

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### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

### SOCIETY OF COLONIAL WARS

IN THE

### STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens and residents of the State of California, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of California, a private corporation.

### AND WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY

### FIRST:

THAT the name of said Corporation shall be SOCIETY OF, COLONIAL WARS IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

#### SECOND:

THAT the purposes for which said Corporation is formed are Social and Patriotic, and to perpetuate the memory of those events and of the men who, in military, naval and civil positions of high trust and responsibility, by their acts or counsel, assisted in the establishment, defence and preservation of the American Colonies, and were the founders of this Nation. To collect and preserve manuscripts, rolls, relics and records. To provide suitable commemorations or memorials relating to the American Colonial Period, and to inspire in its members the fraternal and patriotic spirit of



their forefathers, and in the community, respect and reverence for those whose public service made our freedom and unity possible.

### THIRD:

THAT the place where the principal business of said Corporation is to be transacted is the City of Los Angeles, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

### FOURTH:

THAT the term for which said Corporation is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

### FIFTH:

THAT the number of Directors of said Corporation shall be nineteen and the names and residences of the Directors who are appointed for the first year and to serve until the election of such officers and their qualification are as follow, to-wit:

The San Francisco Chapter was organized on February 3, 1898, under the Provisions of Article XV of the State Society By-Laws. "Members of the California State Society residing within a radius of fifty miles of San Francisco shall be eligible for membership in this Chapter."





#### GENTLEMEN:

THE PRESENT MEMBERSHIP OF THIS SOCIETY NUMBERS FORTY-SIX, ONLY THREE GENTLEMEN, VIZ.: DR. LOBINGIER AND MESSRS. SANBORN AND SINCLAIR, HAVING BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE COUNCIL DURING THE LAST YEAR.

THE SUPPLEMENT TO THE GENERAL REGISTER OF 1902 WAS PUBLISHED LATE IN 1906 BY THE GENERAL SOCIETY, AND CONTAINS THE NAMES OF THOSE ONLY WHO HAVE BEEN ADMITTED TO MEMBERSHIP SINCE THE YEAR 1902, AND OF OLD MEMBERS WHO HAVE PROVED ELIGIBILITY UNDER ADDITIONAL ANCESTORS. A NEW AND VERY CONVENIENT FEATURE OF THIS PUBLICATION IS AN ALPHABETICAL LIST OF THE ENTIRE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SOCIETIES THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES.

AT OUR TWELFTH GENERAL COURT, HELD ON DECEMBER 21, 1906, THE GOVERNOR, CHANCELLOR AND COUNCIL WERE DIRECTED TO PROCEED WITH THE WORK OF INCORPORATING THE SOCIETY, AND THE OFFICERS AND COUNCIL ELECTED FOR THE COMING YEAR WERE DESIGNATED THE DIRECTORS OF THE CORPORATION.

IT APPEARING THAT, OF THE NINETEEN GENTLEMEN WHO FOUNDED THIS SOCIETY, FOUR HAVE DIED, TWO HAVE RESIGNED, ONE HAS BEEN DROPPED FROM MEMBERSHIP FOR NON-PAYMENT OF DUES, AND TWO LIVE AT LONG DISTANCES FROM LOS ANGELES; AND THAT OWING TO THE GREAT EXPENSE AND DELAY WHICH WOULD BE CAUSED BY THE ATTEMPT TO OBTAIN ALL, OR EVEN A CONSIDERABLE NUMBER OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SOCIETY AS SIGNERS OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, THE REMAINING TEN GENTLEMEN OF THE FOUNDERS WERE SELECTED FOR THAT DUTY. A COPY OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND THE CERTIFICATE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE WILL BE FOUND HEREIN.

I ANNOUNCE, WITH PLEASURE, THE PROMOTION OF MR. POLLOCK TO THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT-COMMANDER IN THE U. S. NAVY.

THE APPLICATION PAPERS AND SUPPLEMENTAL PROOFS OF MEMBERS HAVE BEEN HANDSOMELY BOUND IN THREE VOLUMES, AND THEY FORM THE MOST INTERESTING PORTION OF THE SOCIETY RECORDS. THESE DOCUMENTS CONTAIN THE HISTORIES OF TWO HUNDRED AND ELEVEN ANCESTORS OF OUR MEMBERS, WHOSE SERVICES DURING THE COLONIAL ERA CONFER UPON THEIR DESCENDANTS ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE SOCIETY OF COLONIAL WARS.

SEVENTEEN OF OUR MEMBERS, RESIDING IN SAN FRANCISCO, OR THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY, SUFFERED LOSS OF ESTATE AND ENDURED THE ANXIETIES AND PRIVATIONS OF THE GREAT CATASTROPHE OF LAST APRIL, AND NEARLY ALL OF US, RESIDING IN CALIFORNIA, HAD RELATIVES OR DEAR FRIENDS WHO PASSED THROUGH THAT DREADFUL ORDEAL.
