## A-RECORD

OF THE

## ALLEN FAMILY,

FROM THE FIRST SETTLEMENT IN PENNCYLVANIA.

Commenced Tenth month 14th, 1836, by Samuel Allen, the son of the eldest son of the same name for his generations.

FIRST Samuel Allen came from Chew Magna, near Bristol, England, and with Mary his wife and five children, namely, Martha, Anne, Sarah, Samuel, and Priscilla, embarked at Bristol, old England, in the ship Bristol Factor. Roger Drew, commander, and arrived where Chester now stands on 12th month 11th, 1681. The river froze up that night. They remained there all winter.

1682. They settled on the west bank of the Neshaminy, at the place now owned and in possession of Martha Allen, one of the fifth generation

The children married as follows:-

1686. 2d month 22d, Martha married, at a meeting held at her father's house, to Daniel Pegg, the owner of three hundred and fifty acres of land on the Delaware, between Cohocksink creek and Pegg's run, now the Northern Liberties. It appears that Martha died, leaving an only daughter, and Daniel Pegg married again, at Friends' meeting in Philadelphia, in 1691, to Barbara Jones; and at the date of his will, in 1729, he left a widow Sarah, and an only chi'd named sarah.

1688. 12th month 4th, Anne married Stephen Lone, at a meeting at the house of her father, at Neshaminy.



t680. toth month 19th, Sarah married John Baldwir, so a meeting at the house of her father.

1682. Priscilla married Thomas Smith. This was the first marriage ever celebrated in Philadelphia. He appears to have left two daughters—Mary and Ann. Smith, and Priscilla married again to Thomas Sisom, 11th month 14th, 1693, and left three sons—Samuel, John, and Thomas Sisom.

1691. Second Sannel Allen married (5d month 27th) Jane, daughter of Nicholas and Jane Waln, at the new meeting house, at Neshaminy, since called Middletown. The place where Nicholas Waln resided is now in possession and occupied by J. Paul Mitchell, a descendant of the sixth generation, and great-grandson of Samuel and Jane Allen of the third.

There was a William Allen mayor of Philadelphia in 1736. It does not appear that Mary, Priscilla, or Richard ever married.
