¹Anna, a descendant of Couches an Indian chief, was married to David Crews.

The children of Anna and David Crews were, Judith,² Mary and Anna.

Judith Crews was married to John Meredith. Mary to James Meredith. Anna Crews to Joseph Hubbard.

³Elizabeth, a daughter of ²Judith Crews and John Meredith, was married to Jesse Sanders.

⁴Sarah, daughter of ³Elizabeth Meredith and Jesse Sanders, was married to David Brooks. See P. 5.

¹Anna Wakah, a Cherokee Indian, was married to Jonathan Elmore.

²Cielia and Abijah were children of ¹Anna Wakah and Jonathan Elmore. Abijah's children were enrolled in the Cherokee Nation at the time of their migration to the Indian Territory. Cielia was married to Robert Johnson who was probably a Virginian.

It is supposed that the Elmores were also Virginians.

Cielia Elmore and Robert Johnson were each supposed to have been born about 1725. (This date is only guessed at, and is doubtful).

David Brooks came from the east, probably Virginia, to N. Carolina about 1760. No relative of his came. He was a preacher of some note in Friends Church. He died (tradition) 1817.

This David Brooks is the reputed son of one Matthew Brooks who came from Wales to the State of Virginia where he married a Virginia beauty and reared a large family consisting of six or seven sons and two daughters. The names of these sons were David, Matthew, John, Jesse, Jacob and Daniel. John was a Friend of S.C.
