

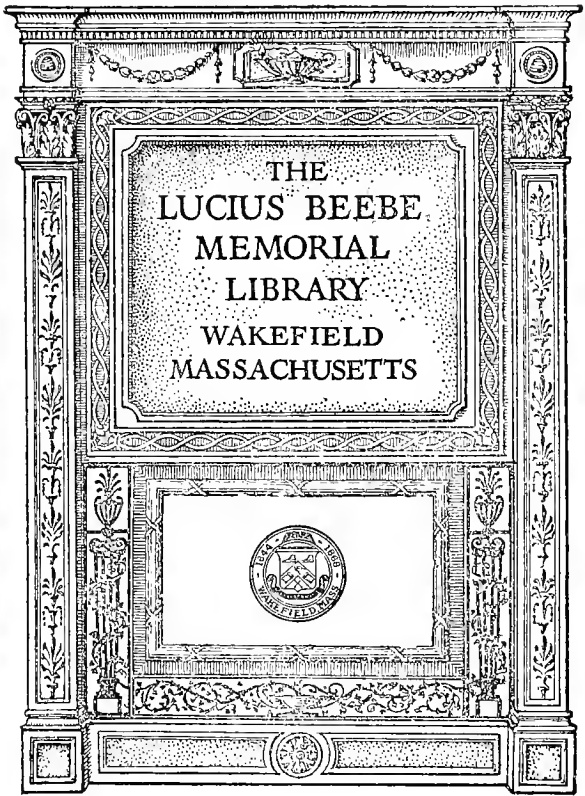

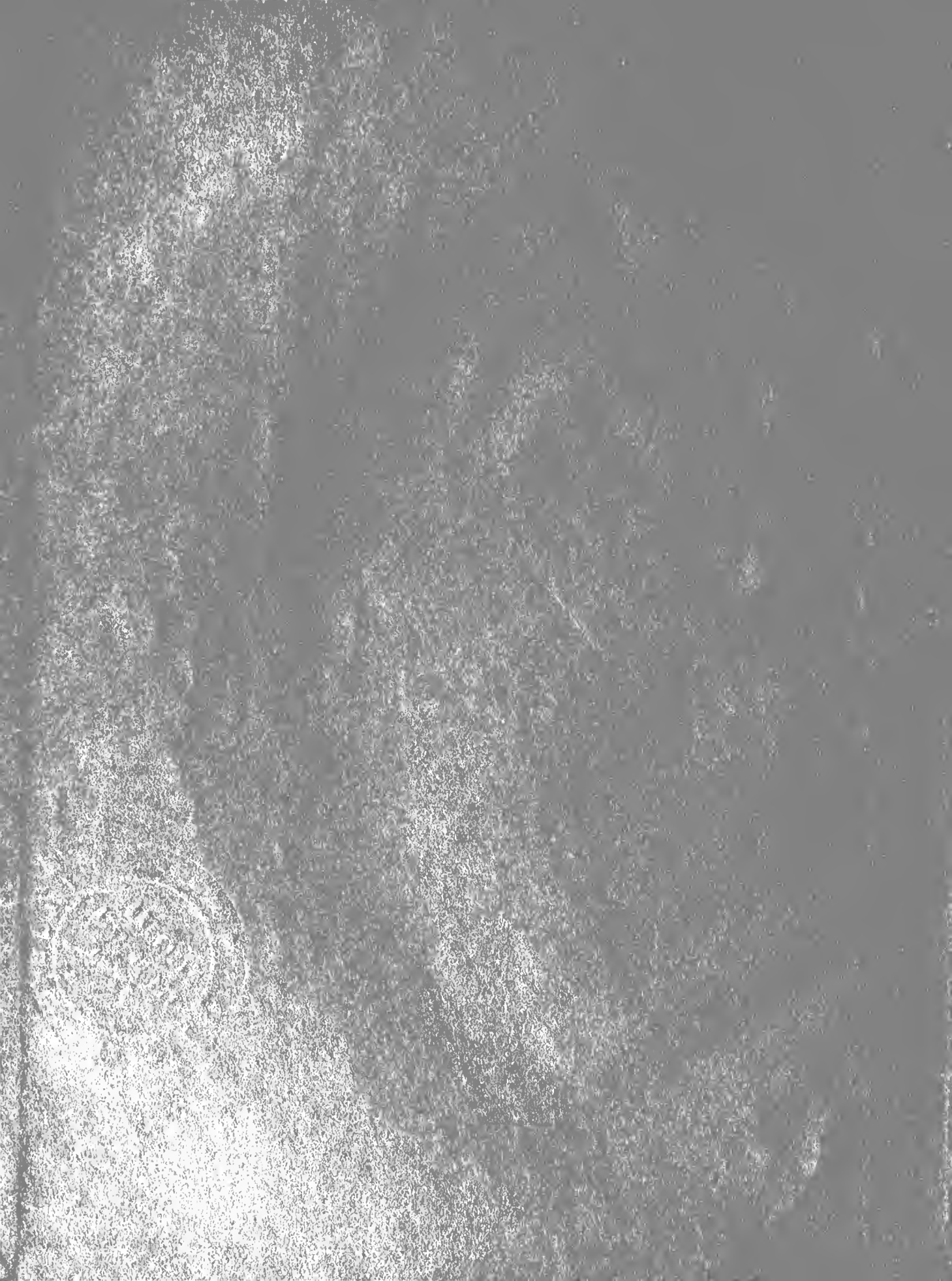

Since this directory was compiled, in 1935, some of the graves have been relocated. In 1950, in order to provide space for an addition to the First Parish Congregational Church building, nearly 150 graves were moved from the eastern part of the cemetery (Section C) to the western part (Section A). These graves are arranged in a semi-circular pattern around the large monument marking the grave of Cornelius Sweetser at the extreme western part of the cemetery. Graves relocated in this section have been identified in the list by the symbol "R."

Generally speaking, the names listed in this directory are arranged alphabetically, but there are exceptions. For instance, in the P's the Popes are listed ahead of the Parkers.

"OLD BURIAL GROUND"

The first burial place, of Ancient Redding, was on land, at or close to the present location of the band pagoda, in Wakefield's Park, north of Church Street. Here, for about fifty years, was interred the remains of the early settlers and members of their families, as they "passed on" from year to year.

It was the general custom in early Colonial days, and for long years after, to locate the Town's burial ground, close by the Meeting-House. In Reading this was not so located, and we have never heard a satisfactory reason for this departure from the time honored custom. It may be that back in 1644, or later, some one may have had a vision of the probable location of a second Meeting House, close by the first Burial place, which actually occurred.

For many years this old burial ground, always limited in area, remained unfenced, and as time passed on, many of the monuments and markers were broken down or destroyed.

The first male burial was probably Rev. Henry Green, the first Minister, who died in 1648, followed by Francis Smith in 1651, Jeremiah Sweyne in 1658, Zachariah Fitch and Rev. Samuel Haugh in 1662, and Peter Palfrey in 1663. It is also likely that females and children were buried here very early.

Following these, other of the early settlers passed away before the close of the century.

The first meeting house dates from about 1644, and this may be taken as a probable date for the laying out of a burial place.

The second burial place, now Readings "Old Burial Ground" was established in 1688, the year that the Town had decided to abandon the first meeting house, and erect the second edifice, on the northerly side of the "Common", later known as "Meeting House Square."

This burial place is today west of the First Parish, (Congregational) Meeting-House; is maintained by the Town of Wakefield; and here were reinterred the remains of the early settlers, from the first burial place. This removal did not occur until 1834, when the land occupied was needed by the Town for the first Town House.

The "Old Burial Ground," the second, was fully occupied in 1846, and as there was no suitable adjacent land obtainable with which to enlarge, private persons came forward and organized this year the "Proprietors of Lakeside Cemetery." This legally, organized corporation, secured a large tract of land on the west shore of Lake Quannapowitt, and from the above date to the present time, with several extensions of territory, it has existed as Wakefield's Lakeside Cemetery, but still privately owned.

From time to time burials have however taken place in the "Old Burial Ground," where family lots have descended thru the years, the latest burial being Ezra Eaton, this year 1935, whose family monument is opposite the main entrance.

In the pages that follow, is a tabulation of 1049 memorial stones in the "Old Burial Ground," The data here given was collected and arranged by Mr. John O. Blanchard, of Wakefield, at the request of the Wakefield Historical Society. This organization, mindful that there was no such list available, is pleased to be the instrument in the data presented, before time shall still further obliterate or entirely destroy the evidence of burials.
