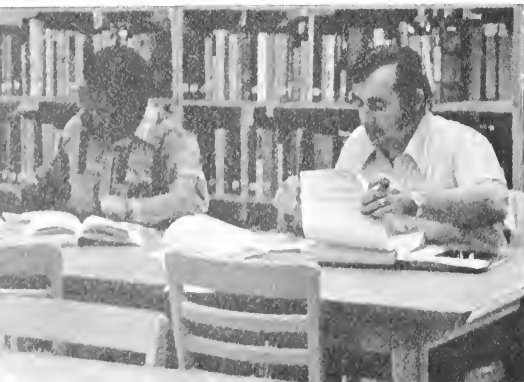
Reflections
