Resolved. That the Bill to levy additional taxes for the year 1 1865, for the support of the government, be recommitted to the 2 Committee of Ways and Means, with instructions to report a 3 bill providing that the taxes for the year 1865 shall, so far as 4 the same may be payable in Treasury notes, he payable exclu-5 sively in Treasury notes hereafter to be issued. That the amount 6 of such Treasury notes shall be limited to double the amount of 7 the taxes estimated for the year 1865. That the Treasury notes 8 now outstanding shall be fundable in six per cent bonds. That 9 a tax in kind be levied on cotton, tobacco and specie. That the 10 existing rate of taxation be so modified as to enable the country 11 to meet the taxes in the improved currency. 12
