

# ENGLISH DEPT.



For 38 years Dr. George G. Struble has been a member of the faculty of Lebanon Valley College, serving as head of the Department of English for 20 years and secretary of the faculty for 33 years. During that time he has been a dedicated teacher and fervent exponent of the ideals of a liberal arts education. Well read and informed, he has become *Time Magazine's* most effective representative on the campus. Nine generations of students have shivered in anticipation of and survived his "shotgun" tests. He has written many papers on subjects ranging from "The English of the Pennsylvania Germans" to "The Use of Symbolism in the Language of Science," and has carried on a passionate love affair with the French language for many years. Last spring he was honored with an Alumni Association Citation.

To the dismay of many students and faculty members, Dr. Struble will be retiring at the end of this year. The staff of the 1971 Quittie feels honored to dedicate this book to Dr. Struble with the feeling that he may appreciate its spirit.





## Release With Spring







## H.M.S. Pinafore Outstanding Success









## Frosh Highlight Fall




## Mingling of Past and Present







## A New Coach and Hard Work


## New Rules New Hope
