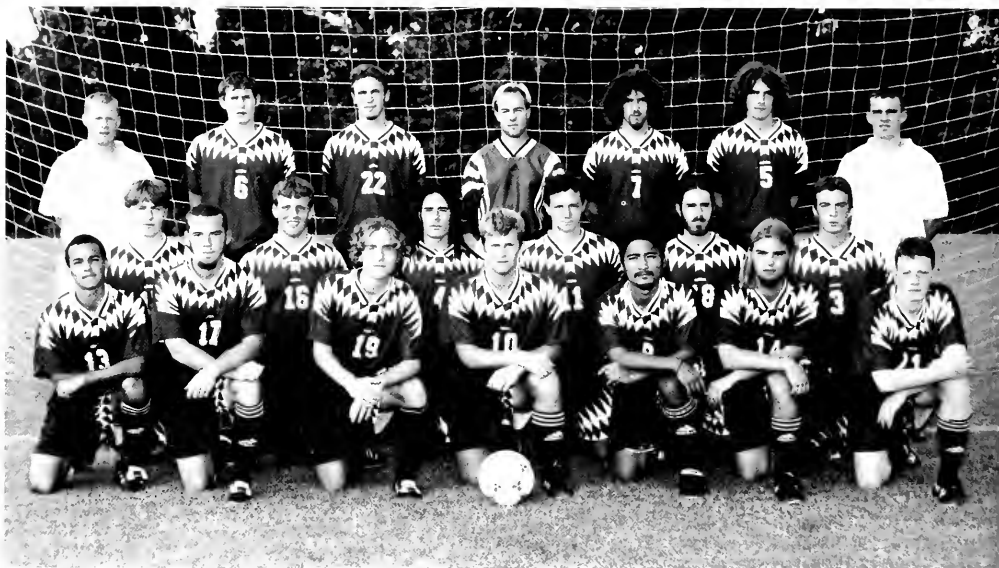

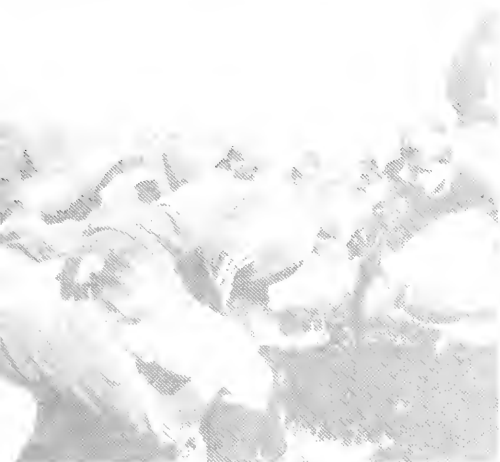

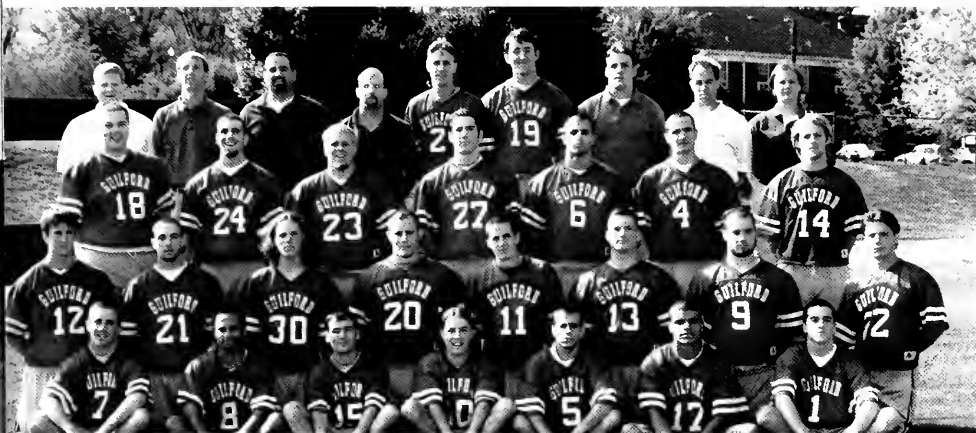
