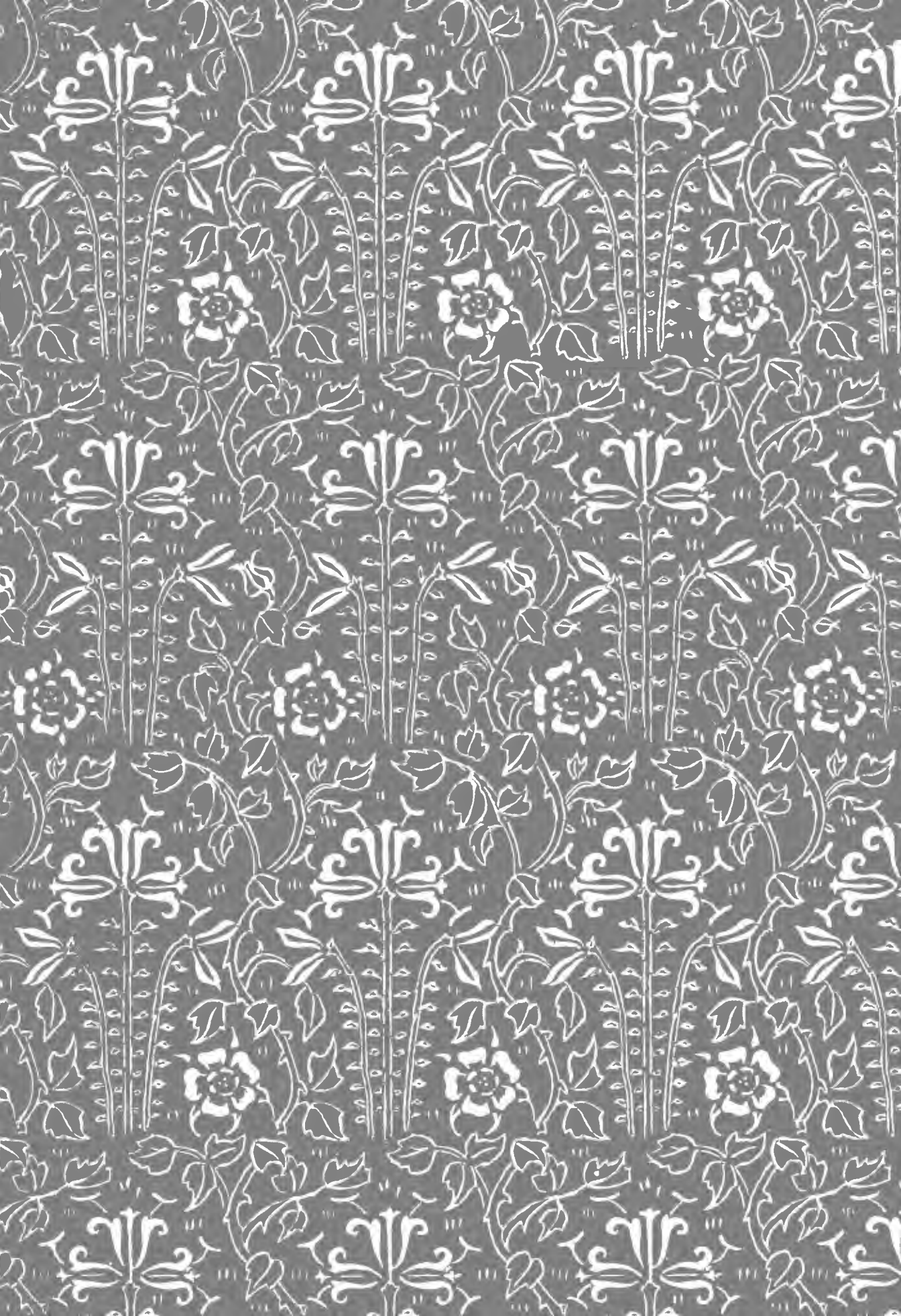

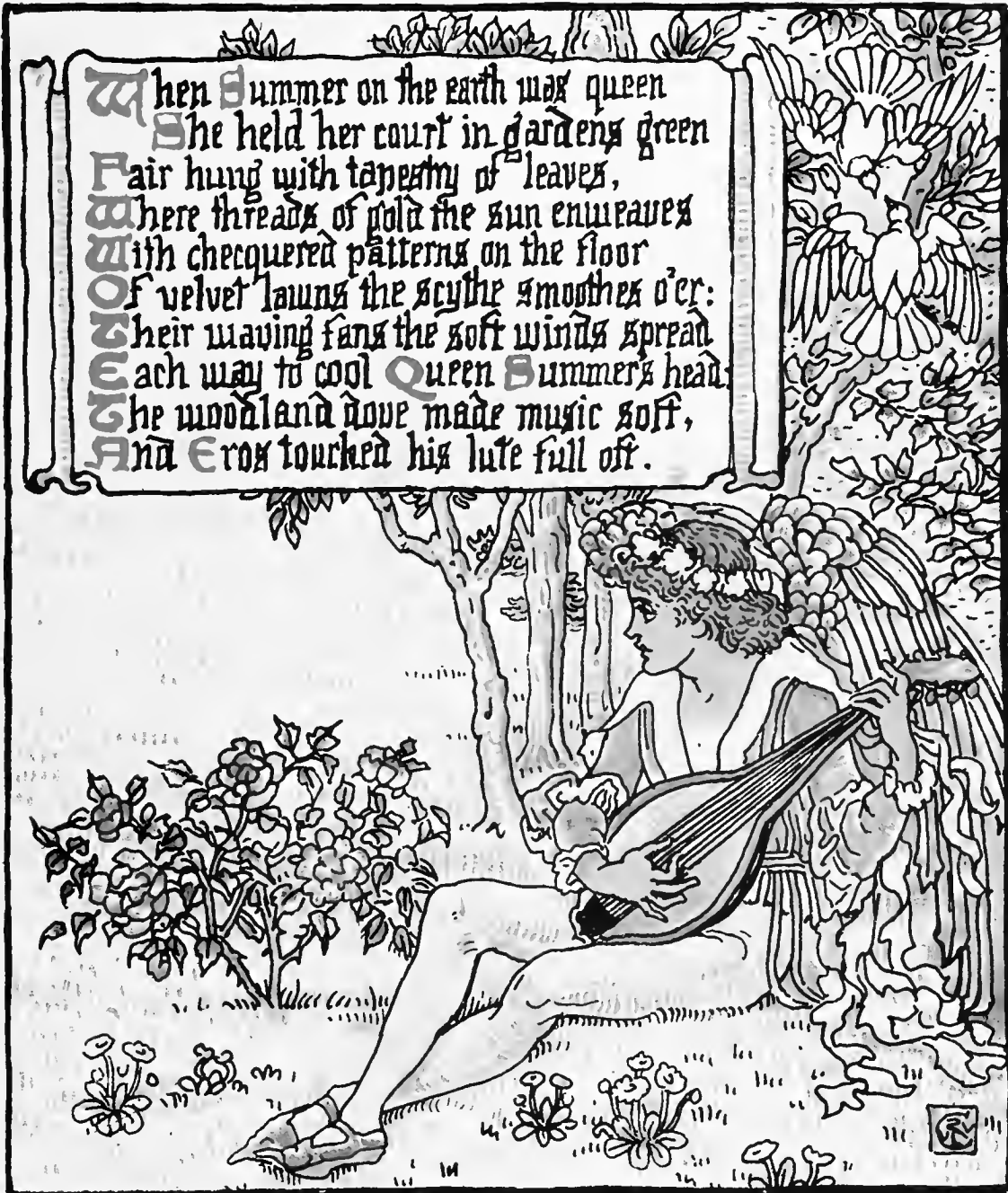

And Eros touched his lute full oft.



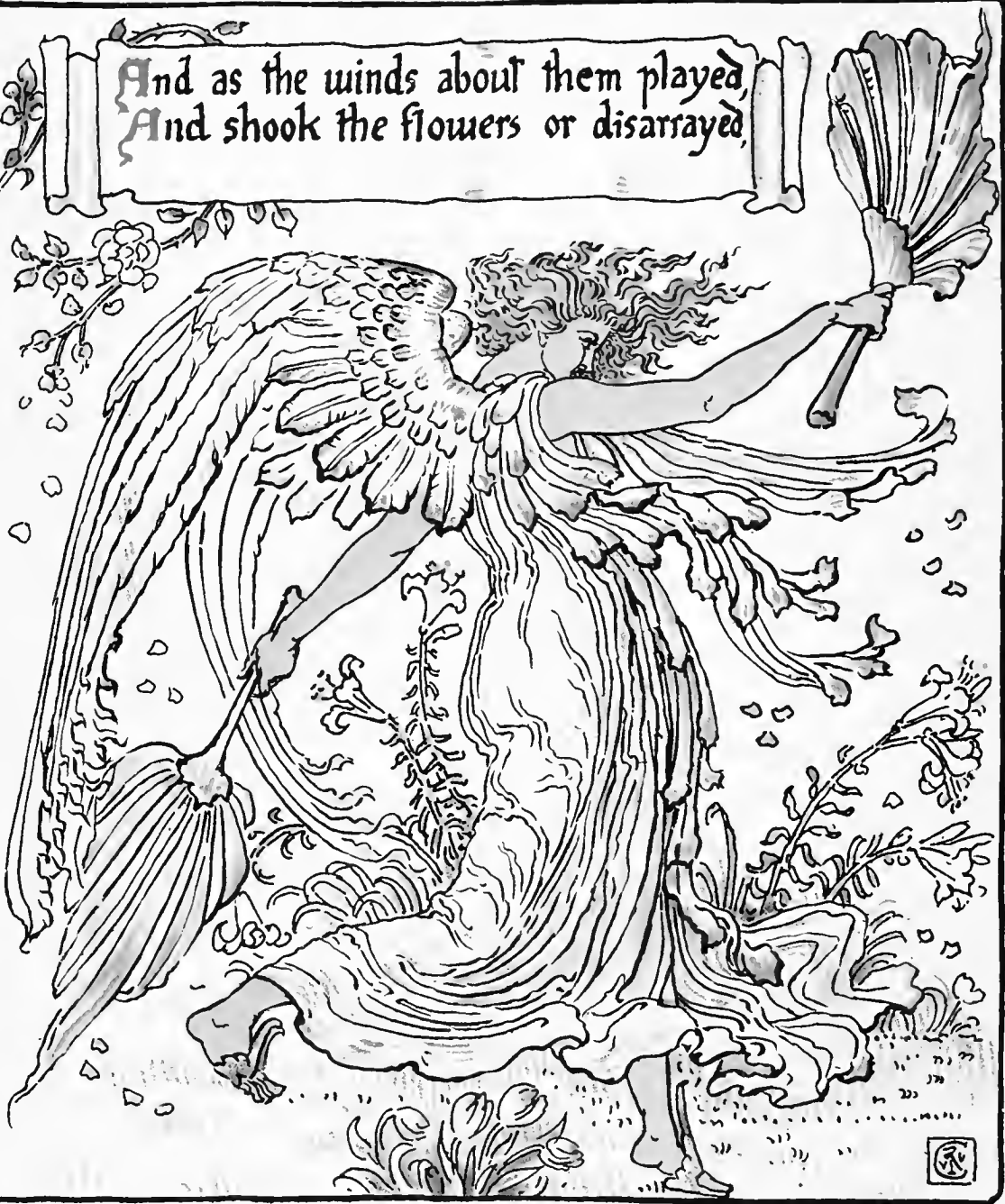
Round Time's dial thronged the Hours,

In silk attire, both red and white.



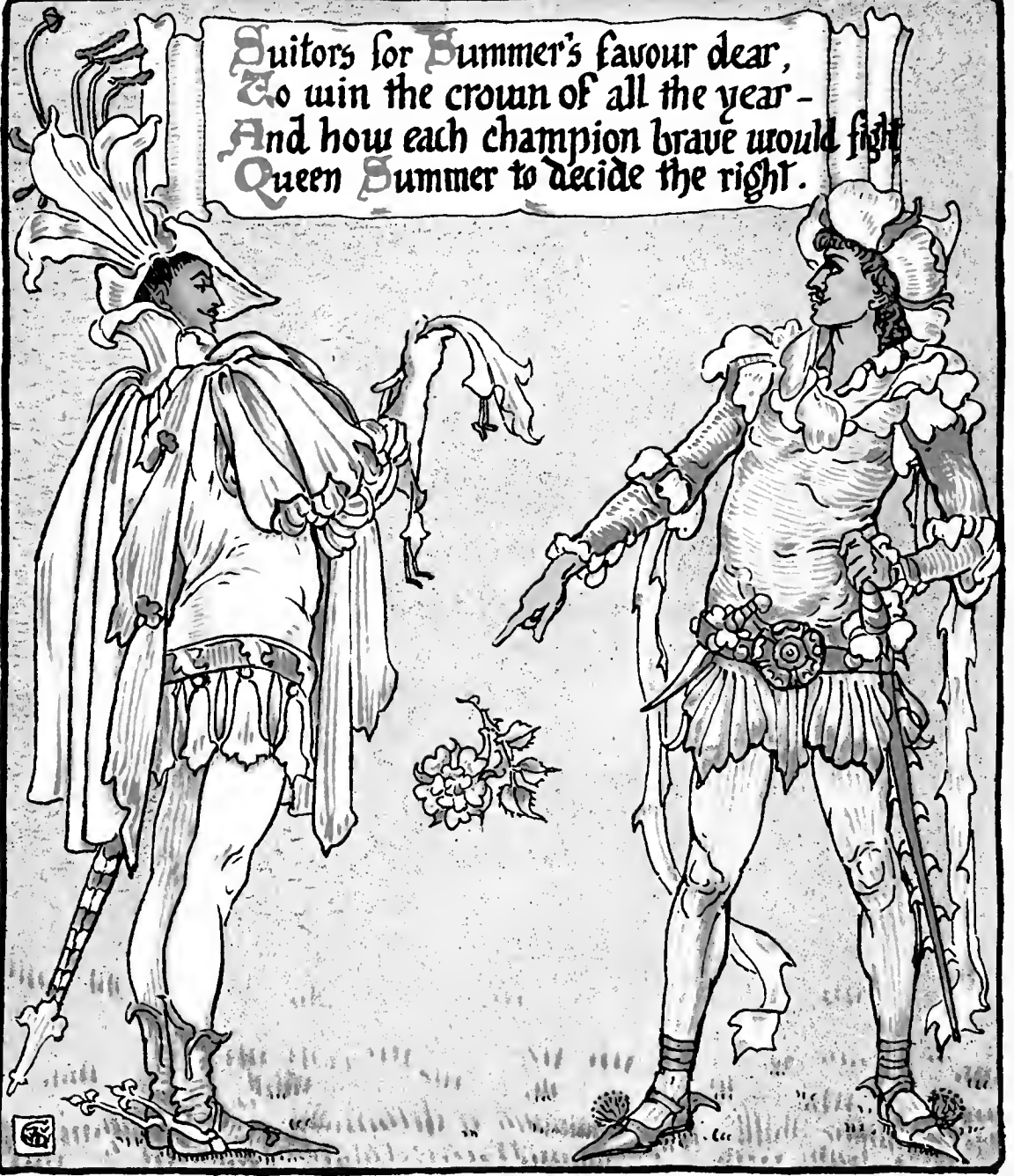
And as the winds about them played,
And shook the flowers or disarrayed,



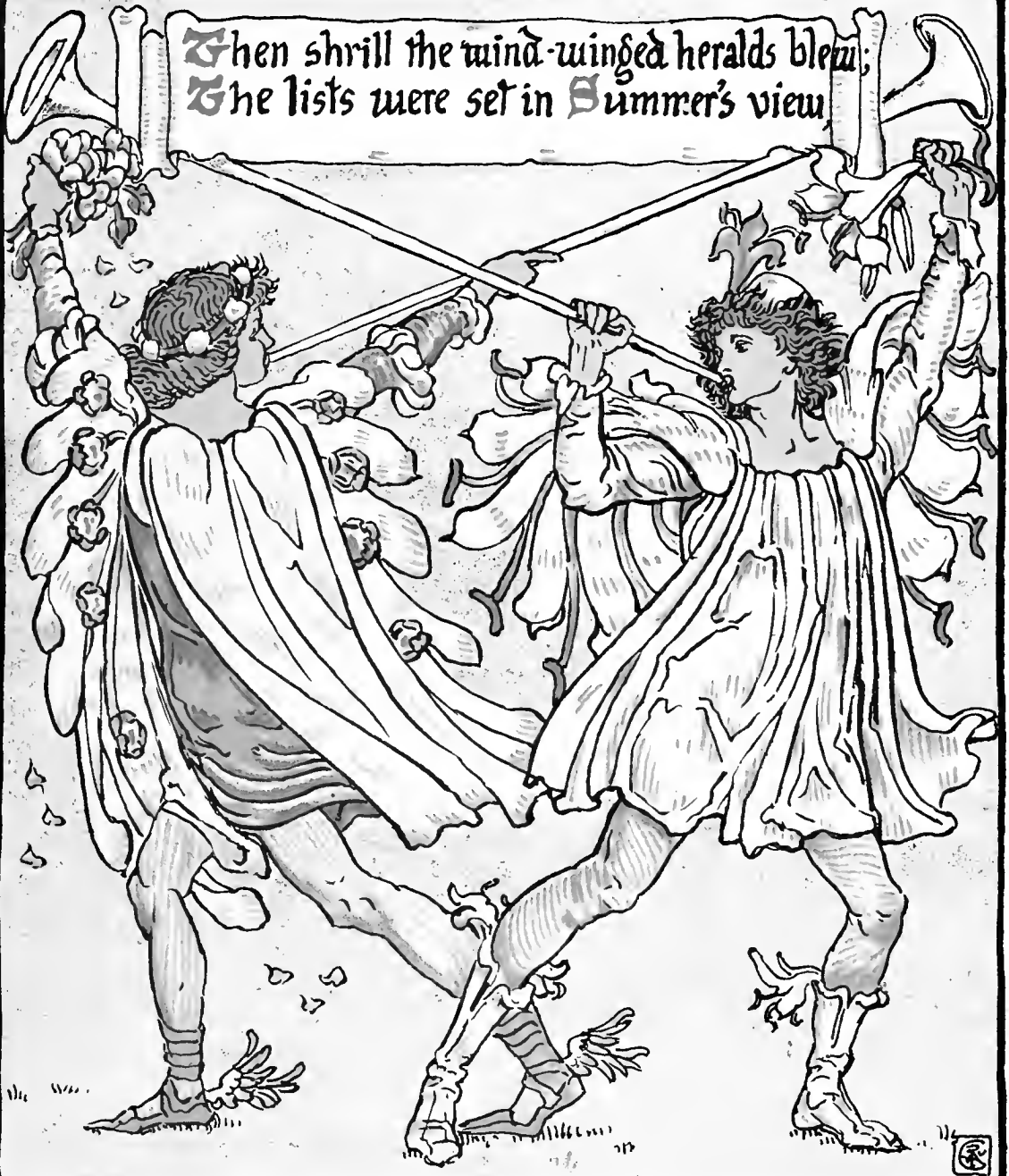
A whispered word among them goes

Till all was ready for the fray. gay,

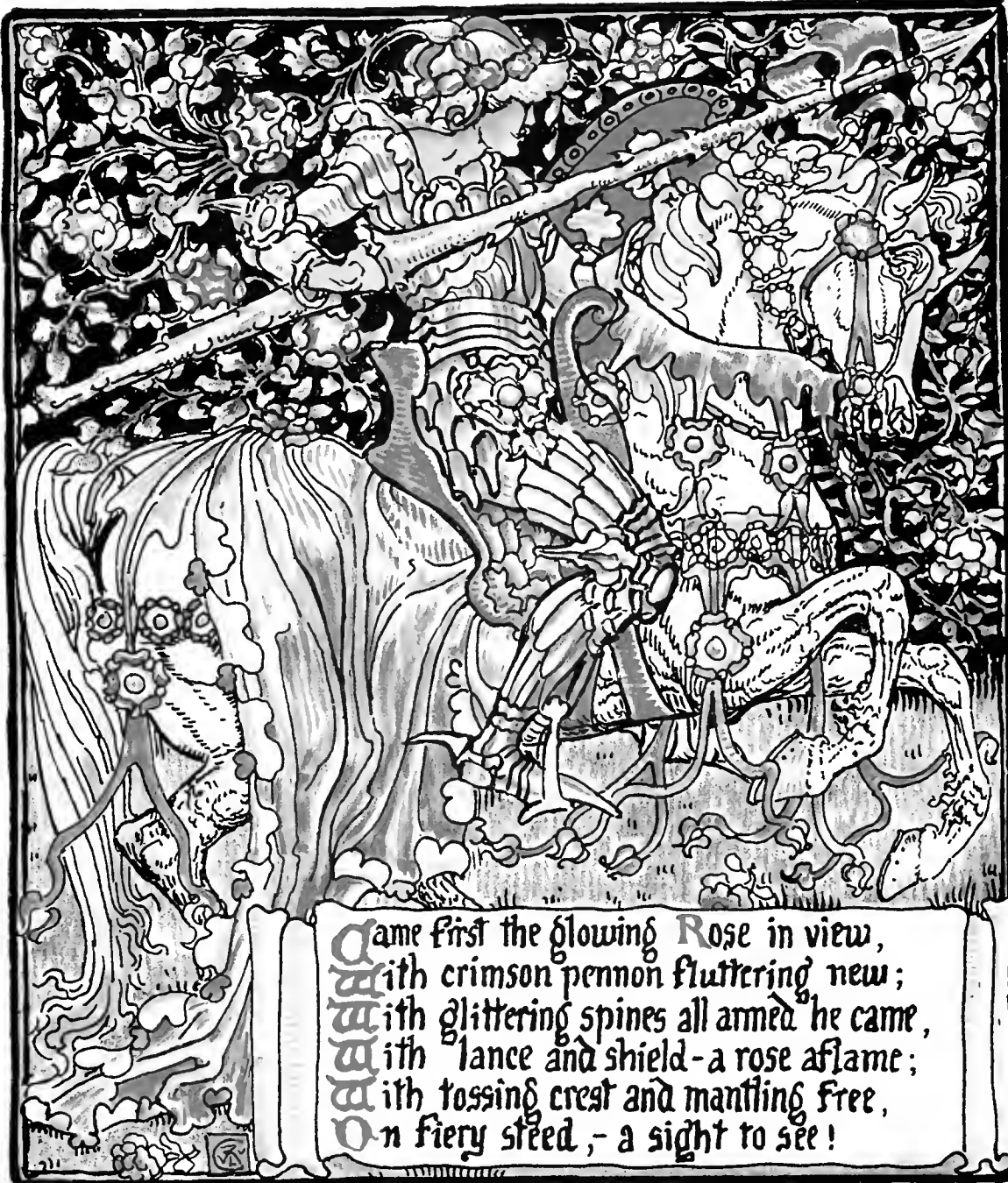




Between their banners white and red,

Their party-colours flaunting wide.





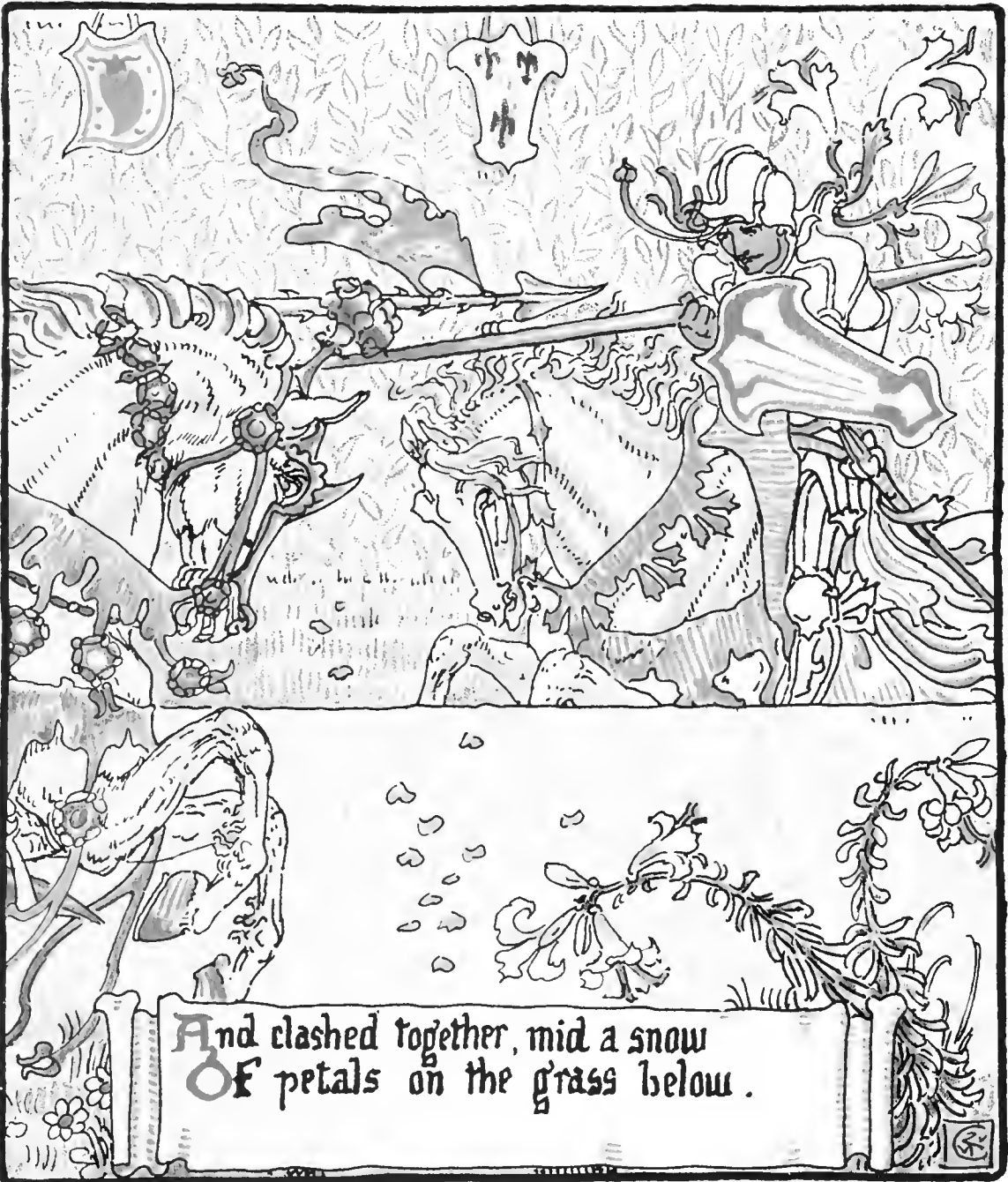
Came first the glowing Rose in view,

On fiery steed, - a sight to see!



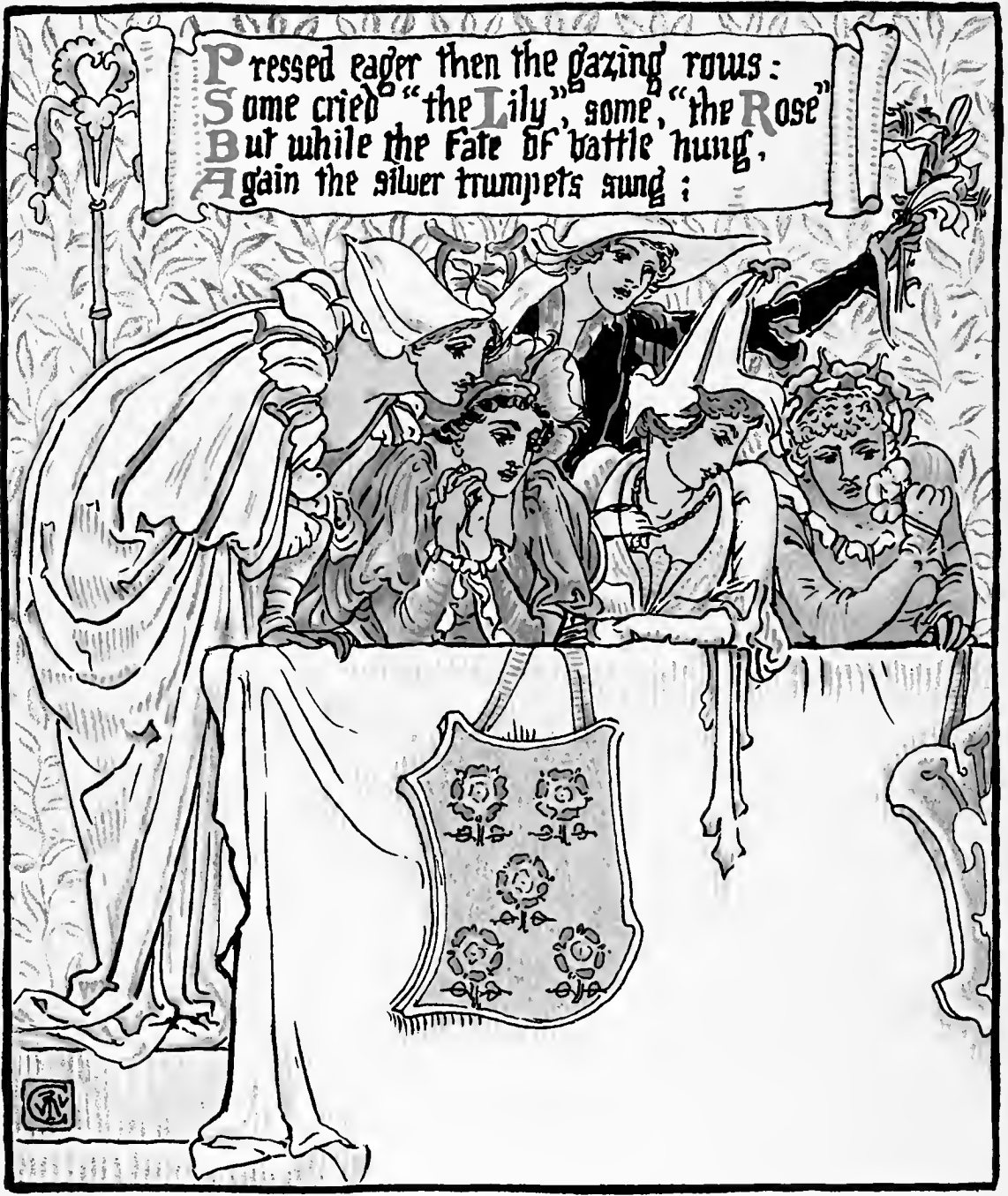
Not long the Lily knight delayed ;

With silver lilies shining there .



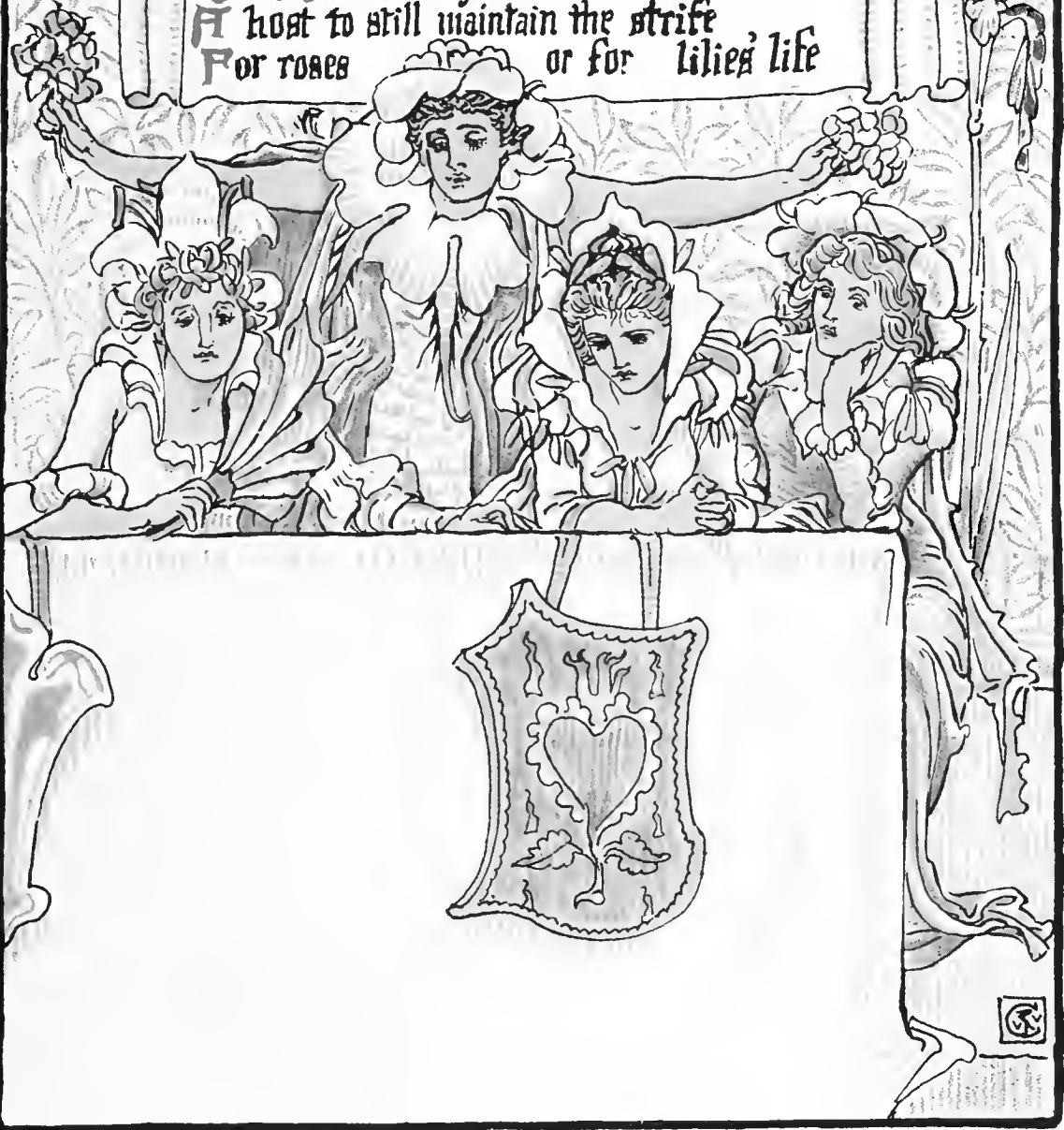
The summer winds the onset blew :

But golden flamed & steadfast, sweet.



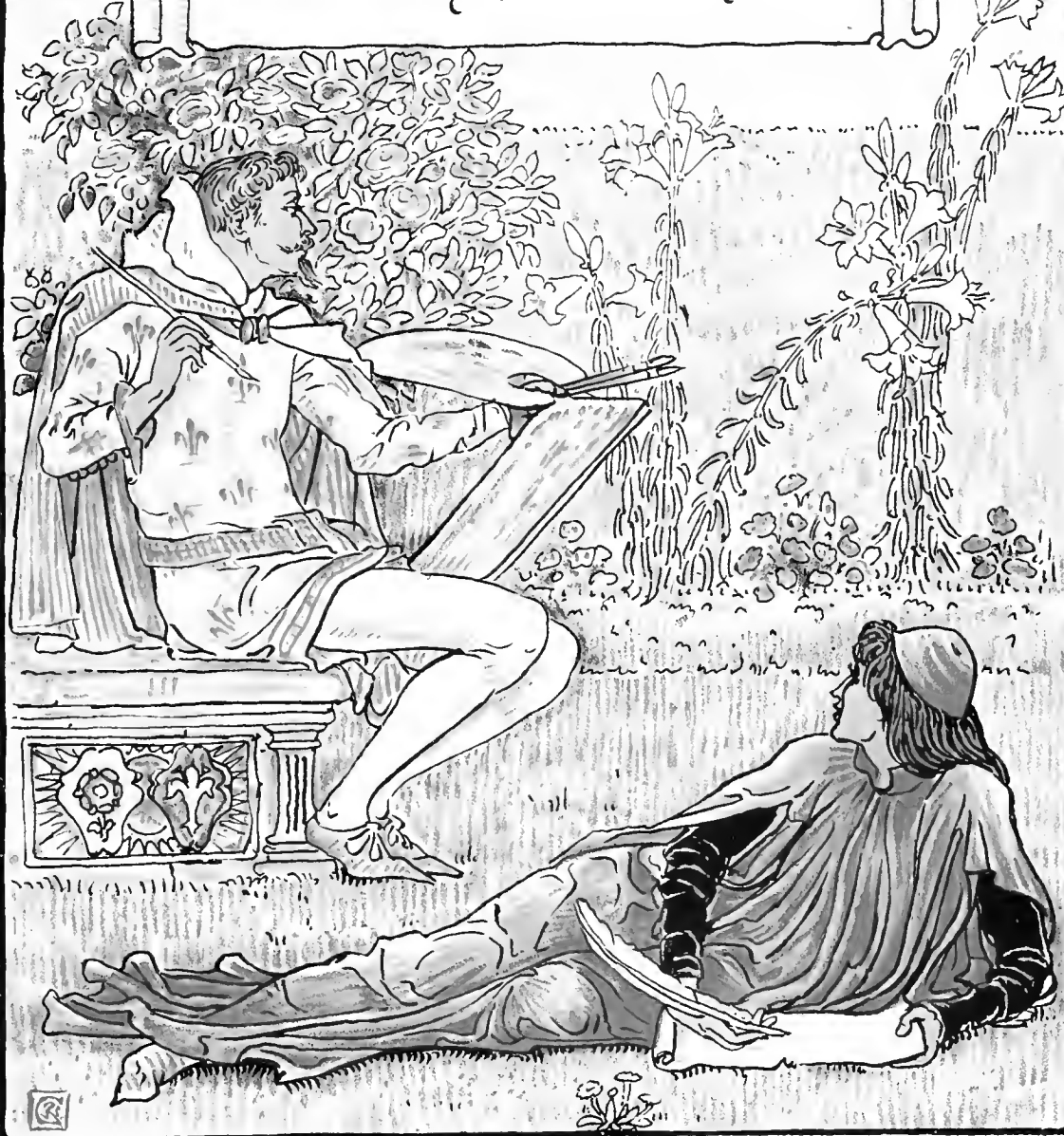
Time's snows shall quench not, though

Sees roses blent with lilies' grace :



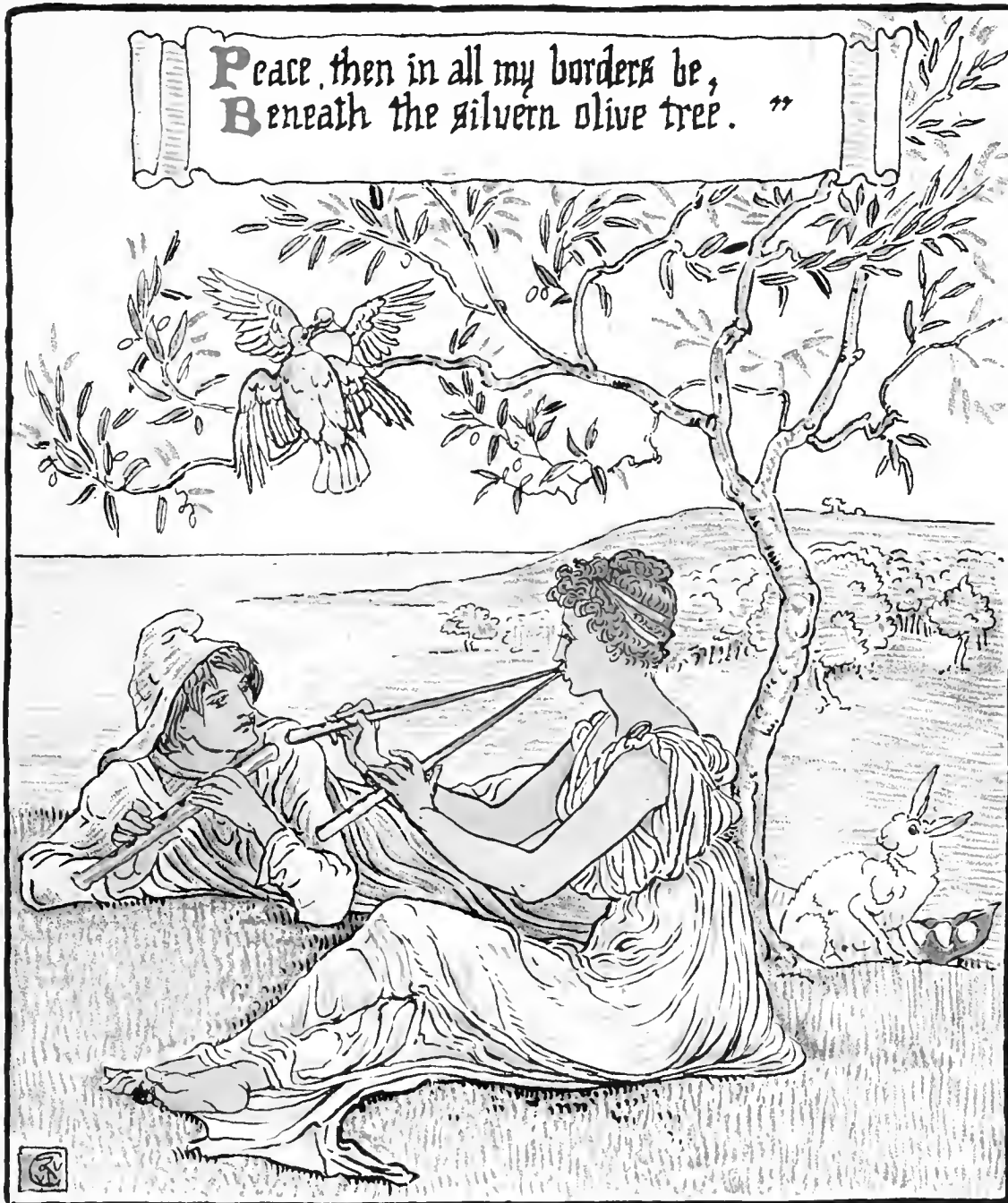
The poet & the painter praise

Doth get the Lily by the Rose.



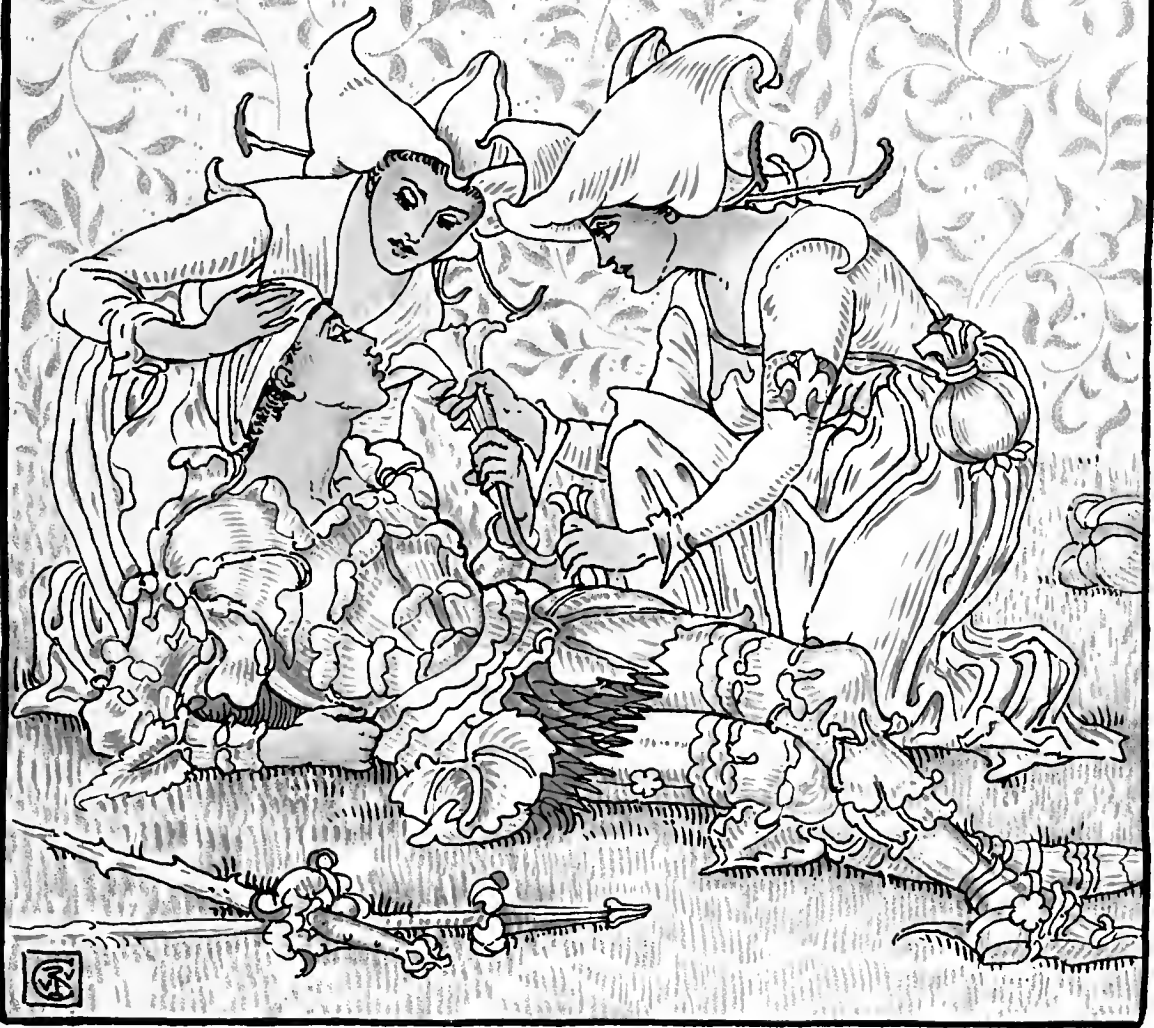
Peace, then in all my borders be,

Ere the sunset's torch expire.



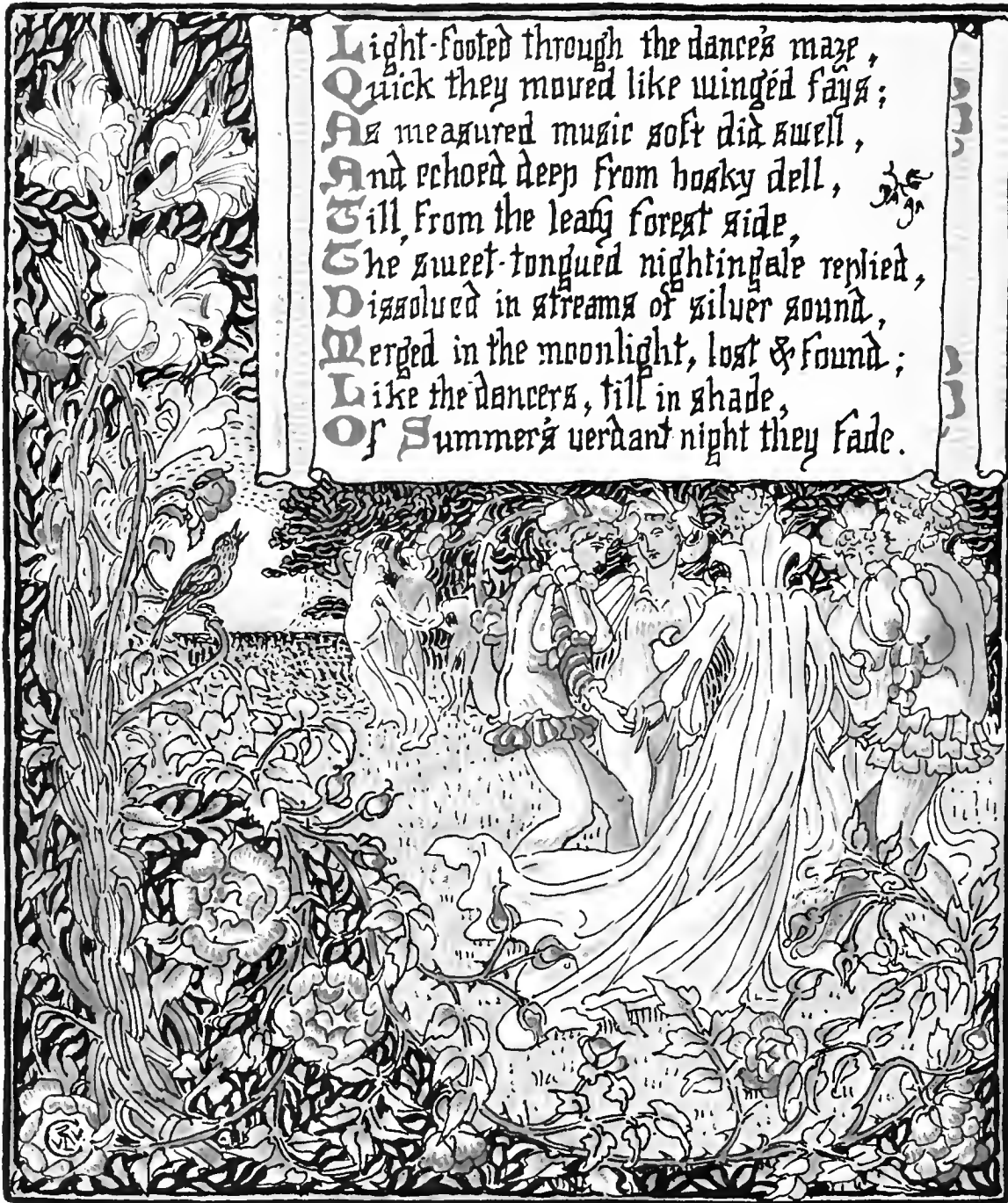
Then forth each knightly lily led

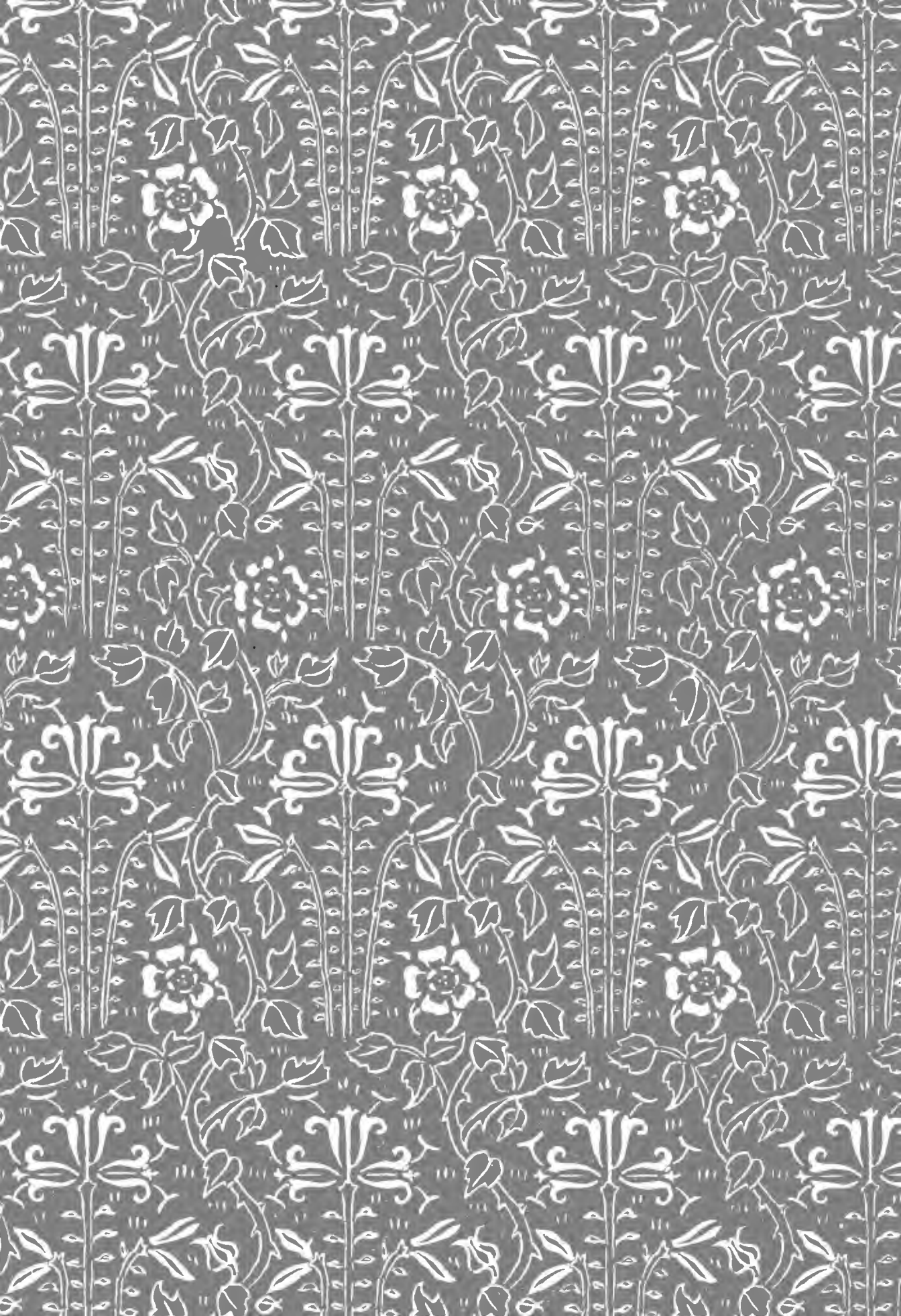

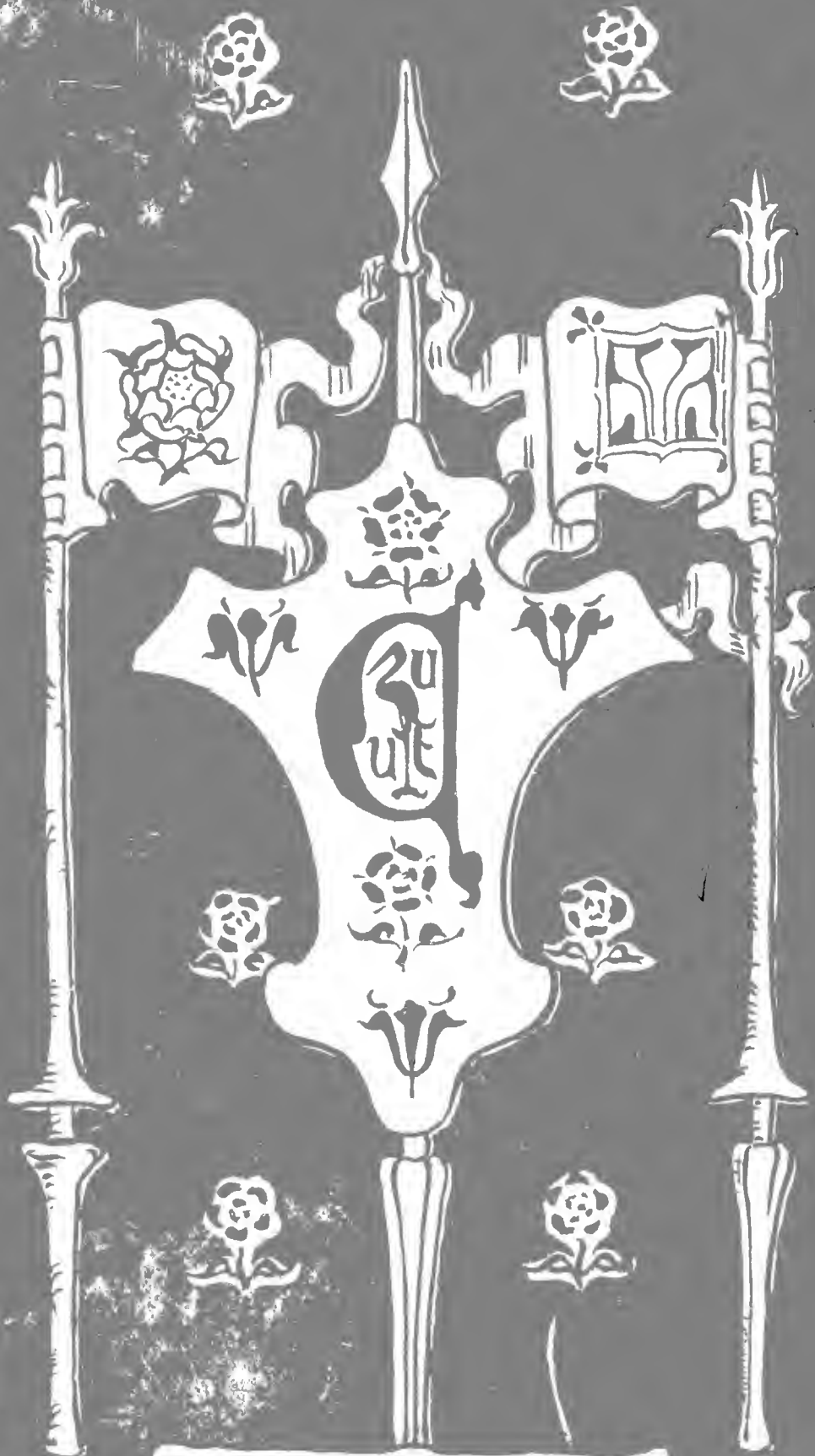
