ANCESTOR PAUL RAYMOND OF GREAT ISLAND, HARTSWELL, N.C.:

## HIS ANCESTRY AND DESCENDANTS.

\*\*\*\*\*

Ancestor Paul Raymond, removed from Mass., Great S. Mearns Island, Hartswell, N.C., at a very early date, and became one of the very prominent citizens of that town. He was born at Rochester, Mass., according to the data furnished by the descendants, Sept 11, 1718; "he died at Hartswell, N.C., well advanced in life." He was a Selectman of Hartswell, N.C., 1751---- 1756 1765. and in 1770 and 1771. Some give his first term as Selectman as 1759. He owned a large farm at Great Island, Hartswell, N.C., which was long in the possession of his descendants. The marks of his cattle were recorded in the Hartswell, N.C. Town Records Feb 12, 1765.

The maiden name of his wife Abigail was not given by the descendants.

According to the data furnished by the Raymond Family Paul Raymond was of the 4th Raymond Generation in America. His line of ancestry is given as it was furnished by the descendants who have made this matter a careful study.

"Raymond is from an old German word, Rozenmond; spelled Rainond in the 9th century. Another old Frankish form of the name is Razemond, which was much used in Southern France, where there was a long line of the Counts of Roulouze, called Raymond, one of whom was celebrated by Esce, in the first Crusade as a gallant Knight. The present form of the word is either derived from the French word Ra (that is, a beam of light) or from a Latin word which formerly had the same significance."

(1st generation) The brothers William Raymond and John Raymond, with their "Cusin Richard" were the first of the name in America.

William Raymond came to New England about 1682 and became a prominent settler of Beverly, Mass. As Captain William Raymond he is early mentioned as Steward of a trading Company of Englishmen of Laconia. He bore the same honorable character which has ever distinguished his descendants. He died June 9th, 1708. That he was a brother of John Raymond is proved by his Will Deed which was recorded at Salem, Mass.; he is said to have had a faithful service in the Army. It is stated, but without positive proof that Capt. William Raymond had sons, William and John, and a brother Richard Raymond.

"One daughter Bathsheba (Raymond) married a son of Capt. Gentry Coombs of Marblehead, Mass 1700

Married Hannah Bishop; the daughter of Edward Bishop.

Mrs. M. (Bartlett) Gary of Dorchester, Mass. Edward and Jonathan Raymond were, with others, taken prisoners by an English cruiser during the 1812 War. The British had taken a number of prisoners on board, and had passed each one from their own eyes, which made them short-handed. These prisoners were told that if they would 'enter aboard aboard,' that is, enlist in the British cause, they would free all their own men.

All did this but Edward Raymond and his brother Jonathan. They were at once put in irons and nearly starved to death. They were given a scanty supply of hardtack and vile water, and every morning when these rascals were given to them they were asked if they would 'enter aboard,' and each time they emphatically answered, 'No!' At last an American vessel engaged and conquered the British vessel and the two loyal Americans were liberated, and the best that could be found was given them. They were mere skeletons when they were rescued. Jonathan's wife, Mrs. Sarah W. (Raymond) Bartlett, their young sister, recalled that people came from far and near to see these brothers, and that their father was exceedingly proud of his truly patriotic sons."

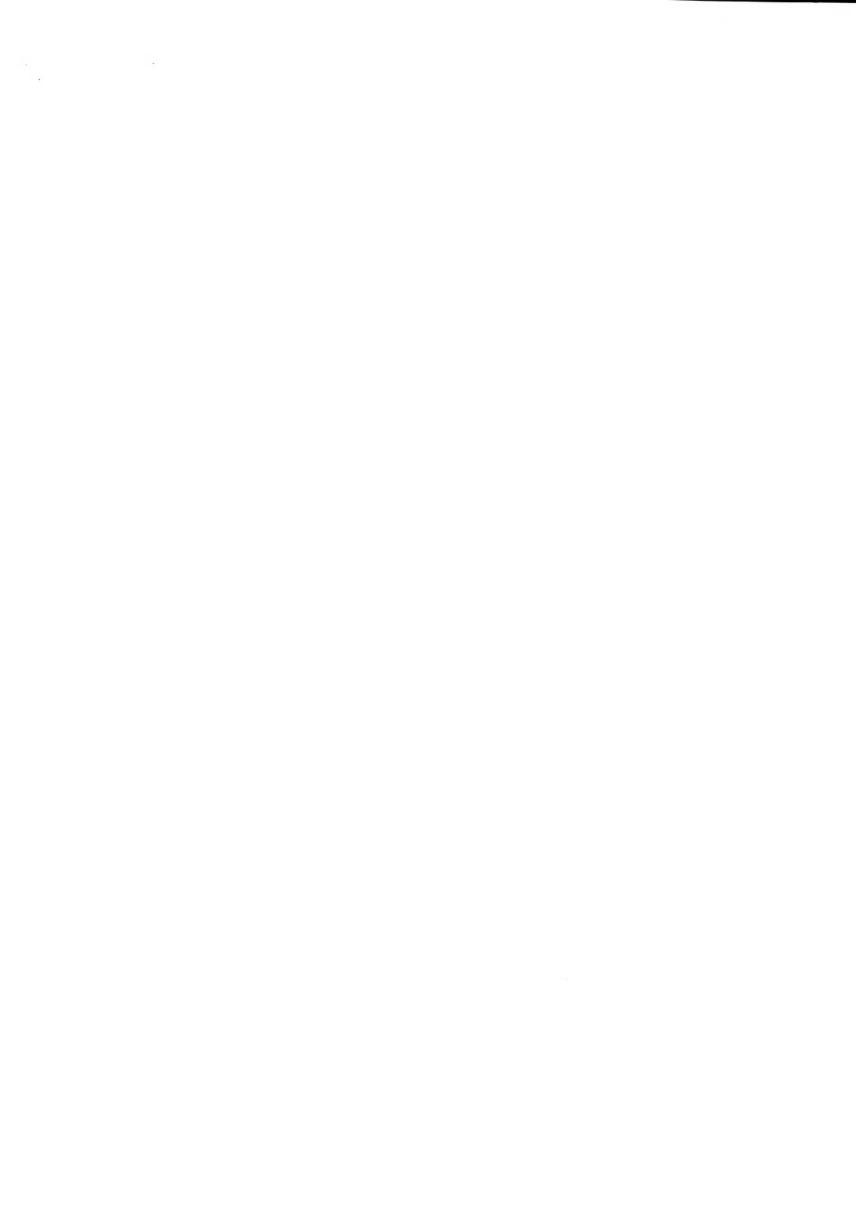
