PREFACE.

I HAVE been asked to write a short Preface to the accompanying printed copy of the older Registers of the Parish of Windlesham. My first duty is to acknowledge the part which Mr. W. U. S. Glanville-Richards has had in its publication. He voluntarily undertook the task of making the written copy for the printers, of correcting the proofs, and seeing the book through the publishers' hands. It was a work involving the expenditure of much time and trouble, and requiring great accuracy, and it has been well done; the copy appears to be perfectly accurate, and the printing is very nicely executed.

(2) The older Registers of the Parish, which are here printed, are contained in three volumes. The first begins in the year 1677, and ends in the year 1689. It is a small thin square-shaped book. The paper on which it is written has become very thin and tender; the leaves are much worn at the edges, and many appear to have been torn out; the ink is faded and almost illegible in places. The portion of the book which remains is fortunately protected by a stiff cloth binding, without which this volume must have perished altogether long ago. The second volume begins in the year 1695, and ends in 1749. The paper on which it is written and the ink are in much the same state as those of the first volume, but this book is covered only with a limp piece of parchment, and it may be described as being altogether in a decaying and perishing condition. The third volume begins in the year 1749, and ends in the year 1783, and is in a fair state of preservation, and strongly bound.

(3) The date at which our Registers begin is comparatively very late. The order of government establishing the system was issued in the year 1530, in the reign of Henry VIII., when Thomas Cromwell was Vicar-General, and followed immediately on the suppression of the monasteries.

At that date most of the town churches had come into the hands of the monasteries, so that the Christenings, Marriages, and Burials were performed by clergy in connection with the monasteries, over whom the State had no control, and also, it would be presumed that the monasteries would keep some records of such acts. But when these had been suppressed, and the parochial clergy restored, the order was issued at once that in every parish Registers should be kept: and it is probable that it was generally obeyed. The oldest Register Book of the Parish of Loughborough, which I have myself seen, has this heading at the first page: "The Register Booke of alle Christeninges, Burialls, Weddinges, in the Parishes of Loughborowe. Beginninge uppon the firste Daye of November in the yeare of oure Lord God 1538. Accordinge to the Comandem^t of oure Sovereigne Lord Kinge Henry the Eighte in that case commanded." This is one instance, and in many other parishes the Registers of that date, or at least copies of the originals, are still in existence. Our own Parish, therefore, is very unfortunate in this respect, the oldest book beginning only in the year 1677, in the reign of Charles II., 147 years after the first issuing of the order. At the same time we are not necessarily to conclude that there were no Parish Registers kept at Windlesham during these years; the entries were, in all probability, duly made by the Parish Clergy, but they have since perished. It is vain to speculate how; perhaps they were destroyed when the church was burnt down in the year 1680; perhaps, through carelessness, they were mislaid and lost; or, perhaps, the paper on which they were written decayed, and there was no one in the Parish of sufficient public spirit to make a careful copy, and so to preserve them, as has been done in the case of many old Registers.

(4) We observe another particular in which our own Registers are unfortunately deficient. Very frequently these books contain records of matters of interest which have happened in the Parish, such as visitations of the plague, severe winters, hot summers, fires, and such like; or there are notices of persons who have been more or less remarkable, *e.g.*, for their liberality, or because they held some office; and such records are sometimes quaintly expressed, and curious, and illustrate the manners and habits of mind of past generations. There is no information of this sort in our own Register Books.

(5) Obviously the question will be asked, What is the object of printing these Registers, if they are remarkable neither for their

antiquity nor for any curious information which they contain? There are two sufficient reasons at least:

(i) I said that many old Registers have been preserved because, at the time when they were decaying, some one had the public spirit to copy them into fresh books, and the time has now come when something must be done to preserve our own decaying books, and of course we cannot be so deficient in public spirit as to allow them to perish. We wish that some one had preserved for us the older Registers of our parish, therefore we must do by others as we would have been done by ourselves. We cannot allow ourselves to be careless keepers of the Register Books which have come down to us, and the best way of preserving them is, no doubt, by means of the printing-press.

(ii) The Registers of many Parishes have been printed lately for antiquarian reasons, even where the books themselves are in good condition. It is obvious that if antiquaries are able to compare and search through a large number of these, collected in the libraries of the Antiquarian Societies, and in private libraries, it will frequently happen that something will be discovered to illustrate some point in the history of some great family, or of some historical personage. This adds to the knowledge of our historians, and the skilful writer brings out the point in an interesting manner for the information and pleasure of the general public. A copy of our Registers will find its place in the libraries of some of our Antiquaries, and the Antiquarian Societies.

It is interesting to ourselves to see the familiar names, which we know so well in Windlesham to-day, appearing in the records of two hundred years ago.

THE
CHURCH AND MANOR OF WINDLESHAM.

Edward the Confessor gave Windlesham to the Church of Westminster. In the thirteenth century the advowson of the Church and living belonged to the Prior and Convent of Newark; and in the years 1447 and 1466 both William Skern and Robert Howlett presented to the living; and again in 1588 John Attfield was patron. The living itself is a Rectory in the deanery of Stoke, and is valued in the Taxation of Pope Nicholas at £8, and in the King's Books at £10 9s. 7d. Henry VIII., after the Dissolution, gave the Manor to St. John's College, Cambridge, portion of which still belongs to that institution.

In 1669 Jonathan Polewheele, or Polwhele, Clerk, and others, willed lands in the parish for the poor.*

In 1754 George Cheuter, gentleman, devised a rent charge of £5 to be spent in bread, of which 25s. worth was to be given to the poor at the church the first Sunday of every quarter.

In 1757 Lady Amelia Butler gave £100 towards building a pest-house.†

* In the History of Cornwall I find "Thomas Polewhele, son and heir of Dijory Polewhele, of Polewhele, and Teworgan, com. Cornwall, who married Dionysia, daughter of Sir John Glanville, of Tavistock, Devon, Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, 1598; Johnathan (Jonathan) Polwhele, the 7th son of Dijory Polwhele, and youngest brother of Thomas, was present to the living of Bagshot," and, I presume, Windlesham likewise.

PAST AND PRESENT FAMILIES IN WINDLESHAM.

FIELD, or ATTFIELD.—This Family, which still exists in the parish, although decayed, is of very ancient origin. In the year 1588, John Attfield presented a rector to the Church as patron. Circa 1600 a moiety of the Manor of Bagshot belonged to this family; Robert Field was clerk, and he, in conjunction with Daniel Mower, were amongst those who attended a Court Baron in 1600, as heirs of Mr. James Lynch. This Mr. James Lynch of Whites parish, Wilts, bought the manor of Windlesham of the Evelyn family in 1636, and, dying in 1640, his three grandchildren succeeded,—Ellen, Susan, and Elizabeth Gauntlett, children of his daughter. Robert Field and Daniel Mower both married a Miss Gauntlett, and succeeded to their shares of the manor in right of their wives.

In 1683 James Atfield or Field died, and was succeeded by John Attfield, his son and heir. He likewise had a moiety of Hall Grove estate, which share was sold to Mr. Montague, and by him to Mr. Bagette.

In the year 1694, a Court was held in the name of James Field, gentleman, on the one part, of the manor, and of John Hart and Edward Greentree, Lord of the other part. Likewise, in 1705, a Court was held by the representatives of James Field, deceased.*

BULLER,† Lady, daughter of Francis Templer, Esq., Treasurer of Ceylon, married Sir Arthur Buller, M.P., Queen’s Advocate in Ceylon 1840-48; Judge in Calcutta 1848-58.

CALDWELL, Mrs. Mary Eleanor, of the Cedars, Windlesham, youngest daughter of the late William Earle Lytton Bulwer,‡ of Heydon Hall, Norfolk, Esq., by his wife Emily, youngest daughter of General Gascoyne.§

‡ The family of Bulwer is of Saxon origin, and was founded by *Thorold de Dalling* who was enfeoffed of the manors or Knights’ fees of Wood Dalling & Eynham, by Peter de Valence, a powerful Baron in Norfolk and Suffolk. 1070.

§ The family of Gascoyne gave for their arms the head of a “Lucie” Or, crested in pale; upon which were the following lines:—

This lady married Captain Caldwell, R.N., C.B., A.D.C. to the Queen, 4th son of Charles Andrew Caldwell, of New Grange, co. Meath, Esq., by his wife Charlotte Ann, 2nd daughter of Sir William Abdy, Bart., of Chobham Place, Surrey. Mr. C. A. Caldwell was the only son of Admiral Sir Benjamin Caldwell, G.C.B.*

Arms :—Or, in chief 3 piles Sable, each charged with a fountain proper, in base 4 bars wavy, alternately Gules and Vert.

Crest :—A demi lion grasping a broken scimitar, all proper, issuing from a naval crown Or.

FYLER, Rev. James, of Woodlands, Windlesham, eldest son of the late James Chamness Fyler, of Woodlands, Surrey, and Hethfelton, Dorset, Esq., by his first wife, daughter of the late Sir John Frederick, Baronet, of Burwood Park, Walton-on-Thames, Surrey, who represented the county of Surrey in Parliament for forty years. Mr. Fyler married in 1847 Rosalind Charity, daughter of the late William F. Chambers, M.D., K.C.H., of Hordle Cliff, Hants, Physician in Ordinary to the Queen. Mr. Fyler was educated at Harrow, and graduated B.A. at Balliol College, Oxon, 1842. Appointed Rector of Windlesham 1861, which benefice he resigned in 1878, having, by his laudable exertions and assistance, enabled his parishioners to restore St. John's, Windlesham, to its present handsome condition.‡

Arms :—Sable, 3 cinquefoils between 9 crosses crosslet, Or.

Motto :—" Volonté de Dieu."

LLOYD, Robert Jones Saunderson, of Ardnagowan, co. Roscommon, Esq^{re}, has resided in the detached brick house at the cross roads, north-west of the church, since 1872. He married, 1863, Sarah Margaret, eldest daughter of James Barber, of Manor House, Homerton, Middx., Esq., and has issue :—1. Robert Jones, n. 1865; 2. Lyster, n. 1867, ob. 1871; 3. St George, n. 1869; 4. Arthur Walter, n. 1871; 5. Desmond Lyster, n. 1872; 6. Edward Osborne, n. 1874; 7. James FitzGerald, n. 1879; and Mabel Lucy. Originally of North Wales, this family settled in Ireland in 1687. Mr Lloyd's grandfather's grandmother was sister to the mother of the poet Oliver Goldsmith, who was delivered of her cele-

brated son in the old house of Ardnagowan, where she was on a visit, in 1728. (*Vide* Weld's "Survey of Co. Roscommon," 1832; and Cassell's "Life of Oliver Goldsmith.") The family resided on their estate until 1847, when the then representative, the Rev. John Lloyd, a man of still-remembered benevolence and saintlike piety, was wantonly assassinated on his way home from Aughrim Church, where he had been officiating as Rector of the parish, and where a marble tablet to his memory, erected by his widow (daughter of Colonel Lloyd, of Rockville, in the same county), can still be seen. There is also a mural tablet in the Cathedral of Elphin, over the family pew, to the memory of the Rev. J. Lloyd and his immediate ancestors. The present representative, R. J. S. Lloyd, graduated B.A. at Dublin University in 1861. His brothers are John Matthew, Navigating Lieutenant R.N. (invalided 1874), now residing in Canada; 2. William Battersby, Clerk in Holy Orders, and graduate of Dublin University, M.A. 1870, who was curate to the Rev. James Fyler, Windlesham, 1874-8, and now is curate at Virginia Water; 3. Owen Tudor, settled in Queensland; and, lastly, Anne Frances, his sister, married to Walter Douglas-Irvine, of Grangemuir, Fifeshire, and Ludington House, Egham, Esq., 1870. (For further particulars see Burke's "Landed Gentry," 1848). This family claim descent from Osborn FitzGerald, son of Gwthlac, Earl of Desmond, tempore Edward I. (See Burke's "General Armory," and Meyrick's "Heralds' Visitation of Wales," 2 vols. 4to, in the British Museum). They bear Arms:—Ermine a saltire Gules. Crest:—A boar passant. Motto, alluding to the arms:—"Salus et Decus."

LEYCESTER, Ralph.—This Gentleman resided in the parish for some years. He was second son of Ralph Leycester of Toft, in the county of Chester, Esquire, by his wife Katherine daughter and coheirress of Edward Norris of Speke, in the county of Lancaster. Mr. Ralph Leycester of Windlesham succeeded his brother George Leycester of Toft, Esq., and represented the ancient family of that name, being descended in direct line from Ralph Leycester of Tabley, who married Joan daughter and heiress of Richard Toft of Toft, temp. Richard II. In 1702 Mr. Ralph Leycester married Charlotte third daughter of the Rev. Dr. Lushington of Eastbourne, Sussex, and had issue:—

1. Ralph, who succeeded his father in the family estates at Toft.
2. Henry, a Captain in the Royal Navy.
3. George, Fellow of King's College, Cambridge.
4. William, bapt. at Windlesham, 16 May 1775.
5. Charlotte, married to Charles Dumbleton of Bath, Esq.
6. Harriet, bapt. at Windlesham, August 9, 1770; married to the Rev. Robert Cox, Vicar of Bridgenorth.
7. Susanna, bapt. at Windlesham, May 19th 1773.

Mr. Leycester bore for Arms:—Azure, between two fleur-de-lis Or, a fess of the second fretty Gules.

OWEN, Admiral Sir Edward, G.C.B., G.C.H., came to Windlesham House in the year 1834, and died in 1849.

The property was entailed upon the children of his brother, Admiral W. F. W. Owen, of whom the present Proprietor is the sole survivor.

Windlesham Court was, until lately, the property of the representatives of Sir George Philip Lee, who died 1870; it was sold in 1879 to S. Asser, Esq^{re}.

Hall Grove, a prettily situated estate, is owned by — Dumbleton, Esq^{re}, who leased it to Thomas Sellar, Esq^{re}.

SACH, Frederica Adolphina Ann, of Lee Lane Farm, Windlesham, and Upper Clapton, Middlesex, only daughter of Post-Captain Richard Dickinson, R.N., C.B., K^t.S^t.L., K^t.S^t.A., R.G., and the Vladimar—(this officer succeeded Commodore Bathurst to the command of H.M.S. *Genoa*, 74, at the Battle of Navarino, 1827, and underwent that remarkable court-martial, two years afterwards, upon charges brought against him by Admiral Sir Edward Codrington, K.C.B., and after a trial lasting nineteen days, he was honourably acquitted, and the charges pronounced “groundless,” “frivolous,” and “vexatious”), by his wife Jane Splatt, eldest daughter of Admiral T. Searle, C.B.,* of Kingston House, Kingston Cross, and Straddlescombe, Devon.

M^{rs} Sach married, in 1854, her cousin,† William Glanville-Richards, Esq^{re}, B.A. (Oxon.), eldest son of the Rev^d William Richards, M.A. Oxon. and Vicar of Dawley Magna. M^r Glanville-Richards, dying in 1867, left issue:

2. Henry Arkwright Hakewell Richards, born 1858.

M^{rs} Sach married, secondly, the Rev^d Henry Sach, who was educated at King's College, London; appointed Senior Curate of St George the Martyr; and Special Preacher at St Peter's-upon-Cornhill, London. He died in 1880, leaving issue:

M^{rs} Sach's brothers are—1. Richard Dickinson; 2. Thomas Searle Dickinson, Commander Royal Navy, married, 1868, Louisa, only daughter of J. Izatt, Esq^{re}, of St Andrew's, Scotland; 3. Rev^d G. Cockburn-Dickinson, married the Hon. W. Elizabeth Denison, daughter of the late Lord Londesborough; 4. Henry Richard Sweney Dickinson.

† On the death of this gentleman's uncles, T. Glanville-Taylor, Esq^{re} (a gentleman well known in the scientific and astronomical world, and for some years Astronomer Royal at Madras), and the Rev. Henry Taylor, LL.D., Mr. Glanville-Richards became the representative of one of the elder lines of the Glanville family, being grandson of Roger Glanville, of Ashburton, Esq. (Mrs. Henry Sach is likewise one of his great grand-daughters), who was second in descent from John Glanville, of Broadhilton Manor, Wilts, and Exeter, Esquire, Barrister-at-Law, and his wife Catherine, daughter of Sir Edmund Fortescue, of Fallepit, Devon, Baronet. He was second son of Sir John Glanville, of Broadhilton Manor, Wilts, a noted lawyer, Sergeant-at-Law to Charles I. and II., and Speaker of the House of Commons, Long Parliament 1640, who suffered much persecution for his adherence to the Royal cause. His father was Sir John Glanville, of Halwell, Tavistock, and Kilworthy, Devon, a Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, 1598, who was descended in the direct male line from the distinguished Randolph de Glanville, Lord of Glanville near Caen, Normandy, and Baron de Bromholm, in Norfolk, who entered England at the Conquest. He was also ancestor of William de Glanville, founder of Bromholm Abbey, 1113; of Randolph de Glanville, the celebrated Lord Chief Justice of Henry II., the name of whom, as Lord Campbell writes, “will ever be held in honoured remembrance by Englishmen” (he founded Butley Priory and Leiston Abbey, Suffolk); of Sir Herve de Glanville, Chamberlain to King Stephen, who, according to some authorities, was ancestor to the Butlers, Earls of Ormond; of Gilbert De Glanville, Bishop of Rochester, and Lord Chief Justice of England; of Roger de Glanville, Founder of Bungay Abbey; of Gilbert de Glanville, Earl of Suffolk (ob. 1266), who sided with Simon de Montford; and of Bartholomew de Glanville, a curious monkish writer of the fourteenth century.

WATERER.—Partly situated in this parish are the well known and justly celebrated American Nurseries founded, some years ago, by Mr. John Waterer, whose indefatigable zeal and perseverance, in a great measure, tended towards the growth of American plants and Rhododendrons in this country, and brought them to their present high state of cultivation. He died in 1868. By his wife, who was a Miss M. E. Large, he left issue:—
